

Full Sermon Transcript:
Guidance and Protection of The Holy Ghost
January 27, 2024

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Good to see everybody. I think we can stop right there with the music portion of the service and it is good to see our brother in South Korea, Jamaica, our brothers and sisters in South Africa, John in Kansas, and Mississippi and others. It is good to see you today, especially at this moment when we are facing such great trials, difficulties in this world. Sin and corruption all around us, the world is filled and overflowing with it.

So it is good to look out there and just see your names. Just to see that there are people who are trying to serve the Lord in truth and in spirit.

That song we just sung has the last verse of that song. It says, He leads me gently on through this world below. Amen. Today we are going to be talking about the guidance and protection of the Holy Ghost. How the Holy Ghost leads us and guides us.

So that particular last verse of that song is so true that He gently leads us through this world below. Amen.

And it is a very difficult world and He allows us to make mistakes so that we will grow stronger, learn our lessons, develop a better, stronger character, be better people, better leaders.

That we may be the leaders of the kingdom of God. We cannot do that without learning our lessons. So He allows us to make some mistakes, but He also guides us and protects us so that we don't have to make as many mistakes. Amen.

And so that we can learn from our mistakes. And that is so very important. Before we continue on, let's go in prayer.

Lord Heavenly Father Almighty God, praise Your Holy Name. Thank You Lord that You are guiding us and leading us. We pray that we would be receptive to Your voice, to obey Your guidance, Your direction.

We ask You Father to help us to hear Your voice more accurately, stronger and better. More now than ever before and even more in the future. Please help us to come to know You closer, better, more accurately.

Please give us Your Holy Ghost and more so as the time continues. More of You, less of ourselves. We ask for Your help, Your guidance, Your direction. We ask for logic, common sense and intelligence.

We ask Father that You help us to follow Your will in the center of Your will. We ask for Your help in the service today, in this sermon. Help the people to learn, to grow and to become more and more Your people and not their own. We ask Father Your presence, Your will, Your spirit and Your direction in this message, in this sermon, in this worship service and in our lives increasingly as the time goes by.

May You become stronger as the world fades away. Glory be to Your Name of Jesus, the Alpha, the Omega, the First, the Last, the Beginning and the Ending, the Sustainer, our Kinsman, Redeemer.

Praise be the Name of Jesus, yesterday, today and tomorrow and forever. In Jesus' Name we pray, so be it. Amen.

And the congregation said, Amen. Praise God. Let's be seated. Let's turn to Romans chapter 8. Romans 8.

Romans 8 is one of my favorite chapters of the entire Bible and it is jam packed with power. Amen. Power from Heaven.

Romans 8 verse 14 says, For all who are being led by the Spirit of Theos, these are the sons of Theos. Amen. Praise God.

For all who are being led by the Spirit of God are the sons or the children of God. The people who are not being led by His Spirit are not the children of God spiritually, although we know through Adam and Eve all creation is the children of God, all creation.

But we're not talking physically in that way. We're not talking about the creation. We're talking about in this verse, we are talking about who obeys God, who is truly saved, who is part of the tree of life, who is part of the kingdom, who is part of the church, who is part of the body of Christ, who is truly saved.

These are all synonyms. They all mean the same thing. They're all the same thing. And it is only the people who are led by the Spirit of God.

And more specifically, the portion of His Spirit that exists throughout the entire universe, but the portion of His Spirit that came through the mother Mary and died on the cross and rose from the dead. That portion of the Spirit which we

signify as the Holy Ghost. Amen.

Pardon me for a second here while I turn on the fan. Maybe that will help us wake up.

And if we had one more person, we could have that one more person go and fix a pot of coffee real quick or hot tea or something to help us out. But we don't have that one more person to help us out.

So we continue to struggle. But we are pressed on. We are pressed through. Amen. But the greatest strength comes from the Holy Ghost. Power, empowerment. Amen. Empowerment. To see us through all the difficulties of life.

Without Him, without Him we're nothing. Without Him we're not going to be able to endure this life and have real joy and real peace and real happiness. While everybody else tries to obtain the peace and the happiness and the joy through drugs and illegal activities and different unhealthy activities, smoking and different things.

And false religions. We have the access to the true source of true joy. Something that can really and truly empower joy, peace, happiness, contentment even when there are great trials and difficulties and struggles.

But the problem is many people think they're led by God when they're being led by their own imaginations. When they're being led by Google and the Church of YouTube and cult leaders and false prophets, false religions, denominations, groups, false pastors.

The list is endless of things that are competing against God for your attention and for your worship. We need to make sure we're being led by the Spirit of God.

Let's look at Acts 2 verse 38. Acts 2 verse 38. You already know what that says. You can even quote it before you even turn there, hopefully. And if not, why not? If you can't quote that verse by now, why not?

Shake up. Amen. Acts 2 verse 38 says that Peter said to them, Repent, being each one of you be baptized in the name or in the authority of Jesus the Christ for the forgiveness of your sins and you will receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Amen.

If we're going to be led by the Spirit of God, we need the gift of the Holy Ghost. And that comes after baptism in the name of Jesus, in His authority.

You can't receive that through a preacher who believes in a three-headed God. You can't. You can't receive that with few exceptions. In general, you cannot receive the Holy Ghost when you're being baptized by a preacher that believes in a three-headed Greek mythological God or Christmas or Easter or Sunday worship.

He doesn't have the authority to baptize you in the authority of Jesus. He can't baptize you with authority He doesn't have. He doesn't have that authority because He's not keeping the commandments of God, of the Lord. He doesn't know God. God doesn't know Him. Amen. You know what I mean. Amen.

So, you can't receive the Holy Ghost when you're baptized in a letter Y-name Hebrew roots cult or Jehovah Witness or a Catholic or Lutheran or Presbyterian or any of those. Amen.

Or even in the Apostolic church because they're still doing Sunday. Amen. They're not keeping the fourth commandment. If they're not keeping the fourth commandment, how can they say they know God? They're liars and the truth is not in them according to what the Bible says. That's not my opinion. It's what the Bible says. Amen.

So, we have to be baptized by a person with truly the authority of Christ which would of course be a person that keeps the commandments. Well, the Hebrew roots keeps the commandments but they don't have the name of Jesus. Amen.

And when the Hebrew roots and Torah focus even when they use the name of Jesus, they're keeping the commandments by the letter of the law with a legalistic focus on the law. On the Torah, Torah, Torah, Torah, Torah instead of Jesus, Jesus, Jesus, Jesus. So, they're worshipping a false god. They're worshipping the law rather than Jesus. So, even though they may use Jesus' name, a few of them, it's not the authority of Jesus because they're worshipping the law.

So, baptism by the right person is very key. Not that the person to baptize you has to be perfect. No, I'm not Jesus. But has to be a person that does keep the commandments in Jesus' name with true and correct doctrine who is truly saved. With the fruits thereof. That's very hard to find. That's why we have to do internet baptisms because I can't travel the whole world. But difficult to find. You have to make sure that God leads you to that right person, that right church, that right ministry. Amen.

And if you're truly being led by God, he'll lead you to the right person, the right church, the right ministry sooner or later, eventually. Amen.

Especially as you start listening to him more, hearing his voice more accurately, obeying him more, seeking him more,

then he'll eventually lead you. Amen.

Galatians 5, let's turn there, Galatians chapter 5 verse 18, page 222, if you have the paperbacks of the Alpha and Omega Bibles. Galatians 5 verse 18.

But if you're led by the Spirit, you're not covered by the law. We have to be led by the Spirit. That's what we're talking about today. Being led by the Holy Ghost. How the Holy Ghost leads us and protects us and guides us.

And if so, you're not covered by the law, which means that the law, the Torah, the Torah, the Torah, the Torah, and the Hebrew roots crap is not your God. That you do have some liberty in Christ. Amen.

There was a lot of law that was added on. The Bible says that law was added on because of their transgressions. Law that goes way and beyond and far past the Ten Commandments.

We know that there was a lot of law dealing with only health. Not have sex with a woman while she's having her blood period. That's not a spiritual law. That's a health law. Amen.

Trimming the fat off your meat, not eating the meat. That's not a spiritual law. That's a health law. There's some laws that was health. There's other laws that was ceremonial and ritual. Like the clean and unclean meats. That had to do with sacrifices. It had to do with health as far as old knowledge and primitives were given.

It had to do with knowledge and primitive cooking skills and primitive cleaning and stuff like that. But it wasn't so much as health as it was ceremonial and symbolic. Separating the Gentiles from the Israelites. It was not an eternal law.

We know that Acts 10 is absolute if you believe what it says. God said to Peter two or three times, to not call these unclean animals, to not call these things what I have cleansed unclean.

That's very clear. That's very, very, very, very, very clear. I don't care what Peter said later on to somebody else. I only care what God Himself said to Peter. Amen. Because Peter was a fool many times. He denied Christ repeatedly more than the three times.

I don't care what Peter told somebody else later. I only care what God said to Peter. Because Peter was a fool.

God said, do not call what I have cleansed unclean, while he was looking at the animals. It's very clear. Very clear.

Extremely clear. If you would just believe what it says of what God said. Amen.

So it was different sets of laws for different reasons. And the Holy Ghost can give us discernment about such things.

Amen. The Holy Ghost, if you read Acts 10 with the Holy Ghost, then it's easy. Amen.

It's easy to understand. Even without the Holy Ghost, it's easy to understand. But the Holy Ghost empowers us to understand more so, more easily, except for we fight back against the Holy Ghost many times.

So that's very important to understand as well, is that the Holy Ghost may be speaking, but we may be ignoring or disobeying. Amen.

So we have to be led by the Holy Ghost, but we also have to accept His leadership, His guidance, His direction, His voice. Amen.

But the Bible does talk about liberty in other verses. Talking about liberty. That we don't have to be legalistic. The Holy Ghost will protect you from being legalistic.

If you have felt yourself at certain times in your life, you finally discovered you had been legalistic, then either you had been fighting the Holy Ghost or you didn't have the Holy Ghost to begin with, one or the other.

And most likely, you didn't have the Holy Ghost. Because the Holy Ghost will protect you from becoming overly legalistic. Many times He will perform that function, that protection, that guidance.

Go down to verse 25. Verse 25 here in Galatians 5 says, And if we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit.

So it is something that it should not be like Samson, that the Holy Spirit would come and go upon him, but rather it should be that the Holy Ghost is living in us.

And that is a major fundamental difference between the Holy Spirit and the Holy Ghost. Even though they're the one and the same Spirit, one and the same God, one and the same being, they are different portions.

Like the left side and the right side, basically. They are different portions of that one Spirit. And the Holy Spirit can come and go upon even an animal, a wicked person, or anything, or person or object.

And the Holy Spirit at the same time is ever present and ever living and breathing object, even the most wicked, even in demons. The Holy Spirit exists because the Holy Spirit exists throughout the entire universe, on Jupiter, the moon, and behind that rock, and under that rock, and in the grave.

But the Holy Ghost resides, lives, dwells in the children of God. The Holy Ghost is the Spirit and so that portion of God that came through Mary died and rose again.

That is the portion that lives, stays, resides 24-7 in the children of God and therefore we're living and walking by the Spirit, by the power of the Holy Ghost. He doesn't just come and go.

He should be guiding us, leading us, if we're accepting His voice, if we're listening, if we're watching, if we want His direction, if we accept His direction, if we obey His direction, then He is with us daily. Amen.

That if we're not accepting and obedient of His direction and we continue to be disobedient and rebellious against His direction, He will leave us. Absolutely, He will leave us because we left Him.

We have to live and walk by the Spirit. He protects us against sin and guides us in all areas of life.

We'll go back to verse 18, talking about legalism. The Holy Ghost protects the truly saved person from being overly legalistic, which means He protects you from converting to Judaism and Islam.

He protects you from embracing the Hebrew roots Torah cults. He protects you from that if you have the Holy Ghost and you're not rebellious and disobedient against Him. He protects you from joining the Hebrew roots cults. He protects you from the letter Y named cults, which are all, every one of those, very legalistic.

He protects you from false religions, false groups, false leaders, and false prophets. The Holy Ghost protects you spiritually. He protects your soul. Amen.

Let's go back to the book of Acts. Let's go to Acts 16. Acts 16, verse 6. They passed through that area and the Galatian region having been forbidden by the Holy Ghost to speak the word in Asia.

And they came to Mysia and they tried to go into this other town and the Spirit of God did not permit them. Amen.

Yes, the Spirit of Jesus is the same as the Holy Ghost. Amen. You can underline verse 7, the Spirit of Jesus did not permit them. And verse 6, underline forbidden by the Holy Ghost. Jesus, the Spirit of Jesus is the same as the Holy Ghost. Amen.

That Holy Ghost, that Spirit of Jesus, did not permit them to preach the word of God in certain towns. Some people are not worthy to receive the truth.

And sometimes as a matter of protection from certain people in those towns, whatever the reasoning may be, the apostles were being led by the Spirit of God. Amen.

The Holy Ghost, I've heard stories multiple times in my life how the Holy Ghost would tell somebody, don't go to work that day or don't go to the store that day.

Don't go somewhere that day. Because if they had meant, they would have been killed in a car wreck or something else, something very bad would have happened.

And the only reason they survived was because they did not go that day. Amen. Things like that happen.

Look at chapter 21 verse 4. Chapter 21 verse 4. And after looking up the disciples, we stayed there seven days and they kept telling Paul through the Spirit not to set foot in Jerusalem.

Again, Spirit of God, the Holy Ghost guiding about where to go, rather where not to go. Where to go and where not to go. Amen.

The Holy Ghost's protection guides you about where to go and where not to go and the timing thereof. Amen.

Whether it's preaching or going to the store or moving or getting a job or not getting a job or whatever, God guides us and protects us about the timing and location of where to go and where not to go if we're listening and obeying.

Chapter 13 verse 2. Acts 13 verse 2. Acts 13 verse 2. While they were ministering to the Lord and fasting, the Holy Ghost said, set apart from the Artemis and Solace for the work to which that I have called it to him.

It's very clear here that the Holy Ghost directs who to appoint as ministers of the Gospel. Who are going to be the pastors, the apostles, the evangelists, the pastors, the teachers, the deacons.

That's not up to us. It's up to God. God is the one that does the calling. God directs the ministry, the direction of the ministry, the direction of the church and the work of the church.

God directs the work of the church. Here to promote in the church positions of authority and so forth. People cannot volunteer to be a minister or go to school to be a minister. That's crazy.

It is God that teaches. It is God that instructs. It is God that calls. It is God that promotes.

Look at chapter 8 now. Look at chapter 8. Acts 8 verse 29. Acts 8 verse 29. Then the spirit said to Philip, go up and join this chariot. Philip didn't go up to the chariot to witness to the eunuch of his own accord, but rather he was being led by the Holy Ghost to go up to talk to that man.

It was God directing his witnessing, his step, his evangelism. He didn't just look and say, oh, there's somebody I can

witness to. No.

God said go and talk to that man. The Holy Ghost directs our evangelism. Amen. Some people are not worthy to be evangelized. Some people are not worthy of the truth. They're just going to tread it underfoot.

We see that very, very, very often, don't we? We need to be led by the Holy Ghost who and when to witness to and how that we may have God's blessings upon it, God's anointing upon our evangelism, our witnessing to people.

Let's go to Mark chapter 13. Mark 13 verse 11. page 64. Mark 13 verse 11. When they arrest you and hand you over, do not worry beforehand about what you are to say, but say whatever is given to you in that hour, for it is not you who speaks, but the Holy Breath.

In other words, Holy Spirit. But the Holy Spirit and the Holy Ghost are really the one in the same being and the one in the same spirit.

So it doesn't matter whether we say Holy Spirit, Holy Breath, Holy Ghost. We're still talking about the one and the same God. We're still talking about Jesus.

And He directs us about how to reply, how to speak, what to speak when we're in a conversation, when we're under persecution. Amen.

If we truly have God's Spirit in us, directing us, guiding us, leading us, if we are obedient to that voice, if we are truly saved and really being led by His Spirit on a daily basis, then we will be directed in how to reply, what to say and what not to say when we're being persecuted.

And regardless of what the Bible says, I would dare to say this truth, that the Holy Spirit, the Holy Ghost could have you to rebuke a person while you are being persecuted or to keep your mouth shut.

It could go either way. It is not always, without exception, always, always, always keeping your mouth shut and forgiving them.

Sometimes the Holy Ghost may actually have you to make a whip and chase them out of the building as Jesus did. Amen.

So the Holy Ghost may be doing one thing at one time, one location, one situation, but something completely different and opposite in a different situation.

You can't say that is always and forever without exception, always keeping your mouth shut and accepting the persecution.

Although we do have that teaching in the Bible, it's not every time. There are exceptions. There are different situations.

Let's go to 1 Corinthians, 1 Corinthians chapter 2, 1 Corinthians 2 verse 13. Which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words.

The teaching of the church, the teaching of the pastor, the teaching of the deacon, the teaching of the ministers of the church is led by the Spirit of God.

People hate authority. A lot of people think you no longer have to go to church, you no longer need a pastor, you no longer need prophets and apostles.

They think that way because they hate authority. That is the root cause of that thinking. Absolutely. They hate authority.

That is the root cause of them rebelling against God's servants. That we see throughout Scripture, not only Old Testament, but New Testament, even as elite as the book of Revelation, even in the end time prophecies of the church.

We see even in the millennium, even in the hundred years, even in paradise, we see in Scripture the truth of authority in the church. How even David will rule forever. Amen.

We see always from the beginning to the end, and into eternity, the structure of authority of God and his servants, the apostles, prophets, and evangelists, pastors, those chosen servants of God, and then the members, members of the church.

We see that power structure, not only in New Testament, Old Testament, and New Testament, but even in the decades after the crucifixion and the resurrection of Christ, where you had like two and three decades after the resurrection, that there was still that same power structure in the church. It wasn't done away with. Ever.

It won't be done away with in the great tribulation. You still have that power structure of the two witnesses. Amen. You still have that power structure in the millennium, and the hundred years of David on the throne, under Christ Jesus, God, and then God's chosen servants, and then the members, the people, the population, the citizens. Amen.

So, God speaks through his servants. Many, many, many times we have eyewitness right here in these sermons, how I would say things that I did not plan to say, had no idea I would say those things, had no idea I would teach those things,

and I would stand here and those words would come out of my mouth, and I said, I never knew that until right now. Amen.

We've seen that over and over and over. I don't have that much intelligence in my body that God speaks through me, even as this verse teaches. Amen.

That many of the teachings of the Apostle Paul, many of them was not his teachings, but God's teachings, was God that was teaching him, which went totally contrary to his religious school upbringing, because he had gone to religious school, when he was lost.

When he went to religious school and was an apprentice of a false leader, and a false teacher, and a cult under the Pharisees, it wasn't through the power of the Holy Ghost, but rather through the teachings of men.

He had to repent of those teachings and learn from God, and what Jesus had taught him contradicted what he had learned in religious school. These are facts.

The religious school he had went to was contrary to the Holy Ghost. While he was going to the religious school, he was persecuting the church, the people of God.

The Holy Ghost teaches us the truth and directs the ministers in their teaching, speaks in the mouth of the pastor while giving the sermons, and speaks through their writings of the apostles and prophets of the church of God.

And if it be God that speaks, and God is the one that spoke through Paul most of the time, even though sometimes his flesh got in the way, and he inserted his own thinking and his own opinions and his own customs, as he himself said he did. Amen.

People don't know it, but he said it more than once. That this is not the Lord speaking, but it's my opinion and my custom. And if it causes troubles, forget what I said. That's what he said. That's what Paul said. Sometimes his flesh got in the way. Sometimes my flesh gets in the way. Amen. That's being human. Amen.

But those times when God really did speak through Paul, which was very often, it was the word of the Lord. And when that occurred, and he wrote it down, and he wrote letters to the church, we then eventually embraced it as Scripture.

Which means holy anointed writings, anointed of God. And the same thing happened to Jeremiah, to Moses, to Hosea, to Amos, to Daniel, to Isaiah, in different generations, in different time periods throughout human history, the Maccabees.

So Old Testament, Middle Testament, and New Testament. So what makes you think is any different today?

But all these pastors and all these Christians and all these churches and all these books and all these videos, all these people, their own human thinking, saying God doesn't speak today, and that new Scripture can't be formed, and a man cannot write down what God has said, and it's not Scripture and it's not anointed because God is dead.

God is a deaf mute is basically what they're saying when they say that. God does not change. He's the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow. If God can speak through a man, He'd write it down, and it'd be considered Scripture way, way, way, way back in Moses.

And then hundreds and thousands of years pass and you get to Jeremiah, and we shouldn't skip Noah. Amen?

And we know that Noah wrote Scripture because he was a preacher of righteousness. Of course he wrote Scripture. He was a great prophet. He was a great man of God. He was the only righteous man on the entire earth. Of course he wrote Scripture. We just don't have it.

God speaks and is not a deaf mute. It is God, according to this verse right here, not my interpretation, but it is God Himself that teaches, not with human wisdom, it's not my human thoughts, it's not my human intelligence, but God's words, God's presence, God's presence, God teaching things that I didn't even know. Amen.

And the Holy Ghost that teaches His own church, His own people. Amen. The Holy Ghost is the teacher, the Bible says. Amen? And the Holy Ghost is the one that directs. Amen.

Not saying we won't ever make mistakes because the flesh gets in the way. But the Holy Ghost, if we are relying upon Him, listening to Him, will correct us. Will correct us and get us back on the right path, sooner or later.

Let's go to the book of John, John 16. And that's very important about correction. The flesh will get in the way, will go our own direction sometimes, even I myself because I'm human, but the Holy Ghost will correct us. The Holy Ghost corrects us. Amen.

John 16, verse 13. But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you in all the truth, for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak and He will disclose it to you, what is to come.

Two things there, what is to come is teaching about God will tell us about the future, rather short term future or long term future, prophecy, either way. But the other thing here in this verse is that guide you in all the truth.

Guide you in all the truth. Amen. So that if we have gone astray out of the truth, if we was doing the sunset to sunset, God corrects us. If we have done at one time the clean and unclean meats, God corrects us. Amen.

If we are willing to be corrected by scripture, by God and His true servants, if we are willing to be corrected, if we are willing to grow in truth and not be stubborn, not be stiff necked, not be powerful, but be humble and willing to be corrected and to grow in His truth, then He will do that.

He will guide us, lead us, correct us and lead us into greater truth and more truth and more truth as we continue, as time goes by and we endure into the end. Amen.

As I go through all of this, we have to ask ourselves, why did we mess up? Why did we go to that group? Why did we go to that church? Why did we follow that call? Why did we follow this? Why did we believe this? So on and so on and so on.

Was we really and truly saved? And I think the answer to a lot of that, when we were searching, when we were church hopping, when we were going here and there, and that's all of us. That's not one person. Don't get me wrong. That's not one person. That was all of us. Amen.

That was all of us. I've heard it over and over and over and over. That's not one person. That's everybody. Amen. Thank God we were seeking the truth. Amen. Thank God that we did leave those groups and keep looking and keep looking and keep looking. That's fine.

But, but, there was a problem. Because if we had really and truly had the Holy Ghost and was listening to Him the whole time, then we wouldn't have gone to that group that denied Christ.

We wouldn't have gone to that group that rejected Jesus' name or Jesus' authority or Jesus' existence or Jesus as the Messiahs. We wouldn't have gone there. We wouldn't have gone here because the Holy Ghost would have had a stop to it as He did with the apostles and said, Don't go. Amen. Repeatedly more than once. Don't go. The Holy Ghost will protect you and say, Don't go. Amen.

The Holy Ghost will say, Don't read that. Amen. The Holy Ghost will say, Don't read that ridiculous, foolish, horrible translation. The Holy Ghost will say, Don't listen to that song or don't watch that video or don't listen to that preacher or don't return back to that church.

The Holy Ghost will correct us. The Holy Ghost will lead us and the Holy Ghost will protect us from cults, false leaders, false prophets, and so forth. Amen.

Am I not speaking the truth? Amen. Does the truth not witness of Himself? Amen. But going back to the other part of that verse, yes, indicating the future. Things are to come. Amen. Warning us of things to come. Helping us to get ready for the future and so forth. Amen.

And I'm thinking right now of this guy in Memphis that had recently contacted me that he's been in a letter Y name cult for years, praying to and worshipping the letter Y name false god, rejecting Jesus' name, following a cult leader, a false prophet. And he doesn't believe that any of that is wrong. He thinks he's right. He can't be convinced otherwise, even though the reason he contacted me is for prayer because he's being paralyzed, literally, physically paralyzed, totally paralyzed by demons repeatedly for years.

For multiple years, there are times when he cannot move a muscle of his body from head to toe, cannot move. He's as stiff as a board, to use his own words, stiff as a board for long periods of time. I don't know if long periods of time is hours or 30 minutes. I don't know.

But he's had long periods of time, and even more so recently, even though it's been happening for years. He confessed as demons. He knows it's sin related to sin.

Let me tell you something. If it was the sin of anything but worshipping a false god, of praying to demons, it would not paralyze him. Amen?

I've never in my whole life heard of somebody being paralyzed by watching pornography, or committing adultery, or cussing, or being an alcoholic. Amen? None of those type of sins are severe enough that a demon would take over your body and you can't move a muscle of your body.

But I tell you a sin that will cause that is praying to Satan. Amen? That is a sin of a severity that demons will attack you. Even as multiple people have, I don't know how many people, but more than one, more than two, more than three people have contacted me over the years telling me from different regions, telling me that when they was worshipping the letter Y name, that demons were scratching under their bed at night when they were trying to sleep. Demons would

be scratching under the bed, or demons would be scratching at the door of their bedroom, or demons would be in their closet scratching at the door of their closet.

Different locations, but always demons scratching, and they would never flee when they're rebuked in the letter Y names. Amen?

They don't leave in the letter Y names. But when the person finally learns about Jesus' name and reads the I Saw the Light Ministries website, and finds that article proving, without a doubt, undeniable, totally, totally, totally undeniable proof of Jesus' name.

And that the Y names are demonic. Once they find that proof, and accept it, and return to Jesus' name, and abandon the Y names, and start rebuking the demons in Jesus' name, they leave. Demons flee in Jesus' name.

And you might have to say it more than once, with authority, that they will flee in Jesus' name. Whereas the Y names, you could say it every day and every night, over and over, and they would never leave, because they loved the letter Y names, and they're not afraid of the letter Y names. Amen?

So this person in Memphis right now is the perfect example of someone who thinks he's led by God, thinks he's led by the Holy Ghost, thinks that he is saved, and yet confesses that demons paralyze his body, and have been doing so for years and years, and getting worse.

Something's wrong. You're not saved. You don't have the Spirit of God leading you. Absolutely not. It's not that you're rebelling. It's not that you're disobeying the Holy Spirit, but rather the Holy Spirit's not leading you in the first place. You don't have the Holy Ghost.

The only presence of the Holy Ghost in that situation is the Holy Ghost puts him in contact with the ministry to try to save him, to try to deliver him. But then he resists the Holy Ghost. Amen?

The Holy Ghost says, okay, here's the truth. Here is your chance for deliverance. But then he disregards it, and rejects the truth, and throws it away, and tramples it underfoot, even though I gave him more than sufficient proof that the cult leader he's following is a false prophet, and he's got all the proof he could ever ask for on the website about the names.

And it's easy. It's logical. It's simple. I've laid it out. I've given you all the links, all the documentation, all the proof.

You don't have to, like he thinks he does, you don't have to learn the entire language to know what the truth is.

I've given you the documentation. Here's Josephus. Josephus, having lived in the first century, knowing of the customs of the temple, having his dad had been a priest in the temple, knowing that the name of God was four vows, which totally contradicts the letter lining, totally contradicts.

And how much more authoritative of a voice can you get in that situation? The son of a priest in the first century A.D. How much more authoritative can you get? How much more authority? Do you really want lightning and thunder to come down out of heaven?

It's ridiculous. For a person that don't want the truth, it don't matter how much truth you present them. You can have thunder and lightning, and they still won't accept the truth with a person like that.

He deserves to be paralyzed and continue to get worse and worse. He deserves it. After being presented with total, undeniable proof, more than sufficient proof, and still reject it, he deserves to be paralyzed. That's just the honest truth. What a man sows, he reaps. Only fools will perish in the lake of fire. Only idiots will perish in the lake of fire.

As I had said recently, that those words came to my mind, and within only a couple minutes or less of that coming into my mind, there it was. I saw it on the internet, wherever it was, wherever I saw it, just a few minutes after that came into my head.

And then I saw it with my eyes, those words that I had just thought, the exact words that I had just thought. That's the Holy Ghost. That's proof of God. That's true salvation. Amen. That's being led by the Holy Ghost.

The Holy Ghost will protect you from the absolutely ridiculous Flat Earth Theory. The Holy Ghost will give you a little bit of intelligence, logic, common sense.

The Holy Ghost will teach you and protect you, guide you and lead you, and protect you from such ridiculous, foolish, upside down theories like the Flat Earth Foolishness. The Holy Ghost has more intelligence than that. Amen.

The Holy Ghost will protect you from taking the side of the Democrats, Obama and Biden and Robert Kennedy, Alex Jones, Putin and Assad. The Holy Ghost will protect you from taking the side of the Devil. Amen.

The Holy Ghost will tell you why demons are attacking you. The Holy Ghost will correct you of your sins. And if you're a child of God, you'll accept the correction and repent. Amen.

If you don't accept the correction and repent, you're not a child of God. It's simple. Very simple.

The problem with people is they don't want to confess that they're not saved, even when all the fruits and all the

evidence says that they're not saved. They want to hold on to a tickled ear, feel good message that they are saved when all the evidence says they're not saved. Amen.

For a person to be saved, they need to confess to themselves, to God and to the church, that they need to be saved. That the Holy Ghost has not been guiding them and directing them very much at all, but rather it was their own will, their own direction, their own path, their own choices, their own decisions, their own mistakes.

That God was not present and never bit of it, except for only his voice saying that maybe perhaps. I think you don't even need God's voice to say you're in the wrong place. Amen.

Because if you have any common sense, common sense will eventually kick in and say, this ain't right, this ain't right. You don't really even need the Holy Ghost to understand the Sabbath because it's so written out plain and black and white in the Bible.

You don't need the Holy Ghost to understand rather the Sabbath is required or not required or rather clean and unclean meats is required or not required when it is laid out in black and white in the Bible in such simple language repeatedly. But what you do need the Holy Ghost for is to protect you in many different areas of life, guide you in many areas of life and help you to grow in the deeper things of God, the deeper things.

Because the Sabbath is so basic, you can accept the Sabbath and God's existence before baptism and before salvation. But being the Holy Ghost helps you to grow in deeper things that are beyond the basic elementary things, the deeper things of God.

Like the days that the Holy Days are the days that the end time prophecies what we can feel.

Oh God help us. So everybody please stand up, wherever you are, whatever nation, whatever location, whatever place you're in, please stand up and let's go in prayer.

Lord Heavenly Father Almighty God, in Jesus' holy name, if we have rejected your spirit, the Holy Ghost, or your direction, your guidance or your voice, we ask you Father to please forgive us, correct us, show us the truth and help us to receive your spirit.

Help us Lord to be saved, help us Lord to learn your voice, to hear you more accurately, more correctly and stronger than ever before.

We ask you Father for salvation, for deliverance, for help, for direction, for your teaching, for your word, for your truth.

We ask you Lord Father to be our Father, our God, our Lord, our kinsman redeemer, our husband, our pastor, our teacher, our apostle, our prophet, our shield, our hope and our strength, our future and our foundation.

We ask you Lord to be our temple and our dwelling place. We ask you Lord Heavenly Father to correct our steps and help us to become into the center of your will and once we get into the center of your will to never depart.

We ask this sincerely in the name of Jesus the Christ, the almighty alpha animator, in Jesus' name so be it. Amen. Praise God.

And now I open up the tab. Be invited as a song, a testimony, a question, a comment, anything to do or say for the Lord as Brother Robert also prepares his statements and anything.

And I'm also available on Telegram and WhatsApp and the Mixlr chat room in all of those locations as well as text messaging on the phone.

I'm available right here right now for people to give their testimonies, a word for God, a word praising the Lord, a Bible verse that you read this week that God touched your heart with, a confirmation, a question, any of these things.

A song, any of these things, type it in now or send the message now. Brother Robert, what do you have, anything to say?

That's true John. We can debate what that really is but yes, we should remember the sin, unforgivable sin of blaspheming the Holy Spirit or the Holy Ghost.

And so we should be careful not to do that rather that is continual or lifelong rebellion against God or rather that is saying that what God has done is demonic, whatever that really is.

In both cases we should not do those things, right? In both possible interpretations of that, both possible, there's really only two possibilities of what the unforgivable sin is.

It's either claiming that what God has done is demonic, is of the devil, or it is the sin of not repenting continually all the way up to the lake of fire.

In whichever case, those are things we should not do, either one of those we should not do.

Brother Robert? Let me see where the next new moon is coming up. It will be the 10th on a Saturday. So the next new moon is on February the 10th which is on the weekly 7th day.

So we'll be already here for the worship service already that day regardless of the new moon.

Anything else? "This is Hebrews 6 verse 7 and 8. For ground that drinks the rain, which often falls on it, brings forth vegetation useful to those whose sake is also told and receives a blessing from Theos.

But if it yields thorns and vessels, it is worthless and is supposed to be encouraged and ends up being burned." Amen. So the Holy Ghost will bear forth good fruit. Amen. So you have to look at the fruit of the ministry, the fruit of the pastor, the fruit of the scripture, the fruit of the book, the fruit of the teaching.

What is the fruit? Amen. It's a very important part. And if the fruit is, you're being paralyzed, increasingly so, more and more over the years.

That's not the right fruit of that ministry and of the people that you're following in that ministry. I would get out of that. Amen.

And Monica says, "I praise and thank God that He has blessed me with another day, another week of life to learn more of His truth and to grow closer to Him." Amen.

Thank you very much Monica and John and Robert. I would that more people would step up to the plate. I really would that more and more people would step up to the plate just to say one word for God, anything at all.

I'll give you some more time. People like to use the excuse of not having enough time. So I'll give you more time. Let's just stand here.

John asks the question, "With new moon and Sabbath the same day, do you do anything special?" It's just a normal worship service. When the new moon and the Sabbath follows on the same day, it's just a normal worship service.
