

Curses On False Preachers and People Who Don't Reject Them.
Full sermon transcript Dec. 3, 2022.

Revelation 18 verse 3.

For all the nations have drunk of the wine of the passion of her immorality,
sin, and the kings of the earth have committed immorality with her.

And the merchants of the earth have become rich by the wealth of her luxuries or her indulgence.

Or that could also be translated as passion or arrogance.

Now, this is talking about the end time Bible.

And it has several different meanings.

It is referring to both a literal city on earth that's being built right now.

I believe that it is referring to the city of Neom, N E O M.

Currently being built in Saudi Arabia and growing, continually, constantly growing in size.

They've already got a lot of stuff built, but also a lot of plans and preparations for a lot more building.

And they're building a bridge from Saudi Arabia across the Red Sea into Egypt.

They're building this city into Egypt and Saudi Arabia and Jordan and plans to build it into the territory of Israel as well.

This is going to be basically a nation state city.

And we'll absolutely become the new capital of Saudi Arabia and the new capital of technology for the world and commerce for the world.

Seaports, digital ID, digital currency, green energy.

It is the World Economic Forum that is greatly involved in this.

Bill Gates, Charles Schwab, all of those demons and nephilim that are leading the communism in the world.

They're greatly involved in this. Saudi Arabia is the hub for this.

And it will be blending the city of Mecca into this new city of Neom, N-E-O-M or neon, whatever you want to call it, the city of the devil.

But this is also referring not only to a physical city, but it is also referring to false religion around the world.

And how Islam has crept into false Christianity actually is the basis and origin of false Christianity.

The Roman Catholic Church is a great part of this, as well as the Vatican and the Pope's and Islam.

But also the Protestant churches is also a great part of this.

A lot of people want to focus entirely on the Catholic Church when they read this.

But the reality is that the Pope's and the Catholic Church and the Vatican is intertwined,
mixed and mingled in with Islam, and they are truly not separate.

I have, I think, 19 ways I believe the count is currently, if I'm not mistaken,

19 ways listed on that article of how Islam and the Catholic Church are the same.

They both idolize Mary and worship the dead and there are both death cults.

And they both have a history of slaughtering the saints of God and true Christians and newcomers to Christianity, newcomers to Christ.

They both have a history of fighting the Bible, fighting Jesus Christ, fighting the truth,
restricting freedom of the Holy Scriptures and many other things that they have in common, many other things.

They are the one and the same.

And the Roman Empire that developed what we know now is the Roman Catholic Church and the Orthodox Church,
the Greek Orthodox, the Russian Orthodox, they're all one in the same as well.

And the Roman Empire is a blend of things from the Persian Empire.

We have to look at that statue of Daniel in Daniel 2 that Daniel saw,

actually, King Nebuchadnezzar saw and Daniel interpreted that the head of gold was the Assyrian Babylonian Empire.

People don't understand the Assyrian connection, but Nebuchadnezzar and his family and his empire,

they came from the Assyrian Empire and they were Assyrian people and they spoke the Assyrian language.

They had Assyrian religion, Assyrian culture.

It was entirely Assyrian.

When we hear the word Babylon, we must understand that it is Assyrian.

And then the Assyrian Empire blending into the new age of what we call the Babylonian Empire,

then blending into the new age of the Persian Empire that came next, is that right?

And then the Greek Empire and then the Roman Empire.

And each one of these continued the policies, the culture and the religion of the previous empire.

They did not end nor destroy the culture and the religion of the previous empire.

They did not, but rather they continued on that culture, that empire, that religion of the Babylonian mystery religion.

They continued it. They added to it.

They changed a few things, but they continued it.

They changed the names of the deities, but they continued the same deities,

the same stories, adding and mixing and blending it together.

And all the way down into the Catholic Church and the worship of Allah,

the Moon God was present the whole time.
Different names, Bel and Baal and Easter and all these different things.
The Christmas, the Easter, the Halloween, it is all in there.
It is all mixed together.
It is all one in the same.
So then when you come down into the Protestant churches,
people think that that's not Catholic, it's anti-Catholic and that is not true.
They changed some things.
They changed some words.
They edited, but it is still the same culture.
It is still the same religion.
It is still mystery Babylon.
It is still Islam.
It is still the cult of death.
It is still the cult of death that teaches falsehood and lies and deceptions
and that leads to destruction.
This is what it's talking about here in addition to a little town and nation.
It is also talking about world government, the corruption of society.
It is talking about feminine government.
It is a woman riding a beast.
It is feminine government.
It is women leaders, women governors, women prime ministers.
It is all mixed together.
It's the worship of a woman, the worship of Mary,
the worship of a goddesses, witchcraft being mostly women.
It is Easter being a female goddess.
It is feminization of men.
It is transgenderism.
It is homosexuality.
It is the destruction of the family.
It is destruction of family values and family morals.
It is destruction of the Ten Commandments and the name of Jesus.
It's all of this and more.
So this is a lot to this.
But the part that I'm going to focus on today is the Protestant Church,
the false teachers, false preachers out there,
Baptist preachers, Pentecostal preachers and Apostolic teachers.
A lot of people, when they start coming into the truth against the Assyrian letter Y names
and other elements of the truth,
they get persuaded by false preachers of the Apostolic Church
and other churches, the Seventh-day Adventists, the Jehovah's Witnesses,
other cults that they get caught up into because they have an element of truth.
It is a bait.
It is a carrot stick.
The devil always mixes some truth in with the lies
to catch the people that are seeking the truth.
But we need all of the truth and nothing but the truth.
Amen.
So you might get caught up in some group,
some denominations, some church because of a measure of truth.
But if you continue to read the Scriptures and study the Scriptures and pray and seek Jesus,
then God is going to call you out of that.
Amen.
Entirely, all the way.
And that's what we need to do is come completely
out of that Babylonian false religious system.
All the false teachers, even if they have some truth,
we want nothing but the truth.
So help me God.
Amen.

Verse four.
I heard another voice from heaven saying,

Come out of her, my people, so that you will not participate in her sins and receive of her plagues.

Amen.

When we listen to the Sunday preachers,
when we listen to Trinity preachers,
when we listen to preachers that do not believe in the seventh day of rest and worship,
which the world calls the Sabbath, that's not the correct term.

The Sabbath is not the correct term.

That word has pagan origins.

But we use the word Sabbath because it's the vocabulary of the world so that they know what we're talking about.

We have to use the vocabulary of the world to some extent,
especially when we are evangelizing in public, on Facebook, on MeWe, places like that.

But among ourselves, when we're privately chatting,
when we are privately talking,
when we are among only the other true brothers and sisters,
we should not use the word Sabbath.

We should use the word seventh day.

That would be more accurate, more holy, more clean,
more acceptable without any pagan origins.

So the corruption of the word Sabbath,
the reason the word Sabbath is pagan is because it is Assyrian for destruction
and for Saturn, the planet Saturn is all connected with Assyria.

How that the Jews and other Israelites worshiped the planets and false gods
and embraced paganism.

And that's why they were taken captive by the Assyrians and Babylonians
because God said, if that's what you want, that's what you get.

You have chosen your gods.

Go and serve them.

Go, go.

That's what you want.

That's what you get.

And that's how they embraced the word Sabbath is from the Assyrians.

Just like they did with the sunset to sunset.

They embraced that from the Assyrians.

Sunset to sunset is Islamic in nature, in character.

So we have to come out from all of that, from all of it.

Amen.

Come out from her, my people.

Do not participate in her sins, receive her plagues.

When we defile ourselves by listening to the Sunday preachers
and those that don't keep the Sabbath, even if they don't keep Sunday,
if they don't keep, I said Sabbath of habit

because I have to witness to people on Facebook and other places.

I'm using that word so that they know what I'm talking about.

But I need to say seventh day to you,
since this is the church listening to me right now.

So those preachers that do not keep the seventh day,
even if they don't keep Sunday, if they're not keeping the seventh day,
they are not your true brothers and sisters.

They are part of Babylon because they're rejecting the Fourth Commandment.

The Ten Commandments.

That's the Big Ten.

How can we deny any of the commandments?

Jesus said in reference to the Ten Commandments

that he did not come to destroy the law,
but to fulfill it, which does not mean to do away.

But to fill it up, to explain it,
to teach how to keep the commandments is what that means.

It does not mean to do away.

People that are new to the truth,

they're still under this delusion, this fairy tale,
this hopeful thinking that as long as they have some truth,
such as Jesus name that that is OK to listen to these people
and follow these people and read their teachings and listen to their teachings.
Because they must love God because they're teaching Jesus name,
Jesus name, Jesus name, Jesus name, Jesus name.
And they must be our brother.
They must be our brother. What's wrong with listening to this guy?
He's teaching Jesus name.
He has a lot of truth.
He's got to be our brother. He loves God.

But the reality is, according to the scriptures,
not my opinion, but the scriptures,
if they're not keeping the Ten Commandments,
including the seventh day commandment,
it's not a suggestion, but rather a commandment.
If they're not keeping that commanded, ordained day,
they are not your brothers and sisters
and they are not men of God and they are not true preachers.
And they do not truly love God enough to be your teacher.
If they loved God, they would keep the Big Ten. Amen.
Amen. That's a Bible verse. Amen.

So it does say, let's read it here in the scriptures:

1 John 2:3-4

By this we know that we know Him if we keep His commandments.
The one who says, I have come to know Him
and does not keep His commandments is a liar and the truth is not in him.

How much more clear can you get?
But people say the commandments, that's only talking about loving one another.
That's not talking about the seventh day.
That's what a lot of people try to claim.
But yet in the last verses of Matthew, in Matthew 28, He says,
go and teach people everything that I have taught you and everything I've commanded you.
And that would include the foot washing, the communion on Passover evening,
and the seventh day because Jesus absolutely kept the seventh day.
And He never broke it.
People say He broke it, He broke it, He broke the Sabbath, He broke the seventh day.
That's what they say all the time.
It's a lie of the devil because if He had broken that law,
then He would have committed a sin and Jesus never sinned, ever.
So people that try to claim that Jesus broke the seventh day,
they are liars of the worst kind.
They are blasphemers.
And you should absolutely, harshly rebuke anyone and everyone
that tries to say that Jesus broke the seventh day commandment,
which is a very popular opinion, doctrine.
I don't care who they are.
Your mommy, your daddy, your child, your best friend, your husband, your wife,
anybody that tries to tell you that Jesus broke the commandment of the seventh day,
you should harshly rebuke them because that's blasphemy.
That is blasphemy and deserves harsh and immediate rebuke.
People have this false interpretation of what love is.
They think love is never offending, never upsetting anyone,
never rebuking, never blocking, never disfellowshipping,
never deleting anybody's comments.
That's bull crap.
True love would be putting God first and the truth first over and above any human friendship
and making your stand for the truth boldly.
That's true love.

And true love is rebuking the enemy and rebuking lies and fairy tales and deceptions.
True love is casting out darkness and not having anything to do with it,
but rather exposing them.
As the Bible says, not only not precipitate within them their darkness,
but even expose them.
True love will expose the lies, the deceptions, and speak against it boldly.
So not as a wimp, not as a coward, but boldly fighting the evil, especially the men.
And the men need to do a better job at teaching their wives
and leading their wives and becoming the head of the house
and not being afraid of the women and what they think or what they're going to say or what they're going to do.
The men should be the head of the house.
And what the man says goes, even if she disagrees.
Men should start being in control of their family, of their household, of their wives.
If the man is in the truth, then he should enforce the truth in his home.
The man that is in the truth should be commanding that his wife and his children keep the seventh day.
And if they don't, then out the door they go.

People think that's unloving, unkind, not Jesus-like, but it is very Jesus-like.
God comes first, not wife, not children, not jobs, not money, not career, not a place to live.
God, His truth, His commandments, that is what comes first, nothing else.
But men have been feminized, softened and weakened to where now they obey the woman.
Society is upside down.
Even in the Eastern world, when I was a child in my ignorance, I thought that in the Eastern world,
I thought that in Korea and other places like that, that the men were men and the women were women.
But even when I was a child, it was already much changing because of modern society,
the Internet, the computers, businesses, corporations, women managers, women workers,
women leaving their children behind or their husbands behind to make a few dollars.
It was already in the works way back then. Very sad.
Society has been corrupted all the way around the globe, even in Africa as well as Asia.
Very, very sad.
We need to come out of all that, all that corruption, all of that feminization of men,
men being cowards and too soft and the church being cowards, church being too soft.
We need to come out of that.
Preachers being too soft, we need to come out of that.
The men of God in the Bible preached it boldly, with courage, without fear.
They preached it boldly without worrying who would leave the church or who would stop giving money.
This is the truth. Amen.
Those false preachers that do not keep the seventh day, they are not your brothers.
They keep not the commandments of the Lord, therefore they do not know God.
If they knew God, they would keep His commandments.
This is what the Bible teaches us. That's not my opinion.
It's what the Bible says. Amen.
Now it says here in Revelation, go back to that, Revelation 18,
not only that we are not to participate in her sins, but also not receive of her plagues,
her judgments, her punishment.
I have personally eyewitnessed recently sickness and disease among people who heard the truth.
Spouses, friends, people.
People that heard the truth from this church, from this ministry, from you,
who are now sick and diseased and bedridden because they did not give up the Sunday preachers.
They did not give up listening, watching, following, idolizing the Babylonian lawless rebellious preachers.
This is the fruit of continuing to stay one foot in the door of Babylon.
This is the consequences. That is the fruit.
You will receive of her plagues if you do not come all the way out of the false religion,
if you do not stop following these false teachers on Facebook, on MeWe, on Twitter, on TV, on the radio, and so forth.
And their websites and their websites and their YouTube videos.
You say, oh, but I get so much from it.
He's teach me that. He taught me that. He taught me this. He taught me that.

Listen, this ministry right here has a YouTube channel.
We've got other videos that's not on YouTube that are on the website that you can watch.
And I'm going to make more eventually.
We've got the Alpha and Omega Bible. (<https://most-accurate-bible.com>)
We've got a 24 hour a day radio station on the Internet, 24 hours a day that you can listen to.

And it's music and it's documentaries and it's other content.

We have the flyer distribution that you need to be doing every one of you.

We have activities.

We've got the new moon worship services, the seventh day worship services, the holy day worship services.

We've got MeWe, Facebook and Twitter.

There's no excuse of you needing to go somewhere else looking in the dumpster,

looking in the trash of Babylon, going to the false creatures and their videos and their channels and their Facebook page and their YouTube page.

We've got all of this for you right here.

There's no excuse.

I'm extremely active in the social media groups and posting things for you to read, for you to study, for you to look at, for you to listen to.

There's no excuse.

I don't know why you need more and you need more and you need more and you need more.

You got a Bible at home.

There's even several hundred hours of sermon recordings.

That should be enough for anyone.

Exactly, brother Jared.

We have tons and tons and tons of audio files of sermons that go back years and years and years.

If you really need more, there it is.

We have so much to offer.

You don't have to go to Babylon to fill up your time.

There's no excuse.

That people say, oh, but I want to study and I want to know whether you're really speaking the truth or not.

Well then, sit down and open up your Bible.

That's how you know.

You don't have to go to YouTube or Facebook in order to test me to see whether I'm speaking the truth or not.

Go to the Bible.

Go to the Bible and go to Strong's Concordance and go to BlueLetterBible.com to look up the Greek and the Hebrew.

Go to Bible manuscripts, look up Bible manuscripts.

I'm not against people testing me.

I'm not against people studying.

I want you to test me.

I want you to study.

I want you to look up the Greek and the Hebrew.

I want you to look up the agent manuscripts.

I want you to read the Bible.

I want you to pray.

I want people to fast as long as it's the right measure of fasting.

But you don't have to go to a false preacher who does not even keep the seventh day or the holy days.

You don't have to do that.

You don't have to go to Satan in order to learn the truth.

Amen?

Amen. That's a very stupid idea to go to Satan to try and learn the truth.

Let's go to the book of Corinthians.

1 Corinthians 10:21 page 185.

Verse 21 says, "You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons.

You cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons.

Or do we provoke the Lord to jealousy?

We're not stronger than he are we."

It's very clear.

You have to make a choice.

You have to stop being double minded.

Have you found the truth or not?

Make up your mind.

How long does it take to figure it out?

I think it's very clear.

I think it's very self evident.

That when you go and you partake and you go to their churches or turn on the radio and listen to them or go to their YouTube channels or their websites,

then you are partaking of the table and the cup and the meal, the spiritual food of the enemy.

Read the Bible for yourself.

Amen.

Read the Bible for yourself.

If you want to test what the truth is, look at chapter 11 verse 28.

One Corinthians 11:28.

"But a person must examine himself.

And in so doing, he is to eat the bread and drink of the cup."

Talking about communion on Passover evening that before you take that communion, you must test yourself.

You must examine yourself about whether you are truly saved or not.

Because if you're not truly saved, you cannot and must not take the communion.

But not only test yourself about whether you're truly saved, but verse 29,

"but he who eats and drinks and eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly."

And the body is not talking about your flesh.

It's not talking about your flesh.

It's talking about the church.

The body here is talking about judging the church,

your brothers and sisters that you're going to take communion with on Passover.

If you have any local brothers and sisters by the time the Passover comes,

you have to judge people.

People always want to point to Matthew 7 where it says "don't judge",

they don't forget to read the next following verses, but rather they are taught to not read the next verses.

That's what it is.

They're taught not to read the next verse.

But if you keep reading, it says that you must remove the beam out of your own eye

before you try to remove the smaller splinter from somebody else's eye.

But once you do that, then you can help your brother.

Amen.

So in other words, when it said "do not judge", the context means "do not judge

hypocritically when you yourself have not got your own life cleaned up yet."

You have to remove the beam out of your own eye first.

Then you can help other people.

So that can be applied about judging, but it also can and must be applied

about teaching and preaching.

One of the people I saw on Facebook recently preaching Jesus' name,

preaching, preaching, preaching, posting every day,

preaching against the Assyrian letter Y names.

Hey, that's all good, but he himself, an alcoholic, drinking and getting drunk

every day, every day and every day and hanging out with the wrong people,

poisoning his drink and getting in trouble and destroying his health

and destroying his life and everything else and his life going down the drain

and confessing that he's following Satan and yet he continues to preach.

That's not right.

He needs to leave Facebook and stop preaching until he gets his own life

straightened up first.

What I am seeing and I witnessing over and over and over and I've seen this my

entire life is that people think they get saved and they're really not even

saved, but they think they're saved and they automatically start preaching,

thinking that they got to preach because they're excited about their supposed

salvation.

They're excited, they're happy, they're joyous and they want to share the joy

with the world and they want to share Jesus with the world and they want to get

everybody saved and they preach and they preach and they preach, but God never

told them, I have called you to preach.

I want you to start your ministry.

God never told them that.

That's the majority of your Facebook preachers.

That's the majority of your Sunday preachers.

That's the majority of all the preachers around the world, of every church, of

every religion, of every denomination.

God never said to them, I have called you to preach.

Never.

To be a preacher, a teacher is not just you deciding you want to do that because you're happy.

That's not the right way.

You must hear from God.

So we see the fruit of this is death because it says here, let's find this verse, verse 30, "for this reason many among you are weak and sick and a number of people are asleep."

They are dead.

But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged.

In other words, if you would test yourself about who you listen to, who you go to church with, who you follow, who you follow on Facebook, who you follow on MeWe and social media, and who you listen to on the radio and TV, if you would choose or test more seriously, more seriously, then you wouldn't have to be judged or punished by the plagues that are coming upon Babylon.

Amen.

There are people that have heard the truth that are now sick or even dead.

And this is absolutely the truth.

There are people that are dead, that heard me preach, that heard the truth, that had the AOB Bible in their hands, and they are now dead or sick or bedridden because they did not fully accept the Word of God.

This is a strong warning.

Not only must you test me, but you must test those preachers and other people that claim to be your brothers and your sisters.

You must test and you must judge.

Right here it says you must judge the body rightly.

That means the church.

It's not testing your feet.

It's not testing your arms.

It's testing the church is what it's talking about.

The context proves that.

Amen.

You must judge is the only safe way to live is to judge people.

Otherwise, you're going up dead.

Let's go to 2 Corinthians 6:14, page 196, and before I forget, as people are returning to 2 Corinthians 6, verse 14, page 196, before I forget, a very exciting announcement that we're going to be very soon releasing a brand new, updated, new improved edition of the Alpha and Omega Bible to where all of the words of God in the Old Testament, all the words of God in the Old Testament will be in bold in the black and white edition and in red in the full color edition and the online PDF will have all the words of God in red, Old Testament and New Testament both.

So this is awesome.

Amen.

Thank you to Brother Jared for all of his hard work, his steadfastness, his perseverance.

He has far past the length of time of the majority of people that have come and gone through this ministry.

He has been steadfast, steadfast, and he has been tested, strongly tested.

He did not flee like a coward.

He did not flee like a little child, but rather he became a man.

And withstood the testing, we can learn a lot from Brother Jared in a lot of different ways.

Amen.

He's a faithful brother to you and to me in many more ways than you know.

There's a lot more going on behind the scenes than what any of you know because we do not boast about our good works.

There's a lot going on behind the scenes.

You have no idea.

And God is faithful to help us and to strengthen us to continue the work of the kingdom.

And it is God's work, not ours.

It is God's church.
It is God's strength.
It is God's healing.
It is God's calling.
It is God's anointing.
And it is He that works in us.
We could do nothing of ourselves without God.
Amen.
Praise God.

But here in 2 Corinthians 6:14, "do not be unequally yoked together with unfaithfulness.

For what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness?
What is lawlessness?"

Lawlessness is breaking the Ten Commandments, breaking the law of God, not obeying God when the seventh day is very clear in Scripture.

The seventh day is one of the most basic elementary truths that there is.

It's very simple.

How can you not believe in the seventh day on Saturday?

Very simple.

Lawlessness is breaking the seventh day and other commandments of the Lord.

"And what communion has light with darkness?

Or what harmony has Christ with Baal?

Or what portion?

Faithfulness with unfaithfulness or what agreement has the temple of

Theos with idols?

For we are the temple of the living Theos, just as Theos said, quote,

I will dwell in them and walk among them, and I will be their Theos,

and there shall be my people."

Therefore come out, Revelation 18, amen, come out from their midst and be separate, be separate from those that break God's law.

How much more clear can you get?

This applies to not only marriage and friendships, but also it applies to churches and congregations and so-called brothers and sisters.

Amen.

Now, don't get me wrong.

I know that it's acceptable to have some friends that are lost because you continue to witness to them and they're listening to you.

They listen.

They hear you out.

They don't interrupt you.

They listen to you.

They're not telling you that you're lost, that you're deceived, that you're brainwashed.

They're not telling you that you're following a cult.

Then yeah, keep them as friends as long as they're willing to listen, even if they're not repenting yet.

But once a person tells you that you are brainwashed, you are following a cult, you are deceived, you are wrong, any of these things and similar words, then that is time to disfellowship because they have already proven that they're not willing to come into the truth.

They're not willing to accept the Word of God.

And therefore, the Bible tells us not my opinion, but the Bible tells us to remove your blessing from that house, from that person, from that city, to remove your blessing, to remove your greeting, to remove your peace from that person and shake the dust off your feet, which is cursing that person.

Do not cast your pearls before swine.

Come out from among them.

Touch not the unclean.

Come out from their midst and be separate.
This is what the scripture tells us over and over and over and over.
But people say, but Jesus sat down with the sinners.
Yes, he did.
And I just told you, it's all right.
It's okay to have friends that are sinners.
It's all right to have friends with the laws.
I'm not against that.
But once they tread the Word of God like trash and say that you are deceived,
you are lost, you're brainwashed, you're following a cult, then that is telling
you right there that they are swine, that they are not worthy of your pearls
and that you should stop casting your pearls before swine.
Why do we not believe what the Bible says?
Why do we not obey what the Bible says?
There are some people that are not worthy of your friendship and your witnessing
or your help.
They are dogs, according to the Bible.
This is why the Bible calls them.
If you truly love them, you cast them out.
Even if they are your sisters, your brothers, your parents, your children,
because this is what the Bible says in Luke 14.

Let's go over there in Luke 14:26.
"If anyone comes to me and is not willing to forsake his own dad and mom and wife
and children and brothers and sisters",
that's everybody.
That's even your uncles and nephews, nieces and friends.
It's even them, even if it doesn't say that because the context is that person
and that person and that person.
That's the context.
It's everybody.
If you're not willing to forsake them and even your own life,
if you're not willing to even be martyred if the time was to come,
then you cannot be my disciple.
You can't be.
You can't.
You've got to be willing to give up anyone.
No exceptions.
Anyone be willing to do that.
Amen.
And there's another verse that also says that those that forsake houses and land,
that they will be rewarded.
We've got to be willing even to give up a job.
We've got to be willing to even give up money, even a home.
We've got to be willing to give up anyone or anything.
The principle is the same, whether you're talking about things or people.
The principle is still the same thing.
You've got to be willing to give up anything and anyone.
But people is like, oh, I need the money.
I need the money.
I need the money.
I can't quit this job.
I need the money because they don't trust God.
They don't trust God to replace that job.
They don't trust God to give them an even better life.
They don't trust God to give them an even better friend or better preacher.
They don't want to give up those preachers that reject God, even though they don't love God,
because if they really love God, they would keep the Ten Commandments.
Keeping the seventh day is not about law.
It's about loving God and putting God first over and above job, houses and money and career.
God first is love, love toward God.

So one of the guys on Facebook named David Reed, even though he was this is a different one from the alcoholic.

This is a different one. I'm telling you about now.

David Reed was doing the same as the alcoholic preaching against the letter Y Assyrian names.

And that's good. Preaching Jesus name.

And that's good. But he also this guy, David Reed, had said at least two different times that I could find.

He had spoken against the observance of the seventh day, saying that his words that the Sabbath is not a day.

His words, the Sabbath is not a day. Bull crap, bull crap. It is a day.

And Hebrews four says so. Amen.

And Hebrews four tells us that the observance of the Sabbath from that's the vocabulary it uses

because they were the Jews and the Romans and the Greeks and everybody and the people,

even the church of the first century was using the Assyrian language as addition to Greek as well, mostly Greek.

But a lot of Assyrian words had already been crept in.

The Sabbath had crept in from the Assyrian captivity from back then and from the Babylonian captivity.

So the Sabbath word was being used by the first century church

because mostly because they were witnessing to a lot of Gentiles and to a lot of lost people.

So they were having to use that vocabulary.

And so Hebrews four says that the observance of the Sabbath still remains for the people of God.

Now, your traditional translations, they hide those words, the keeping of the Sabbath,

and translate it wrongfully as the word rest in verse nine.

In Hebrews four, verse nine, they wrongfully translated on purpose.

The King James wrongfully translates it on purpose.

The NIV, the New American Standard, and hundreds, literally hundreds of other translations translated incorrectly on purpose.

Those publishers, those translators, they saw the word Sabbath

and they purposely kept out the word Sabbath because they didn't believe in it.

They purposely changed the Bible and that's exactly what the book of Revelation chapter 22 warns against.

Those that take out words from this book that their names will be removed from the book of life.

Amen.

The Bible has been changed. Revelation 22 says so. Amen.

Why would God put a curse on people that add to the Bible and take away from the Bible?

That proves it was done.

Why would God put a curse if it was never going to happen?

It happened.

The Bible proves itself that it has been corrupted.

Even other verses talk about the lying, the lying pen of the scribe.

Amen. The Bible says so.

So this David Reed speaking against the observance of the seventh day.

He's going to die.

We all have to die sooner or later.

But the Bible promises a longer life for the people of God and a shorter life for the wicked.

This guy has him. He is in stage four kidney disease, diabetes or something.

I don't know what's causing it, but stage four kidney failure,

which when I researched this to see what that was,

which I already knew by common sense that that is a very severe condition.

And it is the last stage of kidney disease before total failure.

And a person of his age can continue to have stage four without death for two and a half,

up to four years with proper treatment and good diet.

But I do not believe that he has that long because he is as white as a ghost.

And because he has preached against the fourth commandment of Jesus Christ.

And I do not believe that it is coincidence of the timing of the seriousness of his illness and me coming back to Facebook.

No coincidence.

I believe that the timing is perfect because God wanted me to see the fruit of disobedience.

So that so that I may witness about it to you.

So that it be a lesson and a warning to everyone.

And not only is the death and sickness and destruction upon the false preachers,

but according to Revelation 18, that the plagues upon the Babylonian people, Babylonian preachers,

the plagues that go upon them could be inflicted upon us as well if we continue to follow such people.

As far as thinking that they are men of God, thinking that they are our brothers in that context,

to follow them in that thinking is death and destruction upon us.

I repeatedly seen the destruction of the wicked.

It won't be the last time.

It is no surprise.

I don't rejoice in this man's punishment.

In fact, it's very sad to see someone suffering, someone near death.
It is sad, but the reality is that he brought it upon himself.
And it's not wrong for me to say that.

Let's turn to Deuteronomy 11:26 says, "Behold, I set before you this day the blessing and the curse,
the blessing if you listen and obey the commands of Jesus your Theos,
all that I command you this day.
But the curse if you do not listen and obey the commands of Jesus our Theos,
as many as I command you this day."

And you wonder from the way which I have commanded you,
having gone to serve other gods which you knew not.
So the commandments of the Lord, it was Jesus that spoke the Ten Commandments
at Mount Sinai.

It wasn't Allah, it wasn't Buddha.
So who was it?

It was Jesus.

We only have one God.

Amen.

It was Jesus that spoke the Ten Commandments,
and it was a covenant between His people and Him, and we are now His people.

Amen.

It's not just for the Jews.

It never was only for the Jews, ever.

Never was.

The tribes of Israel, only one tribe was the Jews.

And then you've had Reuben and Joseph.

Joseph was not a Jew.

Reuben was not a Jew.

Dan was not a Jew, so forth and so forth, and other tribes.

Only the Judah people were Jews.

People don't understand this.

People don't know this because they're extremely ignorant of the Bible
because they didn't read it for themselves,

but rather they just went to church or they just watched YouTube.

But they didn't read the Bible for themselves,

and that's why people don't know that most Israelites are not Jews.

If you read the Bible, you would know this.

Amen.

If you would read it enough, amen.

The commandments were never for the Jews only,

but all of God's people, and not only the Israelites,

not only for the twelve tribes of Israel,

but also even the Gentiles that God adopted into their families.

And that did happen in the Old Testament, absolutely.

It was never just for the Israelites either,

but for all of God's people.

And the Gentiles would be baptized,

and they would call it being born again.

Even back then in the Old Testament time,

they were baptizing people, being born again,

to be converted into, not Judaism, because that's a lie,

they were not converted to Judaism,

but rather they were converted to out of,

away from Gentile false gods over to the God of Israel.

That was their conversion.

Amen.

Amen.

Now, I was going to read a whole bunch more verses
in Deuteronomy 27 and Deuteronomy 28,
but we don't need to do that as far as reading all of that.
But I think we'll read just a verse or two of it.

Let's go to Deuteronomy 27.

I'll let you read most of this at home,
but we'll read a little bit of it.

Chapter 27.

You see in Chapter 27, blessings and curses.

And verse 15, cursed is the man
whosoever shall make a carved or molten image.

Amen.

And verse 16, curses upon those that
break the commandment of honoring the parents.

But there are exceptions,
because you must be willing to forsake your parents,
which is read that.

Amen.

So there are exceptions.

But keeping different commandments and curses,
if you break the commandments and curses
with different sexual sins here in verses 20 through 26,
then you go to Chapter 28,
more curses and curses and curses and sickness and disease
and death and a shorter life.

But blessings in the first part of Chapter 28,
blessings if you keep the commandments,
and long life if you keep the commandments,
and health if you keep the commandments.

So you can read all that yourself.

But people's response to this,
there's Old Testament.

There's Old Testament about having blessings and curses
depending on whether you keep the commandments.

Here's my response.

Let's turn to Matthew 5.

Matthew 5 is New Testament.

Amen.

Chapter 5, verse 1. "When Jesus saw the crowds,

He went up on the mountain,
and after He sat down, His disciples came to Him.

And He opened His mouth and began to teach them saying this,

Blessed are the poor in spirit,
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven,
(the government of heaven).

Blessed are those who mourn,
for they should be comforted.

Blessed are the meek or gentle,
for they should inherit the earth,
(not heaven, but earth).

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness,
for they should be fed to the full.

Blessed are the merciful,
for they shall receive mercy.

Blessed are the pure in heart,
for they shall see Theos.

Blessed are the peacemakers,
for they should be called the sons of Theos.

Blessed are those who have been persecuted,
for the sake of righteousness,
for theirs is the kingdom,
(the government) of heaven."

Not heaven itself, but the government of heaven.

"Blessed are you when people insult you and persecute you,
and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me.

Rejoice and be glad,
for your reward in heaven is great,"

because there is a reward reserved in heaven for us,
but Revelation 21 says that New Jerusalem comes down out of Heaven.
The New Jerusalem, our mansions, that are reserved in heaven for us,
will descend out of heaven and land upon the earth.
Read it for yourself in Revelation 21 verse 2,
for in the same way that they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
Amen.

Notice here blessings.
Deuteronomy chapter 11,
chapter 27, chapter 28,
talked about blessing, blessing, blessing,
and cursing, cursing, cursing,
depending on whether you kept or disobeyed the commandments.
Now the commandments is more than just
do and don't
in the letter of the law,
but rather the commandments have spiritual principles
behind them.

Loving God first, putting God first,
and then loving other people,
and putting other people ahead of yourself,
and then putting yourself last.
That's the spiritual principle behind all the commandments.

Here in Matthew 5 in the New Testament,
these people are blessed
because they're keeping the spirit of the same law,
the same commandments.

And if you read the whole chapter,
it proves that it's talking about people
who are keeping the commandments of the Lord,
specifically the 10 commandments.

If you read the whole chapter,
the context is blessings upon people
that are keeping the 10 commandments.

Verse 13.

You are the salt of the earth.
But if the salt has become tasteless,
if you lose the Savior,
then how can it be made salty again?
Is it no longer good for anything
except to be cast out and trampled underfoot by people?

You are the light of the world.

A city set on a hill cannot be hidden,
nor does anyone light a lamp
and put it under a basket.

But they put it up on the lamp stand,
and it gives light to all that are in the house.

So let your light shine before people
in such a way that they may see your good works
and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

Do not think that I came to abolish the law or the prophets.

I did not come to abolish,
but to bring to fullness.

For truly, this is the truth I say to you,
until heaven and earth pass away,
not one jot, not one J letter,
or nor one stroke, one part of a letter,
shall pass from the law until all is accomplished.
Not until heaven and earth pass away.

That doesn't say until the crucifixion
or until the resurrection,
but rather until the end of the 1,100 years,
the great white throne judgment,
when the fullness of God will come down upon the earth
and devour everything,
and devour and destroy and annihilate
the unrepentant, wicked people
that continue to be lawless.
Not until that moment is the law
that he's talking about here,
the law of the Ten Commandments,
not until that moment or any of the Ten Commandments,
not even the seventh day,
not until then will the seventh day commandment cease,
and it will cease,
because in paradise, the new heaven,
the new earth, there'll be no time.
There'll just be one eternity.
There won't be no setting of the sun.
There won't be any rising of the sun.
There won't be any winter or spring.
There won't be a Sabbath or a holy day.
So, yes, the law will cease
at that point and not before then.
Amen?

This is what Jesus teaches.
Now, the Hebrew roots, the Jews,
claim that Jesus is teaching that even circumcision
and unclean meat and animal sacrifices,
that these things will never be done away with.
That's what the Jews teach,
and a lot of the Hebrew roots people believe,
that a man must cut his skin off his thing
in order to receive the government of God
and the rewards and salvation.
That doesn't make any sense.
That's not logical. It's silly. It's very silly.
It's very foolish. Very foolish thinking,
just to be honest with you.
Amen.

The law he's talking about is not circumcision,
because you can read the book of Galatians
that says that circumcision is done away with
over and over and over and over and over and over.
So we've got to read not only Matthew 5,
but we've got to read all of Galatians, right?
We've got to read the whole Bible,
everything from A to Z.
We've got to take the entire Bible
and add it all up,
and that would be the truth.
Amen?

So the law he's talking about here
can't be talking about circumcision,
because Galatians says over and over and over
that the circumcision is useless.

Okay?

So the law he's talking about,
if you keep reading,
verse 19,
"whoever then annuls" (or tries to do away with

or tries to counsel out)

"one of the least of these commandments,"
(even the least of the Ten Commandments,
even the least of his commandments,
if you try to cancel them out)

"and teach his people the same,
they should be called least
by the kingdom of heaven."

That doesn't mean they still enter in,
but rather the kingdom of heaven,
you and me,

will consider those people as the least,
the least of the population.

They are not among God's people.

Amen.

But whoever keeps and teaches them should be called great by us,
by the kingdom of heaven. We are the kingdom of heaven.

The kingdom of heaven is not a place. It is not a location.

It is a citizenship. The kingdom of heaven is a citizenship for only the warriors of God,
not the soft, not the snowflakes, not the people that believe that you should never offend
and never upset and never disfellowship,

those people are not allowed to be citizens because the Bible says that the soft will not enter in.

Okay?

So, we've got to toughen up!

Amen.

There will not be any snowflakes in heaven!

There will not be any snowflakes in paradise.

It's going to be too warm for them.

There might be a lot of beach bums,

but no, not beach bums, beach dudes.

There might be a lot of beach dudes and beach chicks,

because it could be nice and warm in paradise.

But there won't be any snowflakes in paradise.

Amen.

Praise God.

We know that's the truth.

We've got to toughen up, people.

We've got to toughen up, ladies.

We've got to toughen up, guys.

Amen.

And if you need to toughen up,

which we all do,

then I think you need a sergeant.

Amen?

Amen.

You need a sergeant for a pastor!

You don't need a pastor that is weaker than you are

or sulfur than you are,

but rather every person on this earth

needs a pastor that is more bold,

more courageous, more spiritually strong,

more bold in his speech and his actions.

A preacher, a teacher, a pastor

must be a man of courage and boldness.

If he is not, then you must flee from that wimp. (Disfellowship from pastor's that are too soft.)

Amen.

"Flee from the wimps!" said Apostle Zimmerman on December the 3rd, 2022.

You can write it down.

Flee from the wimps!

God is good.

You can keep reading.

Amen.

Verse 20.

"For I say to you that unless your righteousness surpasses"
(greater than) that of the scribes and the Pharisees,
you will not enter this citizenship,
the government of heaven, the kingdom of heaven.

You will not enter it.

You will not enter it

unless your righteousness is greater than the Pharisees.

That doesn't mean that you got to fast more than the Pharisees

because that would just be legalism

to try to fast more than the Pharisees.

That would kill you.

Amen.

Literally and spiritually,

if you try to fast more than they did,

be very bad on your health and your mind

and your mental health to fast that much.

But rather, for your righteousness

to be greater than the Pharisees,

you must believe and understand

and follow the spirit of the law.

The spirit of the law is more important

than the letter of the law.

That doesn't mean that you can sin willfully

because we know Hebrews chapter 10 speaks against that.

But the spirit of the law

is sometimes much different than,

well, it's always different from legalism.

People have got to understand

that it was against the law of God

not only to commit adultery

but even to marry an adulteress.

But yet God told Hosea to marry an adulteress.

Read it for yourself.

That's not my opinion.

That's what the Bible says.

God told Hosea to marry the adulteress woman.

But yeah, that was against God's law.

The spirit of the law is more important.

The spirit of the law is to keep yourself undefiled

from the heathen, from the sinners,

from the rebellious, from the lawless people.

But the spirit, that same spirit of the law

said to Hosea, in your individual situation,

this is what you need to do

for your witnessing to the people

and as a symbolism of what is to come.

You are to be assembled.

And it's not a sin for you.

It might be a sin for everybody else.

But it's not a sin for you, Hosea.

This is what I want you to do.

Amen.

And we can also think of Samson,

the great man of God,

a tremendous man of God,

and a great example for every dude.

Amen.

So many people are against men being men.

They're against men having their shirt off in public

when there's nothing wrong with that at all.

In biblical times, men were shirtless in public

constantly, all the time, every day,
constantly, constantly, constantly.
That was part of the culture.
And yet Jesus and the prophets and the disciples
never said one word about it.
Not one word did they ever, ever say that this was wrong.
But they definitely would have if it was wrong.
Because it was commonplace.
And Jesus never said that it's wrong for a man
to look at a single lady in lust.
He never said that.
What he said is that it's wrong to look in lust
upon a married woman.
The Greek word is for a married woman.
Of course, that's wrong.
If you know that she's married.
But people think that to be a Christian man,
the man must cut off his Peter mentally.
Mentally, never touch it again if he's a single man.
Never do anything, it's just going to rot off basically.
They want the men to be girls, to be feminine,
to button up the shirt all the way up their neck,
to zip it all the way up their neck.
It's ridiculous.
It's ridiculous what I have to fight against constantly.
The war against men.
The men's ministry is so very important.
Very important.
I'd like for all of you to be praying for the men's ministry
because the men are under attack.
Masculinity is under attack.
Samson was a man of God and he was a man of men.
A masculine man ...
and God did not say one word against it.
Not one word.
People say, yeah, Samson got blamed.
He died.
Hey, we all die. Amen.

But he died not under judgment of God
and his blindness was not from judgment from God.
It was the enemy that did it, was it not?
John the Baptist was beheaded.
Was that judgment from God?
No.
It was the enemy that did it.
Samson's blindness was not judgment from God.
Can you prove from Scripture that it's judgment from God?
But everyone, everyone, everyone, everyone of these preachers out here
and everyone of these Christians out here,
that's the thing about it.
It's not only the preachers, it's even the Christians
that say that Samson's blindness was judgment from God.
You can't prove that from Scripture!
Amen.
There's not any verse of the Bible at all that condemned Samson for anything he did.
Nothing.
In fact, Samson is listed in Hebrews 11, the faith chapter,
as being one of the heroes,
one of those that were true to God.
And even then, it never condemned him there either.
So the Bible says you've got to judge the body rightly,
not according to religious tradition.

You've got to judge rightly.
What is natural?
How did God design things?
How has mankind designed?
Amen.

You've got to consider these things. You've got to use logic and common sense
because most false theology doesn't make sense when you really, really think about it.
The truth has to make sense. If it doesn't, it's not true.
Amen.

But we see here in Matthew 5
that righteousness and the Ten Commandments, verse 21,
you should not commit murder.
Amen.

And we see here other commandments,
verse 31 about divorce, verse 27 about adultery.
He's talking about the Ten Commandments here.
Now, the seventh day is not listed in this chapter for a reason.
He was talking to his disciples.
His disciples knew about the seventh day.
And the Jews and the audience and the surrounding people,
the population of the land, they knew about all of this.
But the seventh day is something that really was not a problem
about people believing in and observing.
They were very legalistic about the Sabbath.
I'll use that word.
They were very legalistic about the seventh day Sabbath.
They were very legalistic about it, extremely legalistic about it.
So Jesus didn't really have to bring it up.
They were keeping it.
But other things were a greater problem.
Adultery was a greater problem.
Hatred, fights, arguments, murder, these things were a greater problem.
And so that's what he addressed more synthetically.
But it's very clear if you read the old chapter,
it's talking about the Ten Commandments.
Amen.

So if you realize it's talking about the Ten Commandments,
but the chapter starts out talking about blessings
and not one blessing and not two and not three,
but blessing and blessing and blessing and blessing,
just like we see in Deuteronomy.
Blessing and blessing and blessing and blessing
and cursing and cursing and cursing.
This validates that the blessings and cursings still remain to this day,
even in the New Covenant time period that we live in now.
The blessings and cursings based upon,
whether you keep the commandments of God or not,
this is still true for us today.
Amen.

Come out from those false teachers.
They may have a lot of truth,
but if they themselves at home are not keeping the Sabbath,
then they are not a true teacher
and they are not truly your brother
and they are not called to preach.
But if you continue to listen and continue to follow them,
what happens is they are encouraged by you clicking Amen,
by you clicking the thumbs up,
by you clicking the heart symbol,
by you staying a member of their audience,
that you continue to follow them,

their numbers remain high,
that encourages them to keep preaching
even though they are not called to preach.
You are contributing to their sin, absolutely.
Same thing with YouTube and visiting their websites.
You continue to keep their numbers high
by continuing to read their stuff.
That contributes to that person continuing in their false teaching.
If they've got an audience, they'll keep teaching.
It's time for you to stop being the audience of false preachers.

All right, chat room is open for anybody that has any questions.
And Brother Jared, if you've got anything to add,
as people began to type,
if anybody has any questions about anything I've said here today.
And a reminder, Hanukkah, first day, December the 19th, Monday.
Monday the 19th, that is one, two, two weeks away.
Two weeks away, that's coming up fast.

I tell you, time flies!
So let's prepare and think about what we're going to do for a special meal.
We would definitely have special worship services
Monday morning on the 19th.
And that would be the only day that we have special worship services, as far as I know.
And we'll continue to update the AOB and other work,
Dan's book, out and about sooner or later.
Pray for that, that that will be accomplished.
Brother Jared, you got anything?

A few verses.
Look at the book of 2 John verses 10-11.

"If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching,
do not receive him into your house,
and do not give him a blessing of a welcome, a Godspeed, or a blessing.
For one who gives him a welcome, a Godspeed, or a blessing,
participates in his evil works."

Amen, brother.
And when you are watching their videos and reading their websites,
you are welcoming them in your house and in your ear gates
and in your eye gates to your soul.
You welcome them in and where they do not bring the correct teachings.
But the Bible says that we are not to welcome nor bless
those people that do not bring the correct teaching.
Amen.
And we're talking about all the correct teaching, all of it,
because we should not allow one lie into us. Amen.
We need to be pushing all the lies away from us
and welcoming only the truth.
Amen.
What else, brother?

Something very interesting about the Ten Commandments
that most people don't notice because they never read the verses.
Exodus 20:1-2
"And Jesus spoke all these words."
Jesus spoke it.
He spoke the Ten Commandments.
"Saying, I am Jesus your Theos,
who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage."
Right there.
And then if you look at that last verse, Deuteronomy 28, verse 68.

If you hold your finger there and look at Deuteronomy,
Page 220.

Deuteronomy 28, verse 61.

"And Jesus will bring upon you every sickness
and every plague that is not written
and every one that is written in the scroll of this law
until he have been destroyed.
And you shall be left few in number,
whereas you were as the stars of the sky and multitude previously.
You did not listen and obey to the voice of Jesus your Theos.
And it shall come to pass that as Jesus rejoiced over you
to do you good and to multiply you,
so will Jesus rejoice over you to destroy you
and you shall be quickly removed from the land
into which you go to inherit it.
And Jesus your Theos shall scatter you among all nations
from one end of the earth to the other
and you shall there serve other gods,
wood and stone, which you had not known nor your fathers.
Moreover, among those nations he will not give you quiet or peace,
neither by any means shall the sole of your foot have rest
and Jesus will give you there another
and misgiven heart and failing eyes and a wasting soul.
And your life shall be in suspense before your eyes
and shall be afraid by day and by night
and you shall have no assurance of your life.
In the morning you shall say, I would that it would be evening
and in the evening you will say, I would that it would be morning
for the fear of your heart with which you shall fear
and for the sights of your eyes which you shall see
and Jesus will bring you back to Egypt in ships
by the way of which I said, you shall not see it again
but you shall be so there to your enemies for bondmen and bondwomen
and none should buy you."

In other words, there is captivity promised for us
if we do not keep the commandments of the Lord.
The Great Tribulation and World War III that is near at hand,
it will include captivity.
God brought us out of Egypt, God brought us out of Babylon,
God brought us out of Assyria and yet He will bring us back
to Egypt and Assyria and Saudi Arabia and Syria
if the people do not repent.
The land of Israel, the land of America, Canada,
the British Empire, England, Scotland, Ireland, Australia, South Africa,
this is the land of Israel, this is the land of Israel.
And this land of Israel, the British Empire and America,
will absolutely be under captivity
and they will be taking slaves, men and women,
back to the Middle East and to Russia and to China
and to Venezuela as slaves.
Amen. That is going to happen.
A lot of these prophecies are dual.
They were fulfilled thousands of years ago and will be fulfilled again.
History repeats itself and the Bible repeats itself.
Biblical events repeat itself.
And this will absolutely occur, I promise you,
that there's going to be captivity and slavery
for many, many Americans and British
and white people and black people and brown and yellow and red
all around the world because they rejected
the seventh day and the biblical holy days
and also because people did not pay their tithes

because that's also a commandment, even if it's not one of the Ten Commandments.

It is a commandment and Hebrews 7 is very clear that it continues into the New Covenant time.

And the spirit of the law is very logical that the spirit of love is that you would want to support the ministry, the church, the true pastors, the true teachers, because the ministry does not run for free. I have to pay the electric bill.

The other pastors have to be paid. The deacons have to be paid as far as paying their rent, their food and their medicine.

That's what I'm talking about when I say they have to be paid, is that we pay. This ministry pays their rent, their food, their medicine, because in Africa there's no jobs, very little, very little, very little.

And it's a struggle to live one day at a time. And this ministry takes care of them.

And that takes money. It takes money to have the website, to do the AOB, to do the radio station. That's not free for me.

It takes money. That's the reality of life. That's the reality of the modern era. And I rarely

ever, ever mention money at all to the ministry people, to the people that listen. I rarely ever mention it. But it is the commandment of God. So I have to mention it sometime or another.

I'm not going to just turn a blind eye and totally ignore it.

It is a commandment of the Lord that in the spirit of the law loving your brothers and your sisters to support the ministries, to support the work of the Church, to support the Kingdom of God, that is the law of love.

Amen. And to put others before yourself. Amen.

What else, brother? The very last verse in the Old Testament. The last verse in the last chapter.

All right. The last verse of the Bible of what was written thousands of years ago, Revelation 22.

And they moved it around in the Masoretic.

In the book of Malachi, the last verse.

Malachi 4. Oh, you're talking about Old Testament. Yeah. I thought you meant Revelation.

Malachi, I misunderstood.

The last verse of Malachi.

The last verse of Malachi, let's turn there.

Malachi 4:1 "For the day is coming, burning as a furnace, and it shall consume them.

That's the opposite of the wicked living forever.

The fire will consume them, and all the strangers do wickedly, shall be stubble, and the day that is coming shall burn them, burn them up,

say of the Lord Jesus Almighty, and there shall not be left of them root or branch."

Nothing left of those people. That's the opposite of them living forever.

Verse 2, "But to you that fear my name, shall the son of righteousness", (that is a term for Jesus),

"He shall arise, and healing shall be in his wings, and you shall go forth as

bound as young calves let loose from bonds, and you shall trample the wicked."

Oh, that sounds very loving, doesn't it?

"You shall trample on the wicked, for there shall be ashes underneath your feet in the day which

I appoint, say of the Almighty Jesus.

And behold, I'm going to send you Elijah the Tishbite before the great and glorious day of Jesus comes."

Footnote, Elijah will not literally be coming back physically, but John the baptizer came in the symbolic role or office of Elijah, and the end time two witnesses will also be coming in the same symbolic role of Elijah. It is not a reincarnation. John was not literally Elijah, but rather it was symbolic of Elijah.

Verse 6,
and this Elijah "shall turn again the heart of the Father to the Son, and the heart of mankind toward his neighbor, to love his neighbor, lest I come and smite the earth grievously. Be in remembrance of the law of Moses, my servant, as I commanded him, with his statutes and judgments at Herod, at Sinai, for all of Israel."

We are spiritual Israel today. You are, even if you are a Gentile, you are still Israel, according to the book of Romans. Absolutely you are spiritual Israel if you're truly, if you're truly saved and truly baptized in Jesus' name, and not a Gentile version of Jesus' name, but rather the true Jesus' name, and if you keep the commandments, then you are spiritual Israel. Now notice the context of Elijah coming back in the end time. This is not primarily talking about John the Baptizer, even though most people say that it is primarily talking about John the Baptizer. John the Baptizer was a partial fulfillment of this, but not the primary fulfillment, because the primary, the main fulfillment is in the end time, just before the great and glorious day of the Lord comes. Amen? So this is talking about the two witnesses. This is talking about the two witnesses... The two witnesses will definitely have a great part in the fulfillment of this prophecy, therefore it's talking about the end time. And yet, even though it's talking about the end time, it is saying to remember the law of Moses. That's what it says. Amen? And his statutes and his judgments, his laws, now of course we know the circuses and unclean meats and animal sacrifices are done away with because we've got to read the whole Bible. But the law that was delivered to Moses directly from the mouth of Jesus concerning the law of the Ten Commandments and tithes, that still exists, and that is what God wants us to continue to remember even until this day. Amen? We've got to read the whole thing. We don't really understand the Bible unless we read the whole thing and read it and read it and study it and read it slowly, not quickly, not in a hurry to finish the chapter of the day, but read it slowly and carefully, making sure we understand it and cross-referencing as we read. So when we're reading the Bible, we're really studying the Bible. That's very important. A lot of people don't do that. Most people don't do that, and that's why they don't understand it.

And then you've got people that study the Bible and they still don't understand it because they don't have the Holy Ghost. They don't have the Holy Ghost.

And so that's a perfect example of some man I saw recently that was teaching on Facebook that Jesus will not come back until the end of the 1,000 years. That's stupid. That is stupid as stupid as stupid can get. How can you get that? And yet it's very clear that he studied the Bible and read the Bible very clear because he had written down multitudes of scriptures, multitudes of scriptures written down, and yet he believes that's a stupid thing. So you can read the Bible, whatever word of it, and still not understand it if you don't have the Holy Ghost. And you can cross-reference and cross-reference and cross-reference and write down scripture and take notes and still not understand it and still get it all wrong if you do not have the Holy Ghost. So that's why baptism is extremely important because that's when you receive the Holy Ghost, most people. And you have to be baptized in Jesus' true name not in the Trinity, not in the Trinity formula not in a Gentile version translation wrong translation of Jesus' name but rather truly in Jesus' name. All you people in Algeria, Apostle Ehud, Pastor Moshe, I want you to make for sure that the people that have been baptized was baptized in Jesus' name and not in a Gentile version of that name. It needs to be how we pronounce it in English. Jesus. Amen. And that's not a Z sound in front. A lot of Gentiles think it's a Z sound. It's not a Z. Je is like the English letter G and that has an E sound to it. G has an E sound to it. It's like a G-E. The J-E in the first part of the name Jesus sounds like a G-E. And then it's "Je's- us". Like the angels said, God with us. G's us. God with us. Amen. And that proves He's God, right there just by His name alone. Because it means God with us. G with us. Amen. That proves He's God just right there!

Now the reason that the Pharisees and the Jews did not recognize Jesus as being the name of God when He was walking on earth and everybody was calling Him Jesus. And His mama and His daddy and His brothers and His sisters. He did have brothers and sisters. Absolutely. He was the firstborn of Mary. But she did have girls and boys after that. James, one of them, was His brother. And they were all calling Him Jesus. And everybody at school was calling Him Jesus. And all of His buddies that He played with in the streets were calling Him Jesus. The reason that they did not recognize that was the name of God is because the Pharisees were not worshiping Jesus. They was worshiping the letter Y names. They was worshiping Yahweh. That's why they didn't recognize the name of Jesus as being God. Amen. Amen. Because they had learned the Assyrian language in the Assyrian and Babylonian captivities and was forced to learn the Assyrian language and to use only the Assyrian language and to rewrite the Bible in the Assyrian language and to remove the name of Jesus. So they had forgotten the name of Jesus. And they did not recognize it. They had forgotten it over a period of hundreds of years of brainwashing and programming under Islamic doctrine. Sunset to sunset. And other Islamic doctrines, the Islamic calendar, the Islamic language and culture had completely taken over the Jewish people. Completely. That's why they did not recognize His name. About who He was by His name. Amen. That's logical. Amen.
