

Full Sermon Transcript: Easter versus Passover April 8, 2023 (4th day of Unleavened Bread)

Now that sound of the trumpet, the ram's horn, but so far, is to announce a gathering when the people are commanded to gather together. They would blow it if there was an enemy coming near the village. They would blow it. They would also blow it when they first see the moon returning from darkness because you have two or three days each month where there is no moon at all. And they would be out watching for the return of the moon, which would be the first day of the biblical month. Because the word month comes from the word moon. And so when the moon returned, it would be the new month, the new moon. And they call it the new moon now, but it's the first day of the biblical month on those days. That's not today, but that's another time when they would blow the horn.

And whenever there was a major event or war, they would blow the horns for war. They would blow the horns for different reasons. Amen. We blow it today because it is a gathering of people. Amen. Praise God.

But it is a time for the chosen people and the called people to gather. Amen. We don't gather with the world on this day. Amen.

We're not inviting people to watch football or basketball. We're here as a people who are called and chosen by God, statistically, out of the world, out of the midst of the world to be separate. To be a separated people. To be a separate people set apart for His name. Amen. And so we gather here today as a people that are called out of the world. The word church in the Bible was the Greek word ekklesia or ecclesia.

Different people pronounce it different ways, but both are appropriate. Ekklesia or ecclesia. And that Greek word means called out people. Called out ones.

And that's where what we call the church today is that we are called out. So we use the word church today. People think the word church, you know the word church is so watered down, but the Bible does describe the synagogue which is also a word for a gathering of people.

The word synagogue means gathering or assembly. And that was the synagogue of Satan that the Bible describes and also describes the church of God. So there's really only two churches even though you read about literally thousands of churches in this world.

In God's eyes there's only two churches and that's it. And that is the synagogue of Satan, the gathering, the assembly of the false Christians and other people, other religions, the Hindus, the Buddhas, the Muslims, whatever. They're as the same as the false Christians.

And then you've got the true church. And that's it. Only two churches. The true, true church of God and then all the rest of humanity. All false religion falls under the category of the synagogue of Satan.

All false religion including false Christianity. That would be the Christians and the preachers and the churches that believe that God is a trinity. And that worship on Sunday and that worship on Easter and that worship on Christmas and that have the Christmas trees and that exchange Christmas gifts.

All of that is the world. The synagogue of Satan which the Bible also calls Babylon. The system of Babylon, the religion of Babylon. And then you've got the true church which is a very small church.

The Bible says that Jesus called the church the little flock. The little flock. He didn't call the

church the megachurch. But rather the little flock.

We are the called out ones. The called out from the world. That's not doing all that pagan false religion. But rather we are observing the true sabbath and the true holy days that we actually read about in the Bible. That sets us as being way different, very different from the world. Amen.

And we are not to have church fellowship with the world who has not surrendered to the truth. To Christ Jesus. Because even though they say that they know Him and even though they are really good at smiling and joking and shaking hands and gathering together.

Even though they are really good at those things. The Bible says if you do not keep My commandments and you say that you know Me but you keep not My commandments then you do not know Me and you are a liar. This is what the Bible says. That's not what I say. That's what the Bible says. Amen.

The truth is we also have the scripture of 2 Corinthians 6. What fellowship does light have with darkness? Amen.

It says right there in that verse right there. To come out from them. To be separate. To be set apart. Amen.

So the people have to be tested. God is testing every one of us. How set apart are we going to be? How set apart are we going to be? How far are we willing to go for the Lord?

The Bible says that if you are not willing to forsake your father, your mother, your brother, your sister, whoever. Whatever is in that list. Whatever is not in that list is still part of the list spiritually. On the spiritual level.

And the spiritual principle behind that list in Luke 14 26. Even though it does not say boyfriends and girlfriends and stuff like that. We know it is there. We know it is including them. That we must be willing to, willing to forsake anyone and everything. Anyone, in fact everyone. If necessary. If necessary. To be set apart. To be different. To be holy. To not touch the unclean.

Matthew 10 describes Jesus talking about that He would even cause division within our homes. Even a man divided with his own dad and so forth and so forth.

Division in our homes. Not caused by Satan but caused by Jesus. The Bible actually describes this. Amen.

People don't like my preaching for one reason because I actually give these Bible verses that they hate. That's the reality. They don't like these particular Bible verses. It upsets them.

Because it's not the Jesus that they know. The Jesus that they know is the typical Christian Jesus. False image of Jesus. That never offends. Never upsets. Does not call out people's names and sins. Does not call out sin. Does not point out sin. Does not condemn. Does not require sainthood and perfection and striving against sin.

Their Jesus is a very weak, soft, gentle, effeminate, homosexual type of characteristic.

It's not the Jesus of the Bible. It upsets them. When I say the same things that Jesus said.

Calling people hypocrites. Calling people dogs and snakes and swine. When I say the same words that Jesus did, they hate me with a passion.

And they will also hate you with a passion once you start acting like Jesus as well.

Oh, it's easy for them to love you while you compromise with them and while you please them and be careful not to offend them.

Oh, it's easy to get along with people then. It's easy to coexist and to have friends and family while you're not ruffling the feathers the wrong way. Amen.

If you're petting them gently. If you're petting them like a dog or a cat gently and trying to get

along with them and not upsetting them by any means at all. It's easy to get along with. If you don't have a passion for Christ. If you don't have a passion for the truth. Amen. But if you have a passion for Christ and His truth, what fellowship does light have with darkness?

If it's dark in the room and you turn on the light switch, the darkness flees.

The more that you have Christ in you and His light and His truth and His word, your family and your friends, they will flee or else you will flee because the light and the darkness cannot get along with each other. Can't.

The darkness and the light are enemies. The darkness and the light are not friends. They're not even family.

Even though you may have been born and raised in a family of flesh and blood, our real family according to Jesus are those that do the will of the Father.

His own mom and His own brother came trying to get in wherever He was meeting with His disciples and the disciples instead of letting them in. His own mom. His own brother. This is in the Bible. Again, this is a Bible verse that Christians don't like.

It's not the Jesus they know because the Jesus they know is not the Jesus of the Bible. It's the Jesus of false religion. But His own mom and His own brother wanted to get in and they wouldn't let them in. And of course we know they were good people. Amen.

And what did Jesus say when He learned of this instead of saying, What? Why are you holding them back? Instead of saying, Why are you holding them back? How come you have not yet let them in? How come you're asking My permission to let them in?

Instead, His reaction was this. Who is My mom? Who is My brother?, but He that does the will of the Father? That was His response.

Our family is not flesh and blood because even worms have flesh and blood. Amen. Or birds or squirrels or rats have and swine have flesh and blood. And they got brothers and sisters. Even a pig has brothers and sisters. Even a snake has brothers and sisters. Amen.

But our brothers and sisters, be careful who you call brother. Amen. Be careful who you call sister. Because our brothers and sisters are those that do the will of the Father. That includes the biblical holy days that are in the Bible.

Passover. The days of unleavened bread. These seven days that we're in right now. Not eating any bread product that has leavening in it. Baking soda and baking powder and sodium bicarbonate and so forth. Yeast.

Who else is doing this? Most of the world is not doing this because they are not set apart. And it's in the Bible to do this but they're not doing it because they don't like that Bible verse.

Amen.

Oh that's Old Testament. That's Old Testament. We just read last time we gathered together here we read a New Testament verse saying to do this. But they don't like that verse and they would never read that verse. Amen. Because it goes against what they've been taught by ignorant pastors. Amen.

That verse where actually Paul is writing let us keep the feast. Talking about the Feast of Unleavened Bread. Very clear in the context the Feast of Unleavened Bread. New Testament verse.

But the pastors will not ever ever ever read that in the gathering of the false Christians because it will prove them wrong. It will prove them wrong. It will prove them as fake Christians.

Even how you get saved. People think they are saved because they said a prayer. But in Acts 2 verse 37 and 38 Peter had been speaking. It convicted them of their sins. It pierced their hearts. It didn't make them feel good.

It pierced their hearts. It convicted them. They felt convicted of their guilt. Of their faults. Even of false religion. It did. Absolutely. And it said what must we do? In other words, how do we get saved? What do we do to save ourselves or to get saved?

And Peter did not say repeat the words after me or just confess with your mouth or just say a prayer. But rather he said repent and be baptized for the forgiveness of your sins, for the remission of your sins and then you will receive the Holy Ghost. Then. At baptism. Amen. But the churches today they will put words in your mouth and you just repeat my words. It's not even words out of your own heart. Just repeat my words and then you are saved.

Not even a requirement of baptism even though Peter said repent and be baptized. Even though Mark 16:16 also says to be baptized. Even though John 3 also says to be baptized and so forth and so forth and so forth.

But forget all those verses because those are not the verses they like. Those are not the verses they pick and choose. So let's just forget that. And this type of preaching upsets them because it convicts them that they are guilty and they don't want to repent. That's why it upsets them. Amen.

They are guilty and they don't want to repent. They don't want to change. They want false religion. They want easy tickle the ear religion. They want the false Jesus that does not convict the heart. That does not pierce the heart. That does not point out their sin.

They want to believe they are already saved. Even though they have either never been baptized or they got baptized by a false preacher. How is that salvation?

A false preacher that believes in a trinity, a three headed monster god, a Greek mythological god with three heads. He or she does not have the authority of Christ to baptize anyone or even to preach or to lead a congregation.

He only has the authority of Satan to lead the congregation, the synagogue of Satan. But such a preacher that believes in the trinity or believes in Sunday worship or Christmas or Easter or Halloween or other major false doctrines like that.

Satan has no authority in Christ to lead the true church, a true Christian, a person that loves the Bible, that loves the Scriptures, that wants the truth and willing to surrender to the truth, to do the Father's will.

So if you have been baptized in traditional religion or you prayed into traditional religion or so called got saved in traditional religion, brother you are not saved.

And that is step number one is to realize that you are not saved. That you need the true Jesus, the Alpha Jesus, the Alpha and the Omega Jesus. That that is the Jesus that you need and confess that you are a sinner and you have been lost and you have been brainwashed and you have been deceived by false religion and you have been gathering with false Christians.

Even though you love those people, even though you love mommy and daddy and brother and sister, even though you love those people, they are all lost. We have to wake up to this reality, confess it to ourselves and confess it to each other and confess it to God.

Then and only then can we really start surrendering to the Alpha and the Omega. Really start surrendering to Him and committing to Him and being set apart and being willing to separate ourselves from them, from those people that hate the truth. That despise the truth and we will

absolutely hate you once you start telling them the truth. Amen.

Time and time and over and over and over again. Sixteen years of preaching here and every one of these years this has been my experience. I have talked to people all over the world in every corner of the globe.

And it is the same thing every time. Oh, I will talk to my preacher and it is going to be okay and they are going to accept the truth.

And then they go and talk to their preacher, they go and talk to their pastor, they go talk to their deacon and they give them the Bible verses.

And the deacon and the pastor and the preacher never repent but rather they say, you are following a cult. You are deceived.

Because we gave them the Bible verses that they hate. Because we gave them the Bible verses that they absolutely refuse to believe even though it is a very simple and very clear and very direct Bible verse.

They will call us a cult because we believe the Bible and they don't. The truth is they are the cult. Amen.

They are the cult of Satan, the sin of God of Satan. Sometimes very rarely, very extremely rarely a person is able to find a true brother that is rather a brother of the flesh or a brother or a mother of the flesh or a father of the flesh that is willing to accept the truth with them.

That is very rare but it does happen. Praise Jesus. But it is very rare, extremely rare, almost never. That is how rare it is.

That you would actually be able to find somebody else that is willing to accept the truth because the true church is a little flock.

The true church doesn't have number one best seller books on the top 100 sellers list. It ain't going to happen. Ain't going to happen. The truth is not popular. Amen.

With all of that said, let's do a short prayer and then we'll get into sermon number two. Amen. Praise God. Let's pray.

Lord, Heavenly Father, thank you, Lord, for pointing out our sins and our foolishness and our worldly ways. Thank you, Father, for showing us the truth, for shining your light in the darkness that we may clearly see things the way they really are.

Please help us, Lord, to embrace more of your light, more of your truth, more of your presence and true salvation.

Please help us, Lord, to be steadfast and strong in the truth and to develop a passion for the truth.

Please help us to be willing to give up things that we really don't want to give up in the flesh, but we need to give up so that we may be surrendered to you and put you first and the truth first.

Please help us to become real men and real women, the way that you created. Your natural design, your perfect design, mature and strong.

Help us, Lord, to come out from wicked people, wicked gatherings, wicked households, households of darkness, households that serve a false Jesus.

Help us, Lord, for the young men to grow up, leave mommy and daddy. Please, Lord, help us. We are an upside down society, so corrupted, so wrong.

The society we live in now is so wicked, so wrong, so defiled, so corrupted. Help us, Lord, how we can be healed and delivered as much as possible from this corrupted way of life.

Help us to follow your direction. Please, Lord, help us. Please anoint the rest of this sermon,

the rest of this service. Have your way, Father. Put your words in my mouth.

Help us, Lord, to grow in understanding and the truth. May your will and your spirit prevail in this and your word not return void nor vain, but accomplish the purpose which forth it is set.

So be it in Jesus' name. Amen.

And the congregation said, "Amen."

All right. Let's turn to the book of Judges, and that is in the history volume if you have the paperbacks of the Alpha and the Maker Bible. And this is Judges chapter 2, page 27.

And this would be the sixth book of the Bible, right after, no, it's actually, I guess, the seventh book of the Bible, right after Joshua, which is after Deuteronomy.

Judges chapter 2. And I'm also going to open up this same verse in another version of the Bible. I've got New American Standard here, the latest update of New American Standard that came out a year or two ago.

I'm going to look at that one as well. In fact, I'm going to read that one first in New American Standard. Judges 2, verse 13. Judges 2, 13 in the New American Standard, which reads very, very similar to the King James in this verse.

Judges 2:13: "They abandoned the Lord, God, the true God, the God of Israel. The people did forsake, abandoned Jesus. And instead they served Baal and Ashtoreth.

Now who is Baal and who is Ashtoreth? Basically, to make it as easy to understand as possible, the Baal is Satan.

Now Ashtoreth, people have different interpretations and opinions, but a lot of times it's thought of as being a wooden symbol or wooden statue of the female goddess, false god, Asherah, or something like that, Asherah or Astaroth or Astarte.

And there's different ways of spelling it and there's different ways of pronouncing it because as you go through the different empires that Daniel saw with the head of God in Daniel 2, King Nebuchadnezzar was the head of God, that was the Babylonian empire.

Then you have the different, the chest and the arms in different parts of the statue that Daniel saw. Each part representing the next time era, the next empire that would come upon the earth.

And as you go through these different empires, they would change the names and the pronunciations and the spellings, but it was still the same female goddesses, mother god, which some modern religions still believe in.

Some of the religions in Korea and Japan and Africa, certain places, even in America, there are people that believe in a mother god or a half male, half female god. It's crazy stuff that people fall for. People are so gullible.

But the female god, however you spell it or pronounce it, in the different empires and time periods in history, there's a lot of agreement among people that are willing to be set apart, that are willing to leave traditional religion that have looked into these histories of this word.

And the conclusion that is absolute and undeniable is that in our modern times, the spelling and the pronunciation would be Easter. Easter. Tomorrow, Sunday, is Easter.

Where did the word Easter come from? When were your Sunday preacher and your Trinity preacher, have they ever brought up the subject of what the word Easter means? And where it comes from? Of course not. They would never bring that up, because if you bring that up, then the people would have to repent. So they're not going to bring that up.

That doesn't fit the image of their false Jesus. Amen. Because they love Easter. They've been taught that's the resurrection of Christ. They've been taught that's something you do if you're

a Christian. But you can search the entire Bible.

And there's no such example, no such biblical example of any of the true prophets of God or the apostles or the disciples, the apostle Paul, Peter, Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, none of them, absolutely none of them, observed, celebrated Easter. None of them. Why not?

The resurrection of Christ, should we not celebrate that? The book of Deuteronomy, if you keep your finger here, and look at the book of Deuteronomy, which is the fifth book of the Bible, it's the last book of the law, Deuteronomy.

Chapter 12, verse 30, and we may go up a little bit. Everybody please turn with me. I hope you brought your Bibles. Always bring your Bibles when you're coming to gather together for worship service. Amen. Amen. Always bring your Bibles.

And even if you don't have an Alpha and Omega Bible, bring whatever Bible you got and let's read the Bible. Because I don't want you to think that this is me. This is not me, this is the Bible. This is what the Bible says.

Amen. And so chapter 12, verse 30, and let's go back up to, let's start up with verse 28.

Verse 28, "Beware and listen and obey. And you should do all the commands which I charge you, that it may be well with you and your sons forever, if you should do that which is pleasing and good before Jesus your Theos, your God."

Like Jesus said, who is my mom, who is my brother, but he that does the will of the Father.

Right? So right here, in this verse, we have to do what is the will of the Father. We have to do what is pleasing and good.

And so, it's more than just believing. It's more than just praying. It's more than going to church and reading the Bible. But rather, it's obedience to God's commandments. Amen.

And verse 29, "And if Jesus your Theos, your God, shall utterly destroy the nations." Now that word nations can also be translated Gentiles. And you can study that for yourself if you don't want to take my words for it. You can study that out for yourself. You can get a Strong's concordance or you can go to blueletterbible.org or .com. I think both of those addresses work. Or Biblehub.com or studylight.org. There's all kinds of websites where you can look at these words and how they were originally written and what they mean.

And so, this is talking about nations that did not serve the true God. Heathen nations. And for the most part, it has always been, even today, the Gentile nations. The nations that are not white people.

That are not Israelite people. That are not of the Hebrew ancestry. That have the voodoo and the witchcraft and the Hinduism and the Buddhism and two thousand gods and three headed gods and so forth. Amen.

And there was literally three headed gods. Literally. There is an origin for everything. An origin. You should always ask, what is the origin? What is the beginning of a certain doctrine or a certain religious belief or even a religious word? What is the origin of it? Always ask that. Always. Amen.

So, if Jesus destroyed these nations that was not serving the God of Israel, to whom you go in there to inherit it, God gives his people, Israel, those lands. The land that they call Palestine and Canaan and different lands.

And even America. When God brought the pilgrims over here and other Europeans over here and then eventually started to be at war with the so-called Native American Indians, which are really from the ancestry of India.

And I know that they say that Christopher Columbus was wrong when he called them Indians because they only looked like Indians but they're not real Indians. That's what we're told. I

know. I'm not ignorant about these things.

But they confess that they came from Asia. Well, they're not Koreans. They're not Chinese. Amen. If they came from Asia, what part of Asia? Amen.

You look at their skin color, their facial characteristics, their religion, their culture, everything they do. The Native American Indians, they're Indians from India. They don't have the Chinese culture. They don't have the Chinese color. They have the Indian culture, the Indian color. Amen.

So, God brought the white people, the Israelites, into the Americas because the Indians here in this land was practicing witchcraft and serving thousands of gods and worshipping the creation rather than the Creator.

It was judgment upon them which they deserved and I can say this as a person that has ancestry of the so-called Native American Indians on my mom's side and the Jews on my dad's side.

So, I have an Indian blood but even if I did not have Indian blood, I could still say this because it's the truth. Amen.

So, when we come into a nation of heathens that, worshipping false gods, we come into their land, verse 29, "and you shall inherit that land and dwell in that land," verse 30, "take heed." That means be careful to yourself, "and guard yourself that you would not seek to follow after them in the same manner which they are destroyed before you. Saying, 'How do these nations act for their gods? I will do likewise.'"

But this is actually what the people did, the Israelites did, when they went into the land of Assyria, when they went into Babylon, when they went into Egypt and different nations, they embraced Easter and Christmas and Sunday and Trinity and all these false religious doctrines of traditional religion.

It came from somewhere. There is an origin. Amen. And the origin of Christmas and Easter is not the birth and death and resurrection of Christ. And that's the truth. You can look it up in the encyclopedia. You can go to history.com or .org, whatever it is, the History Channel. You can go to an encyclopedia of whatever, any of the encyclopedias.

It's not hidden. It's there. If you would just take the time to research it, you can see the absolute undeniable proof, absolute undeniable proof that Christmas and Easter both were being celebrated, of course, under different names.

They would call them something different. But on the same date, in the same mannerism, the same technique of worship, Easter sunrise service, Easter eggs, the bunny rabbit, the whole works, Christmas gifts, Christmas feasts, Christmas tree, all the different same things on the same date and surrounding days.

Before the birth of Christ, thousands of years before the birth of Christ. This is the truth. And there's no doubt to it. If you're willing to look, if you're willing to be honest and sincere in your research, you cannot deny this.

And if you try to deny it, you're of the devil. Because the truth is so clear, it cannot be denied. But yet people say, well, that's why they were doing Christmas. That's why they were doing Easter is because of false gods. But I'm not doing it because of false gods. I'm doing it for Christ. That don't make no sense.

You're serving the devil, but not for the devil. You're serving the devil for God. That don't make no sense. And of course, I'm not serving the devil for God. I'm serving God for God by doing the same thing that the devil worshippers did. But it's for God for God.

I literally feel like throwing up right now. I literally do.

People think they can honor God and worship God with something that is dirty, defiled, nasty, abomination to God. Things that God said, don't do. Well, I'm going to do it anyway in your honor, Lord.

That don't make no sense. God said, don't do it. And you say, "I'll do it anyway, Lord! Because I love you!" "Don't do it, son." "I'm going to do it because I love you, Lord!" And that's exactly how ridiculous it is. Crazy.

And yet you still say they love the Lord. What do they love? God or false religion? This is the preaching that you need to be sharing. We're going to have a full transcript in writing. Every word I say today is going to be in writing. Print that out. Share it with them. Give them this audio. Give them this audio file. We're recording it. It's going to be saved. You're going to be able to download it and save it on your phone, on your computer. Give them this audio. They're not going to like it. Most of them. Most of them, they're going to be not answering your phone calls anymore. They're not going to like this because it points out how silly they are and how demonic they are and how much they hate the truth. It points out their darkness, their sins, the fact that they're lost and not saved. They're like, but I prayed. I did pray. Isaiah 1 says, I'm tired of your prayers and I'm not going to hear your prayers. And when you pray to me, I'm going to turn my head. That's what Isaiah 1 says. God does not accept every prayer just because you're praying. He does not accept every prayer. The Bible says in Isaiah 1, He'll turn His head away from you when you pray to Him. Because you're doing it as a hypocrite. God does not accept all prayers and all worship. He only accepts your prayers and your worship only when your prayers and worship are clean and holy unto Him.

Not clean and holy unto Easter and Trinity and all that. That's not clean and holy. That's defiled. That's an abomination.

It is the same equal and probably even more and greater abomination than homosexuality. Even though homosexuality is a grave abomination.

But to do Christmas and Easter or believe in a Trinity is even worse because you're in a form of worship toward Baal and Easter.

It says don't do this.

Verse 31, "You shall not do so to your Theos, your God, for they have sacrificed to their gods the abominations of Jesus which He hates. For they burn their sons and their daughters in fire to their gods."

And you say, oh but we're not sacrificing children.

Well the truth is you are. When you tell and raise your children to do Christmas and Easter and you raise your children in lies, lies, you straight-out lie that Christmas is His birth and Easter is His resurrection and you brainwash your children in those lies and raise them to worship the devil, then yes, you're sacrificing them to the devil. You absolutely are.

In verse 32, "Every word that I command you this day, which is keep the Sabbath and keep the holy days, this you shall observe to do. And you should not add to it nor diminish or take away from it." This is what the Bible says. Amen.

The Bible commands us, it doesn't suggest, it commands us to do the Passover and never does it command us to do Easter.

It commands us to do the Feast of Tabernacles and Purim and Hanukkah, but it never commands us to do Christmas.

And yet the Bible says, do what I tell you to do and don't add nor take away from it and yet that's exactly what the false Christians are doing. Amen. Exactly what they're doing. Amen. This is not, Pastor Tim, what I say, but this is what the Bible says. You can read it with your own eyes and yet people still won't believe what I'm saying even though I'm reading out of the Bible. Amen.

Going back to Judges 2 now. Judges chapter 2 now. Verse 13, let's go in the AOB now. The AOB, they provoked Jesus and forsook Him and they served God, namely the Easter. Amen. Because like I said, the spelling and pronunciations have changed throughout the decades and centuries and millenniums, but I'm translating it the way that we would translate it today if we're translating it correctly. It's talking about Easter.

They gave up the God of Israel and started serving Easter way back in Old Testament times, even before Christ was born, died, and resurrected. Easter has nothing to do with His resurrection. Nothing.

What does Easter eggs have to do with Christ? Nothing. It has nothing to do with Christ. So how can you say you're serving Christ with something that has nothing to do with Christ? Amen.

And there's many other such examples in the Bible where this word should be translated as Easter. Many such. Let's go over to 1 Kings 11.

And again, I'm going to also read first of all from New American Standard, which is in these particular verses, almost identical or pretty identical to the King James. There's not that much difference in these particular verses.

And then I will read in the AOB, also in 1 Kings 11, give you a page number.

1 Kings 11.

Page 113 if you have the Alpha and Omega Bible. 1 Kings 11. Now we're going to do verse 4. I'm going to read first in the New American Standard. 1 Kings 11 verse 4 and 5.

"For when Solomon was old, his wives turned his heart away to follow other gods."

Men, be warned, his wives turned his heart away to follow other gods, and his heart was not wholly devoted to the Lord his God as the heart of his father David had been.

"For Solomon became a follower of Ashtoreth, the goddess of the Sidonians, and of Milcom, the abhorrent idol of the Amalites."

Now I'm going to read that in the AOB.

Verse 4. "And it came to pass in the time of the old age of Solomon that his heart was not perfect with Jesus his Theos as had been the heart of David his father, but his heart was to Easter the abomination of the Sidonians." Amen.

So Solomon allowed women, and it's not wrong that Solomon loved women and dated women and had relationship with women and married women. That was not the problem because the Bible definitely allows that.

God gave men sexual desire and a lot of it. And David had a lot of wives as well. And yet it says here that David's heart was perfect before God.

The number of wives is not even the problem. David had multiple wives, a ton of wives, and yet right here it shines a great light upon David as David being the good example.

The problem is not women and multiple wives, but rather the problem is the wrong wives and allowing those wives to speak too much and allowing those wives to lead him in the religion. That's the problem.

That's the problem because it is the man that should be the leader of religion and the head of the house and leading the woman and the head of the woman. Amen. And women need to learn to be quiet.

In this day and time, because of the radical feminism that rose up in the 1960s and got worse every decade since then and got a whole lot worse during the Obama years and now the Biden years.

And what happens in America influences the whole wide world. But really it's coming out of Russia and China because they have implanted this into the American society for the purpose of ruining, destroying the morals and values of America to destroy the entire society so that the communist militaries can come in and invade and take over America.

And they have confessed to this many different times, many different Russian people, communist official party. They have said this publicly and they have written it in book after book after book after book. This is the truth. Everything I just said.

You don't have to believe me. If you're willing to study and research with a sincere heart for the real truth, then you'll find the absolute undeniable proof of everything I just said.

The corruption of the American family and society is because Russia and China and Syria implanted it into the American society even as they did the COVID virus worldwide.

They did it to destroy the family, to destroy society, to destroy the freedom of the world so that they can conquer the world with communism.

The problem is that Solomon allowed the women to lead him away from the true God of Israel and led him off into Buddhism and Hinduism and all the other false gods including Christmas and three headed gods.

And I'm literally talking literally three headed gods and the mother god. And time after time after time and the notes I'm going to post on social media will give you even more examples. But right there is enough examples. Right there. Right there. That's enough examples. How many examples do you need?

But I will give you more biblical examples of the same word translated as Easter in the AOB once I post these notes in social media. Once the sermon is finished.

But instead of going through all those multiple examples, we'll just skip to Ezekiel.

Let's go to the book of Ezekiel chapter 8.

And see women don't like my preaching is very clearly why. Amen. Women don't like to be put in their place in their proper gender role.

Women today in our society all across the world like to think that they're equal to men in every aspect and they want equal time to talk and even more time to talk than the men. And they will overrule the men and make the men scared of them.

Every one of you know I'm speaking the truth. Every one of you knows I'm speaking the truth. Women in our society which was the culture of India. India is where the woman was the head of the house and still is today in much of India.

And it has corrupted from Russia, from India, from other cultures coming into America. When you come into the Israelite nations, you should not be corrupting and bringing in your false culture and your demonic culture and your heathen culture and defiling our culture. You should not be doing that.

There's a reason why there are borders to nations. There are reasons why God put you in the nation that He put you in. There's a reason why there are divisions of colors and races and languages.

And it's not just only the sins that happened at Babylon at the Tower of Babel. It's not just that. There are reasons for the national, different national borders.

We can do a whole other sermon on that. But you won't like it. I guarantee you that.

Ezekiel 8 verse 15. "And he said to me, son of humans or son of mankind, you have seen but you shall yet see evil practices greater than these. Even worse than the sins you've already seen."

Verse 16. "And he brought me into the inner core of the house of Jesus at the entrance of the temple of Jesus before the porch, between the porch and the altar were about 20 men with their backs toward the temple of Jesus and these worshiped the sun towards the east."

If there was worship in the sun and the sun was in the east, then it was morning time.

Because the sun rises in the east. You're not going to have the sun in the east in the afternoon or in the evening. But only in the morning.

So it's very easy to understand that this is an Easter sunrise service because their faces are toward the sun in the morning time. That's what people do every Easter sunrise. I know not every church does Easter sunrise outside anymore. They used to.

But traditionally, traditionally the churches would, instead of having worship service inside the house of God or inside the church building or inside the temple, they would actually meet outside the church and especially in graveyards. Think about that.

There's still a lot of churches that do that today that actually have church in the graveyard for Easter sunrise service thinking that it symbolizes the resurrection of Christ. But it doesn't at all. Because they're facing the sun. They're worshiping the sun, the sun god Ra, the Egyptian sun god.

That's what they're really worshiping even though they say in their hearts and they say with their mouths, I'm worshiping Jesus, His resurrection. But the Bible says they're worshiping the sun. So who do we believe? Humans or God? God says they're worshiping the sun. I think I'd rather believe God. Amen.

And there's another reason why we know this is Easter. There's another reason that makes it very clear if you keep reading. I want to thank you for your patience.

Verse 17, "He said to me, 'Son of humans, you have seen this. Is it a little thing?' No. "Is it a little thing to the house of Judah to prophesy the iniquities which they have prophesied here?" "For they have filled the land with iniquities of sin and returned to provoke to anger, to provoke God to anger and behold these stretch out the vine branch as mockers or mocking God. Therefore I will deal with them in wrath and anger. My eye will not spare nor will I have mercy."

Where is it that they're weeping for Tammuz, Brother Jared? There was a previous verse.

Verse 14. We'll go back to verse 14. "He brought me into the porch of the house of Jesus that looks to the north and behold there was women sitting there, lamenting, crying, mourning for Tammuz."

Now I've got in the footnote here in the Alpha and Omega Bible that Baal, the false father, and Tammuz, the false son, and Easter was the false mother. So this is the Trinity. Baal, Tammuz, and Easter. Father, son, and mother.

Now we had went to a ballet here all back a couple months ago or whenever it was and I didn't know they was going to do this or else I wouldn't have gone. But they represented the Holy Spirit with a female character, a woman playing the Holy Spirit. Like I said, if I had known they were going to do it, I wouldn't have been there.

But that's what they did. They had the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit was a female character. The reason they did that was on purpose because the Holy Spirit many times by the Catholic Church and different churches and different religions was many times at certain periods of time represented as a female.

This is what you're serving when you serve a Trinity God. You're serving a transgender.

That's what you're serving when you believe in a Trinity is transgenderism. And there was transgenderism all throughout these ancient histories in connection with the Easter service, the Easter and even the Christmas.

There was mixing the male and the female gods together even as they were doing here. This you can find. You can find evidence. You can find proof of this.

And they're doing it even today. Like I said, a local ballet play and right there they're doing it.

So this is not something two and three and four thousand years ago. This is not something that is just only in certain churches. They're doing it right here. Right here in my local town.

They're doing it. This is much more widespread than what I thought. It's much more widespread than what you thought.

And so the Baal, the Tammuz, the Easter are a pagan Assyrian divinity based on the myths about Cush, Nimrod and Nimrod's wife. It goes back to Cush, Nimrod and Nimrod's wife.

Right there. Some origins for you right there.

Their origin is very important. Very important. Nimrod was a major satanic person. Major, major, major satanic person. That's the origin of Christmas and Easter. A Satan worshipper. And this also tells you about coming from heathen nations. Cush was a very heathen nation. Amen.

And it says that the forty days of Lent observed by the Catholics and Lutherans and certain other churches. The forty days of Lent originated from the Assyrian forty days of weeping for Tammuz.

Lent is followed by the pagan celebration of Easter where the priests of Easter/Ishtar/Astarte — different spellings but they're really pronounced all the same — where they kill a pig to represent the killing of the wild boar.

The wild boar is said to have killed Tammuz. The goddess called "Easter" is said to have resurrected Tammuz on Easter Sunday.

Okay. These pagan demonic rituals were celebrated thousands of years before Jesus was born. Amen.

So we know it's Easter not only because they're outside facing the east in the morning time but also because the word Tammuz. Because they got the word Tammuz here then we have a direct connection to the forty days of Lent which ends on Easter. It ends on Easter morning. So we have a very, very, very direct proof that it's talking about Easter. Because once you recognize that the word Tammuz is there then you can find the forty days of Lent, the forty days ending on Easter morning. So there's no doubt. There's no doubt at all that it's talking about Easter. Amen.

Okay. So let's go over the book of Exodus now and the book of all, Exodus 12. Exodus 12 verse 14.

What day is it talking about? If you look at verse 11, at the very last part of verse 11 it says Passover.

So it commands forever the observance of Passover. Amen.

Forever is a continual commandment throughout all of your generations. It does not say for the Jews only. It does not say it's old covenant only. It does not say until the crucifixion. But rather forever. Amen.

Throughout all of your generations. And yet most churches would say that Passover we don't have to do because it's old covenant. But yet Jesus in the New Testament told us how to observe Passover. Amen.

Why would He do that if that was going to be the very last Passover that anybody had to do? That wouldn't make any sense.

If the Passover, the night that He was arrested, Jesus was arrested that night, if that was the last Passover that anybody is required to do, Jesus would have took the time to say, "Guess what? This is the last Passover anybody has to do."

But He didn't say that. Amen.

And then we find the apostles and disciples, even 50 years later, when Paul was writing Corinthians and so forth, they were still keeping the Passover in the Days of Unleavened Bread.

And Pentecost and other Holy Days. So there's no biblical proof at all that the Holy Days are done and over with. None. None whatsoever at all.

They try to point to verses where Paul was preaching against legalism of focusing on the letter of the law and circumcision and stuff like that.

They point to those verses to try to say the Sabbath and the Holy Day and that all law is done away with.

But yet Paul is being specific that circumcision is done away with, not the Sabbath, not the Holy Days.

And sometimes it's not real clear that he's specific, but he is because many times he was speaking to people that was just very legalistic people and he was trying to get people to think spiritually and to consider the spirit of the law rather than the letter of the law.

And I am all in agreement about that with Paul. I'm very much against Hebrew roots, Torah, Torah, Torah focus, Hebrew roots, ministries who are totally focused on the letter of the law. That's not the way we want to be. We want to focus on Christ.

I point to Christ. That we have to point to Christ and believe in Christ and follow Christ in obedience to Christ. Amen.

But our focus is not on the law. I'm trying to preach faith and trusting God and believing God and relying on God and miracles and prophecy and mercy and grace. I'm trying to include all of this.

But first and foremost, we can't have all this other stuff unless we learn to first and foremost surrender to Him. Amen.

If you want the blessings and the mercy and the grace, you must also be willing to surrender to Him because otherwise He will turn His head away from you.

You won't have His mercy and His grace. It even said that I will not show mercy upon them. It even said, we just read that while ago, that I will not show mercy upon them. Amen.

You won't have the mercy and the grace in the favor of God if you're not surrendered to Him. Or not willing to, that is. Amen.

So we have a biblical commandment for Passover, not only in Exodus, but even on the night

that Jesus was arrested. And even in the writings of Paul, we have the biblical command of Passover in Days of Unleavened Bread.
So, there's multiple verses for that.

But let's go over to Matthew 15.

Matthew 15 verse 9. Jesus says, "But in vain do they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of mankind."

That is a tremendous statement. Amazing statement. Now a lot of people say I'm taking it out of context because he's talking about washing hands and washing dishes and all this other stuff.

But when he said this, if we think past the letter of the law and think about the spirit of what he is saying, the spirit of what He's saying is true going way beyond washing dishes and washing hands. Amen.

It's going beyond that. It is true is a true statement that people really do think that they are worshipping Him, but they're worshipping Him in vain. In other words, He's not accepting their prayers and their worship.

This shows that it is possible, whether you're talking about the legalism of washing hands or whether you're talking about something else, it don't matter. It proves a spiritual point that it is possible that a worship toward Him is a worship in vain.

That He doesn't accept it. That He is not pleased with it. In vain do they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of mankind.

Well Christmas and Easter is not a command of God. It's not a command of the Bible. Jesus didn't say every once a year on the date of my resurrection, on such and such and such a date, you are to commemorate the rising of the sun or the resurrection of the Son of God on that date.

You ain't going to find it because it was never written. He never said it. He didn't command it. So the command that your local pastor, your TV evangelist, your radio evangelist, your apostles in Africa, your false prophets in Africa, they are acting like it's a command from God that you must do Christmas and Easter. That's not the command of God, but rather the command of false apostles, false apostles, false pastors, and false brethren, false brothers, false sisters that you should not be calling your brothers and your sisters because they are not.

The Bible talks about children of Satan. They are the children of Satan. You are not siblings with the children of Satan.

It doesn't matter that their intent is to worship God. It doesn't matter because in vain is their worship. Their worship is in vain. It's pointless. God does not accept it.

It doesn't matter that they think they are worshipping God as far as trying to think that they are Christians. In other words, you should not give them credit for worshipping God when they are not truly, truly, truly worshipping God.

Look at John 6, John chapter 6 verse 52.

John 6 verse 52, page 112 if you have the paperbacks of the Alpha and Omega Bible.

John 6:52, "Then the Judeans argued with one another, saying, 'How can this man give us his flesh to eat?' So Jesus said to them, 'Truthfully, I tell you the absolute truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of mankind and drink his blood, you have no life in yourselves.'"

The type of life he's talking about is eternal life because of course these people were living.

He's not talking to dead people, right? So the life that he's talking about, having no life in you, is talking about salvation, eternal life.

He's saying to these people, you're not saved unless you take the Passover communion. The blood and the flesh of Jesus is not talking about cannibalism.

It's not saying that you literally have to kill a person and eat their flesh or literally eat Jesus.

It's a symbolism for Passover communion. Absolutely. Amen? Absolutely.

It doesn't take much common sense to figure this out, but unfortunately in our society today there's not a lot of common sense. Amen.

A lot of the common sense no longer exists anymore because of how people's brains have been turned into mud because of video games, Hollywood, rap music, and propaganda, anti-American propaganda, anti-NATO propaganda.

And their brains have been turned to mud by Buddhism and Hinduism, yoga, and Sunday preachers and Sunday churches. That has turned people's brains to mud.

So there's not a lot of common sense anymore. But it doesn't take much intelligence or wisdom or common sense to know this is talking about Passover communion.

That is because Jesus himself said when He had the cup of wine in His hands, when He had the unleavened bread of Passover communion in His hands, and He said this bread represents, He said this is my body. He didn't use the word represent, but He said this bread is my flesh and this cup is my blood. So right there He's saying that these were symbols even though He didn't use the word symbols. But that's what He was saying. Amen?

Where's my sound effects? Amen. Amen, brother. I've got to fix this. When I try to scroll it down, it scrolls right back up.

So anyway, it doesn't make much, you don't have to have much intelligence to figure this stuff out. You've just got to have a willing heart. Amen.

You can be a five-year-old child and understand this. This is how easy it is. You don't have to have a lot of intelligence to understand this. The only thing you really need is a sincere heart for the truth. Amen.

And so it's very clear that you're not saved. You don't have life, eternal life, salvation in you unless you do the Passover communion on Passover.

So the reality is you may have said the false prayer of salvation decades ago, years ago, months ago, whatever, but unless you obey the commandments of the Lord to do the Passover communion unless you surrender to the truth, you're not saved.

And they're not saved and mama is not saved and daddy is not saved and brother and sister and friend and roommate, they are not saved and the entire church and that preacher is not saved unless they take the blood and flesh of Christ Jesus on Passover evening.

And they have to be baptized. Repent and be baptized.

And not just baptized by a false preacher that has no authority from God, but a true preacher. Amen.

Or a true representative of God. In South Africa that is brother Hugh. Amen.

But he can't just be baptized as anybody. Not just anyone. Amen.

The people have to show forth the fruits of repentance first before they can be baptized.

Before they can be called a brother or a sister.

They have to show forth the fruits of repentance. The Pharisees came to John the baptizer, came to be baptized by him and he refused to baptize them. He did.

Instead he rebuked them. Even though they came to be baptized, he actually rebuked them

instead of baptizing them. Everybody thinks that he did baptize them. It doesn't describe him baptizing them.

It doesn't describe them coming down into the water and being baptized. It's not there. He didn't do it. He rebuked them.

Another Bible verse actually says that the Pharisees were not baptized by John. It actually tells you that.

And yet all these churches are still teaching, all these preachers are still teaching that he did baptize them. They are going against what the Bible says.

We don't baptize just anybody and everybody and we don't take communion with just anybody and everybody and we don't fellowship with just anybody and everybody.

We're called out. We're separate. We're a select group of people chosen by God because we're willing to show forth the fruits of repentance and that has to be tested.

We have to test one another. You have to test me about whether I'm really telling you the truth or not and I have to test you to see if you're willing to surrender to Christ truly and truly.

And we have to test the next person that comes in the church and the next person and the next person because if we don't test everybody, then we end up with a church full of Satan worshipers that are still doing Christmas and Easter.

And that wouldn't be right because then we wouldn't be set apart and holy unto the Lord. We would just be just like the rest of the world.

Everybody's got to be tested to see if we are worthy. The Bible says to pray that you be worthy and everything. It says other parts of the Bible talks about being accountants worthy.

We have to be worthy.

The churches of this world teach you that you're trash and that you're not worthy. And no matter what happens, I'm not worthy. I know my righteousness is filthy rags, they say. That's bullcrap. If your righteousness continues to be nothing but filthy rags, you ain't going nowhere as with God because God is not a lazy sloth.

He is not a lazy, how can I say this brother Jared, help me out? Slob.

Slob, thank you praise the Lord. God will not be hanging out with a lazy slob. You have to clean yourself up.

We don't hang out with the Christmas and the Easter people. They're not our families no more. We're progressing over to heaven. We're coming out of the world. Amen. Amen.

There's a lot to salvation. It's more than just a prayer. I know you got to start with a prayer. I know you do. I'm not denying that.

But you can't think that you're saved just because you did that prayer and no other steps.

There is another step. There is another step and another step and another step.

And you have to keep taking those steps forward and continuing to get closer and closer to God, more and more surrender to God and stay faithful to Him in the truth all the way to your death.

All the way beyond your death, because the reality is a lot of people once they face the sword and the mark of the beast and the vaccines and other stuff like that, they're no longer going to be serving God. This is the truth.

The very moment that people are told you either take this or you no longer have a job, well, I've got to take it then. Shoot me up. Here's my arm. Shoot it in me even though it's going to kill me, even though it's going to poison me, even though this makes me a fool. Shoot me up like a drug.

They no longer follow wisdom. They no longer follow God. They no longer follow what is right and true and holy the moment that their job is at risk.

Money, money, money, money comes first. Job, career, college, education, wife, everything else comes first. Money comes first. Everything else comes first. Not God.

I preach with boldness and passion because this is what you need. You don't need a pacifier. You don't need to suck on mommy's titties. You need a man that will make you pick up and lift the weights and lift up and take up the heavy burden of the cross of Jesus Christ. That's what you need.

You need a man that will tell you to be a man. You need a man preacher, not no woman preacher, not no soft, effeminate preacher, not no kissy, kissy, kissy preacher.

What you need is a preacher that will tell you to pick up the heavy weight of the cross of Jesus Christ and to carry it and deny yourself and follow Christ Jesus like the Bible says in Matthew 10.

Your traditional preacher will never tell you that. They tickle the ears as it says in Timothy. They tickle the ears. The feel good, easy, easy microwave society.

Look at John 4 here. John 4. My notes that I made to help guide me through the sermon is not going to match the sermon completely, because I go by the Spirit of God in me and the way He directs me. So when you get these notes on social media, He's going to give you some other verses as well for your homework. Amen.

I hope you did your homework last week or last time that we came here together. Time flies so fast. I can't keep up with time. Time is going very, very, very fast and it's going to get even faster.

You've got to be ready for the great tribulation. You've got to get ready for the great tribulation because it's coming. The war, the invasions, the destruction of every building, all these colleges and careers, it's all coming down to the ground. Amen.

Whatever degree you get from the college is good for one year max and that's it. This ain't going to be no career that goes into your older age and your retirement age. You might as well forget that. Amen.

John 4 verse 22. "You worship what you do not know. We worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews."

Think about this statement. Jesus said that salvation is from the Jews or the Judeans. We don't need to be copying what the Egyptians do or what the Indians do or what the Chinese do with Buddhism or Hinduism, but rather we need to be following what God told the Israelites to do. Amen.

So all these false Christians, false preachers out here that say, oh that's for the Jews, that's for the Jews, that's for the Jews, you should say salvation is from the Jews. Amen.

Do I hear shouting in Zimbabwe? Do I hear shouting in South Africa? Brother Andrew? Brother Simon? Whoo!

What about you? Huh? Come on. Let's shout. I don't care where we at. You know, we need to get over being timid and afraid of everything. Amen.

If I was in a public park right now, I'd still be shouting. Let them call the police. Let me get arrested for Christ. Amen.

All the disciples, every one of them got arrested sooner or later because they were talking too much about Christ. Amen.

The whole wide world is wicked. It's not just your nation. The whole wide world is wicked. It's a dangerous thing to walk out here on any street in America.

I could be killed right now, especially since I'm a white man because the Democrat Party has brainwashed a lot, a lot, a lot of the black people and even a lot of the white people in America to think that the white race is evil.

That according to the Bible, the words of Jesus, that salvation came from us, from these white people, from these white honkies. I know we can't dance very well, but he chose this race of people in order to deliver the gospel of Jesus Christ to the whole world.

It is through the white people that the gospel and the name and the true name of Jesus is being preached to every nation on earth. Amen.

If you look at the Koreans, if you look at Chinese and a lot of other languages all across the globe, there is not even a J sound for the letter J in the first letter of Jesus. There is not even a sound for it.

So who did God choose to deliver the message of Christ Jesus to Africa?

You've got to thank God for the day that the white people came to Africa. You've got to thank God for it because if they never came, you would still not know about Jesus today. Amen.

You would still be in these uncivilized voodoo witchcraft, multiple gods that was all across Africa, India and Asia and South America and all across the world.

All across the world. But thank God that anybody of any race can be adopted as the Bible says.

To be adopted into the family of the Jews, into the family of the Israelites, that you are my true brother if you do the will of my father, regardless of the bloodline of the flesh.

That we can be one. That we can be one in Christ, one faith, one church, one baptism, one Lord, united, not divided, not agreeing to disagree, but being united in doctrine and faith and belief on every issue.

Every issue. People say that's impossible. It's not impossible. That's why we are a select and very small group. It's because we are required, absolutely required to agree only on the truth. Amen.

We are not to be in coexistence of lies. Amen.

John 4 verse 22. John 4 verse 22. "You worship what you know but we worship what we do know for salvation is from the Judeans."

"Now an hour is coming," verse 23, "an hour is coming and it is now when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth."

And notice that truth is in connection in the context of the Judeans. The Judeans have, you know, if you look at Israel today, even though they are very much corrupted just like all the other races.

If you look at the Judeans today in Israel, the Jews today in Israel, they are the only nation on earth that I know of, the only nation on earth where the Sabbath is the law.

Where the Sabbath is the law. Where they actually close down some of the roads on the Sabbath. Where the government buildings are closed on the Sabbath and so forth.

And where as a people and as a nation they keep God's true holy days. That's the only nation on earth that I know of that keeps God's true holy days as a race, as a people, as a nation, as a government.

That the government offices are closed on all of God's biblical holy days.

Now I know that the Jews also have a lot of sin in Satan worship because every nation on

earth has been corrupted and turned over to the devil.

But we can still see the remnant, the proof of who they are. That they are the true Jews.

And yet you get all these YouTube videos and websites and liars saying that they are not Jews, that they are fake Jews. The reality is you are a fake Christian.

They are not fake Jews. That's just propaganda coming out of Russia to make you hate Israel. That's exactly what that is and you can't even see through it.

Because you are so programmed by propaganda. The nation of Israel is the arch enemy of Syria, Russia, and China. That in itself proves that they are true Jews.

Read the Bible. Read, read, read, read the Bible. If you would just read every book of the Bible, every page of the Bible, every word of the Bible slowly and carefully and think about what you are reading.

Your whole outlook, everything you believe, everything you was taught will change.

Everything that you can't have a man can't have more than one woman, that would change.

Even though I know what the churches say, I know what the Christians, the so called ridiculous, foolish, upside down Christians, I know what they say, I know what they teach.

I'm not ignorant. I know what you said, I know what you said, I know what you said, but I also know what the Bible says.

And they twist the words to make it fit what they want to believe and to make it fit what the churches and pastors teach. But you have to twist it to make it fit.

The problem is not multiple wives. It's wives that won't shut up. It's wives that won't submit themselves to their husbands. It is wives that are still listening to the Sunday preachers.

That's the problem.

How can you expect the husband to surrender to Christ and be the leader if you yourself are continuing to support morally in your mind, in your soul, in your spirit and with your words, continuing to support the Sunday Trinity preachers?

We've got to be willing to confess to ourselves and to God and to one another that every one of those Sunday preachers, every one of those Sunday preachers, every one of those Sunday preachers are nothing but pagans. Pagan, pagan, pagan. Let's call it the way it is.

Amen.

The Sabbath is so easy to know. You just read the Bible. Just read the Bible. And you'll know that the Sabbath is Saturday, not Sunday. All you've got to do is read the Bible.

I want every one of you to get to the point eventually where you will not need me. I sincerely do because I ain't going to live forever in this flesh. If the Lord was to delay, which I don't think He is, then eventually there would be a funeral for me and Pastor Tim will be dead and gone. What are you going to do then? I want you, every one of you, to eventually be able to do without me. All you have to do is read the Bible and stop going to YouTube.

YouTube is not of the Lord. Read the Bible. Stop going to the Sunday churches because they're not of the Lord. Stop gathering with them. Stop fellowshiping with them. They're not of the Lord.

Come out from them. Revelation 18 verse 4. Come out of her, My people.

Verse 23. "The hour is coming and it is now when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for such a people the Father seeks or searches to be His worshipers."

Verse 24 "Theos" — God — "is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and truth."

That word spirit, you know what that really means? That means with passion.

And that means not being legalistic. That means following the spirit of the law and not the letter of the law. That means having some common sense, having some logic, some logos inside you.

Having the logos, the Word of God inside you. That comes from a personal relationship, not religion. Amen.

I teach the commandments of the Lord, but I also teach personal relationship.

But a true personal relationship, not committing adultery against God. When they do Christmas, when they do Easter, when they go to church on Sunday, that's committing adultery against God.

You can have multiple wives, you men can according to the Bible, but you can't have multiple gods. You can have multiple girlfriends and wives, but you cannot have multiple gods. You can't have multiple gods.

People don't like this because it don't match the Jesus that they know, which is the false Jesus.

Prove it to me. Prove it to me. And that's what needs to be your mentality about every doctrine. Every, every, every, every, every, every doctrine. Prove it to me.

If you can't prove it, it ain't true. And when you prove it, it's got to be not twisting it. Amen. You can look at the original words, that's fine, but don't twist it.

And compare it with other verses. What is the supporting verse? Are we really understanding the verse? Are we really understanding what it's saying? What is the context?

Paul told Timothy about who to choose to appoint as additional deacons and ministers into the church. That was the context in which Paul was writing to Timothy in the book of Timothy. In which people try to say that a minister must be married to only one woman and it doesn't say that. It doesn't say it.

The Greek word translated as one is the same word translated throughout the Bible as the word first. It is. You don't have to believe me.

Search it. Prove it. Prove it. Prove it. Prove it. Prove it. The same Greek word translated as one wife in other verses of the Bible is translated as first. It should say first wife.

Meaning that he should still be married to his first wife. In other words, the context is Paul was telling Timothy to ordain new ministers into the church that are men that have been tried and tested.

That they are men that lead a good life that are not leading a life where they are divorcing two and three and four thousand times. That's the context.

That's the context. If you read all the verses around it, it's talking about the lifestyle of the prospective new minister. What kind of behavior that he has shown and proven himself to be of a good character or a character of a man that cannot get along.

That cannot keep his wife. That is running his family the wrong way. Whatever. That's the context. It has nothing to do with how many wives he has. Nothing at all. That's not the context at all. They trust it.

Even when you look at Matthew 25. The parable of the ten virgins. And all ten virgins are engaged to marry Christ. Think about that. Think about that. Ten different women engaged to marry Christ. Young virgin women. These are not old women in their twenties.

This is young virgin women that are engaged to marry Christ. Not old women in their twenties. A lot of people back then didn't even make it into their sixties. Because there wasn't a lot of modern medicine. There wasn't modern doctors. Modern hospitals. They had a lot of sickness and disease and they didn't know how to treat anything.

When I preach I teach multiple things because everybody has been deceived about everything there is to talk about. Everything that we could talk about. Everybody is wrong about.

Revelation 12 verse 9. Satan has deceived the entire world. Revelation 12 verse 9 that Satan has deceived the entire world. Everything we can talk about. Everybody is wrong about.

That's why people can't agree with me.

That's why they want to be all this disagree to disagree. That's why they want to do that is because they are not willing to unite in the truth. Because they want to hold on to the lies that they have been programmed with in the traditional synagogue of Satan.

False religion. Which is much more legalistic than the truth. Much more legalistic than what the truth is. Can't do this. Can't do that. Can't do this. Can't do that. Can't do this. Can't do that.

I can't even say bullcrap because it offends somebody. But I'm going to say it anyway. Amen.

God is searching for people that will worship Him in the truth with passion, with spirit and with the truth that we can see a remnant still existing even in the Jews of today.

The Holy Days and the Sabbath, Hanukkah, Purim, so forth. That is the sermon. That is the sermon. Praise the Lord Jesus. Praise God.

Now I want to let you know that tomorrow we start the countdown of 50 days to Pentecost. According to what the Bible says in Leviticus 23.

It tells us to start counting the days during this time of Passover, days of unleavened bread. That from the Sabbath, the weekly Sabbath, the weekly seventh day that is within this seven days of unleavened bread, fiesta, festival.

That we are to count from this Sabbath today 50 days and it says 7 weeks to count 7 full weeks and then the next day being the 50th. So automatically that's going to land on a Sunday.

Pentecost is the only biblical Holy Day that lands on Sunday all the time. Every year. The only one. The only one. There is a reason for that.

And that is that we're counting to 50. It's very, very, very, very, very specific. But when you look at the pagan holidays, they all land on Sunday for the most part.

Father's Day, Mother's Day, and Easter, that there's an overflowing of Sunday worship. The name of the day. Sunday. Have you ever thought why it's called Sunday?

It's the day of Sunday worship. Which means that Sunday is the day that was set aside for worship of the Egyptian sun god, which wasn't unique to only Egypt, but also was in Assyria and Greece.

And the Greeks and the Romans and the Roman Catholic Church. That's why in the Roman Catholic Church, very often in the church buildings, you see the symbol of the sun and the moon both, which is a Freemason symbol, which is Islamic.

The Freemasons come from Syria as an Islamic religion. Freemasonry religion club, mason, men's club, is actually Islam in disguise.

So we count the days to 50. That would be Pentecost. And that also is a time of gathering.

And so it goes without saying that we should all gather on Pentecost, and it's a special gathering. So that it's a pilgrimage, would be our modern word for a pilgrimage, to where we meet together with people that we normally might not gather with every seventh day because of time, and travel, and travel expenses, and the time that it takes to travel. And you might live

in such and such a town, or such and such a place, to where you can't be with other true brothers and true sisters on the seventh day every week.

But when it comes to the high holy days, and that's what the Bible calls this, Pentecost and Passover, and the Feast of Tabernacles, three times a year, that we travel with a pilgrimage to go the extra distance to meet up with the true brothers and the true sisters as a larger gathering together.

And if you are baptized, if you are truly saved, truly, truly baptized, and truly, truly surrendered to God, then it's open doors, and you're welcome and invited to gather with His people, but it's not open doors to everybody.

It's open doors only to the people that have proven themselves, faithful to surrender to Christ, be willing to be baptized, so forth, baptized in the truth rather than by pagan religion leaders.

I'm going to tell you what, I am happy and I'm excited for the miracles that I am seeing in South Africa and across the world.

So far, Algeria is the largest congregations, two congregations of two pastors, at least one or two deacons up there as well, in addition to the two pastors, and also one of the pastors is an apostle as well.

The church is growing there as well, but I could see, I could see the Cape Town congregation becoming much larger than what it is right now, and eventually renting a place for people to come and gather and have a worship service building eventually, because we have to start smaller, we have to start with Brother Hugh being appointed as a deacon, and which is already walking in that office right now, like I told him to, he's already, already right now walking in the office of administration and leadership, and we will very, very soon have a ceremony to officially anoint him and appoint him as a deacon, as an administrator of the church, and to have eventually worship services in his home, once he's able to do that, and then from there, eventually, hopefully, God willing, if we get enough people, then start renting a building or something, unless he gets a garage or a basement that he can, which I don't even know if there's even such thing as a basement in South Africa or not, I don't know, but if a person had a garage or a basement to meet in, to lay down some carpet, or even without carpet, and gather together and make that a church building, that'd be fine.

We've done that before, I have met in car garages, I've met next to the lake, in different places, it don't have to be fancy, amen.

But I'm excited, and I'm also excited for Sister Kiki in Australia, that after a very long period of time, of being approved for her disability, disability income check, that is a miracle, really. It is a miracle, because it is so difficult, so extremely difficult, really, in all nations that have that, to be approved. Very, very difficult, even in America, to be approved for disability income check.

It's an answer to much prayers, many, many, many, many prayers, an answer to prayers, really a miracle, and it's a great blessing and a help for her, and she really needs it, really needs it.

We appreciate Sister Kiki, I forget whether she's, what, five years, six years, I don't know that she's been with the ministry, praise God.

We love all of our brothers and sisters across the world, our brothers and sisters in the Islamic nation of Algeria, which is risking their lives to gather together, risking their lives in Algeria.

They're not afraid. I want you people in Jamaica and South Africa to take the perfect example of the Algerian brothers and sisters.

They could, up there in Algeria, they could be arrested for even having a Bible, and yet they are the largest congregation of this ministry. Amen.

God is good, and God is powerful. God is very powerful, very powerful. He is able to protect and to deliver.

There is a time coming upon this earth, and it's already now, that you could be in grave danger, and yet God put forth a shield of protection around you.

So much, so much that at some point of time, He may even make you be invisible to the enemy.

Some of you right now think, oh, that's pretty wild, you're stretching it. I'm not stretching it. There is nothing impossible with God.

He made the sun. He made the stars. He made the earth. He made the planets. He made humanity and the elephant and the zebra.

He made the giraffe. He made the hippo and the bunny rabbit and the doggy and the kitty. He made all these things. He can make you invisible to the enemy.

We need to be more bold, more courageous, especially you men. You need to man up. Stop being so afraid of your community.

Crime is extremely bad in America too, but I would not be afraid if I had to meet in a public park, downtown New York City. I wouldn't be afraid.

The homeless people are surrounding me. I still wouldn't be afraid.

And I know we've got to protect our wives and our children, but even our children need to learn to not be afraid.

And if our children see us being afraid, then they're going to learn to also fear in overabundance.

And the women need to see the men being courageous.

It's going to get a whole lot more dangerous than what it is right now. A lot more. It's going to get a lot more dangerous. A lot more dangerous.

We ain't seen nothing yet. As danger increases, our courage must also increase at the same rate of speed so that we will not be overtaken with fear.

Our courage must grow at the same rate of speed as the wickedness in this world so that we will not be overtaken with fear, because God did not give us the spirit of fear, but of power and of a sound mind. Amen.

Brothers and sisters, I thank you for your patience. I thank you for letting me step on your toes a little bit. I praise the name of Jesus.

Pentecost will be May the 28th. This year is different every year because the Roman calendar does not match God's calendar, so it's different every year.

Pentecost this year of 2023 will be May the 28th. Anybody that is baptized into the true church inside the United States of America, or even outside the United States of America, if you have the ability to travel, then you're welcome.

You're welcome to be here with us. Otherwise, it will be broadcasted and you can join us in the broadcast.

Let's see. April the 11th this month, this Tuesday coming, is the last day of unleavened bread. April the 11th Tuesday is a high holy day Sabbath in which you should not do any school work

and no employment, no work. It is a Sabbath, a high Sabbath, a high holy day Tuesday, April the 11th.

And that's over with at sunset because what we do whenever we are doing any type of a fast that is commanded in the Bible, there are 24 hour periods.

And a fast that is commanded in the Bible always begins at sunset and ends at sunset.

Now, we're not fasting from all food this week and neither is it just only 24 hours, but rather for seven periods of 24 hour days, we are fasting from leavened bread.

Leavened bread, puffed up bread, bread that has yeast or baking soda, baking powder, sodium bicarbonate, stuff like that.

And that is symbolism for the process of our entire lives trying to get the sin out of our lives. It is a process that we must finish and complete.

And because it is a type of fast, fasting from a certain thing, then that's why we got it sunset to sunset. You don't do that for Pentecost.

You don't do that for the Feast of Tabernacles or for the Feast of Trumpets, Day of Trumpets. Because it is only on the fast days that the Bible mentions sunset to sunset. It never ever ever says sunset to sunset in reference to any of the other biblical holy days.

The Bible is very specific, extremely specific. So that's one thing that the Jews do have wrong. They do sunset to sunset for every holy day and every day of the week, but that's not what the Bible says.

And that's not right and that's not the way it should be historically nor in nature. Even nature teaches you that the sun rising in the morning starts the new day. We can learn just by observing nature.

So a day, every day normally, even the Sabbath day every week starts and ends with the sunrise, not sunset to sunset. The Jews learned the sunset to sunset principle from the Babylonians and the Assyrians by embracing the calendar of their enemies.

This is proven on the website at isawthelightministries.com/newmoons.html and also at daystarts.html. That's the more specific one. What time did the day begin?

isawthelightministries.com/daystarts.html. Look for that article. Study it out. It gives you a whole lot more proof than what I can provide in this short period of time I've got right now.

I've got to let you go. We've got people in Asia that need to get to bed and I'm pooped out. Amen.

I preach and I preach and I preach until I'm so exhausted and my body aches and everything else because I'm getting to be an old man. And we've got to raise you, you're younger men. You've got to be taught how to lead and how to lead your women, your wives, girlfriends, your children, society, business, how to lead.

Even if you're not called to be a leader of the church, you're still called to be a leader in business, in society. You're called to be the head of the house. You're called to be the king of your own castle, not the king of your basement, not the king of your bedroom, but the king of your castle, the king of your entire house. That's the way every man is designed by God to be. Amen.

Not the king of Donkey Kong. That shows my age. I don't know the name of these brand new video games. We played Donkey Kong when I was young, but you get my grip. You get my grip, brother? I can't even talk cool when I try to talk cool. I'm too old.

But the young people must be growing up and maturing to be the new leaders up and coming in the church. Amen. And in society.

Brother Jared, you got anything to add?

"I just want the second one thing mentioned during the sermon, which is that pagan religions that these Sunday churches are based on, especially Easter, are strongly associated with homosexuality, transgenderism, all that, in many ways." Amen.

"And I don't know if you're familiar with the Egyptian version of Easter and Tammuz. There was a problem with his resurrection in that pagan religion — they couldn't find his penis!"

I discerned that was coming up. That it was coming up. I did discern that. And that's okay. Okay. You know, we've got to be mature about things and sex and the human body parts. That's part of life. And too much of religion, false Christianity is, you can't say penis, you can't say penis, you can't say...

We need to grow up, not be children. Nothing wrong with saying penis. It's a reality of life and we got to teach our children the same thing. We can't expect our children to grow up if we don't grow up.

And we got to be able to be willing and able to talk about sex and sexuality and different things, even with our children, because if we don't teach them, they will. If we don't teach them, they will.

So we have to teach them right and wrong. We got to teach them the reality of the existence of homosexuality and the existence of all other types of sexual stuff so that we teach them right, because if we don't teach them, they will and they won't teach them right.

So we got to be, have open conversations about this with our children and our families and raise the young people to be mature and knowledgeable and intelligent instead of hiding everything from them. Amen.
