Miracles Biblically Required in the True Church

Amen. Praise Jesus. It's good to see everybody. Let us go in prayer. Everybody please stand no matter where you're at. Let's stand in reverence to the Lord as we pray.

Lord, Heavenly Father, Almighty God, in Jesus' holy name, thank you Lord for getting us through this week.

Thank you for waking us up today. Thank you for giving us life and life more abundantly.

Thank you for changing our hearts and our minds, our souls and our lives. Thank you for shining your light in darkness, for delivering us from false religion, from false denominations, false churches, false pastors.

Thank you for drawing us to yourself. Thank you Lord for this holy day right here, this weekly holy day, this day of rest and worship.

Thank you for a way that we can gather together, that we can join in with like-minded believers around the world.

We do lift them up to you in prayer, every one of them that follows this ministry.

And those that don't follow this ministry that are truly yours, we lift them up to you that you would shine upon them your favor, your help, strength, direction, guidance, healing and deliverance.

Help in time of need, encouragement, help in their finances, their bodies and their minds, all of our brothers and sisters around the world, in each nation, especially those that are struggling the worst.

We do pray Lord that you provide a home for Hugh and Dominique and their children, that you would give them a breakthrough, a way and a means of a home.

We ask Lord for healing and deliverance. We ask for your special blessing and anointing upon this message today, your help in delivering this message, your anointing.

Let us turn to Mark 16. Mark chapter 16. What we're about to read, Mark 16, wasn't really written by Mark, but rather, how would you pronounce his name?

Ariston, the elder, verses 9 through 20 of Mark 16, verses 9 through 20 do not belong in the book of Mark, but are still treated as scripture, written by this elder, a disciple of John.

This disciple of John, a true member of the church, a person that did write scripture.

We don't have much of his writings, but we do have this. We're going to skip down to verse 16.

Let's back up to verse 15. Verse 15, Jesus said to them, go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation, meaning all tribes, all people of the earth.

Verse 16, he who has believed and has been baptized both. Not just believing like the churches teach today, but those that have both believed and have been baptized, shall be saved.

Shall be saved. That doesn't necessarily mean we'll be saved, but shall be as in can be saved.

We know that Matthew chapter 7 does talk about that there will be many people that call upon the name of the Lord.

They do believe. They probably have been baptized. A lot of them have, but yet Jesus would say to them, get away from me. I never knew you, but this is a possibility that as long as you do these two things, then there is a possibility that you may be saved, that you can be saved.

There's a lot more to it than just believing and being baptized. You also have to do the Passover communion.

The book of John says over in either chapter 3 or chapter 6 that if you, and I think it's chapter 6, whichever, that if you do not take this, the body and blood of Christ, talking about through the communion, through the Passover communion, then there is no life in you.

There's no eternal life. That means you're not saved. So believing is one step. baptism is another step.

Passover communion is another step. And every one of these and other steps as well.

Doing the Fiesta of Tabernacles and Pentecost and the weekly Sabbath, every one of these are steps and requirements of true salvation.

Every one of these. If you lack any one of them, any of them, you're not saved. Now there may be that you take the first step and truly be saved and you take the next step.

There is probably you're not doing all of them in the same week, so you can be saved if you've been baptized in the past six months and you've not done Passover yet and this would be your first Passover.

But there is the requirement of all of them sooner or later that you have to do every step.

You have to take the whole Bible and not just one verse. Amen. You have to take the whole Bible.

And it says also in verse 16, the last part of the verse is back he who has not believed shall be condemned.

Verse 17, these signs can come from commitment in my name, casting out demons, speaking with new tongues, picking up serpents, and if drinking any deadly poison it will not hurt them.

Laying hands in the sick and they will recover. These are several different types of miracles that are possible with true, truly saved people.

People that have really truly surrendered and committed to God. These are some possibilities.

Now we know that some of this is also possible or all of it really is also possible even with lost people, false prophets, false ministers, false churches that even like in the Catholic Church they're casting out demons or it looks like it seems like to the human appearance to the human eyes it looks like they are casting out demons.

And there's many people that speak in false tongues, just gibberish, and even demonic tongues that are not coming from God but coming from the devil.

So there's the fake manifestation or even demonic manifestation of really any of these things.

So these things all by themselves do not necessarily prove that someone is saved.

We know that Moses picked up, well threw down the staff and it turned into the snake, he picked it back up, it turned back into the staff, but the servants of Pharaoh did the same thing, but they were of the devil.

So there are demonic manifestations and we know that the Bible warns us against demonic miracles in the end time, that there be all kinds of miracles even far coming down from heaven.

We know that the Antichrist will actually appear in heaven in a fake rapture and in a fake coming of the Lord.

There are great, great miracles that are going to occur in our time and we're warned about those.

So miracles in themselves all by themselves do not prove a true believer and a truly saved person in the true church, but nevertheless, but nevertheless true miracles are biblically required. Absolutely. Amen.

These miracles, some of them, different people, different congregations, different ministers, different pastors, different prophets, different apostles within the true church are going to have different types of miracles, both listed here and listed in other places in the Bible, different types of miracles and gifts from God that will absolutely be manifested. Amen.

So even though miracles by themselves do not prove a true servant of God, such miracles are nevertheless required and if you're following a minister, a pastor, a church, part of the church that does not manifest miracles, then they're lacking any spirit. Amen.

Miracles can be performed by spirits and demons and of Satan, but miracles can be performed by the Spirit of God. Amen.

But a church or pastor or minister that has no miracles, you're lacking any type of manifestation, outward manifestation of any spirit. Amen.

Now healing is one miracle here and in the false churches, you're going to have some demonic false healings, but you're also going to have healing that just comes from taking the doctor's medicine sometimes. Amen.

Sometimes the doctor would give you the right prescription. Sometimes the doctor would give you the right medicine that you really do need and that is effective for you.

Sometimes it will have side effects. Sometimes it's not the right medicine for you.

Sometimes it'll make you worse, but sometimes medicine works and is good for you and that's not necessarily from God, but yet they would go to church and they would testify, God healed me.

How many times have we heard that when actually it was the medicine, when actually it was the natural remedy or it was the doctor's medicine, whichever the case may be, what the person did to help themselves and not necessarily God or a miracle or a healing from heaven.

So we must look at types of miracles beyond healing, beyond healing, even though healing is a sometimes truly from

God, many times is from doctors and natural remedies and what we're doing to help ourselves.

So we need to look when we're looking at if a church or pastor or a minister has miracles as biblically required, we need to go beyond the healing, healing miracles because that could be just the natural remedy working or the doctor working.

The same thing with like people getting a job, ancient prayers, so-called ancient prayers, they pray for a job, they get it. Well you filled out the application. Okay there's a possibility you're gonna get the job, that's not necessarily even if you did pray, that's not necessarily an ancient prayer, you filled out the application, you applied for the job, you got it. Okay that's not necessarily an ancient prayer. So we need to go beyond things like this, things that we can't deny that are truly miracles, that have you didn't do anything to bring it about and nobody else did anything to bring it about.

We need to look for true honest to goodness real miracles where there's no explanation other than a spirit, whether it be the spirit of God or the spirit of the devil, we're looking for a manifestation of a spirit and then test it to see if it'd be from God or the devil and also you've got to look for correct doctrine as well, right?

So if you're looking at a miracle within the Catholic Church, it may be a miracle and divine a manifestation of a spirit but you don't have the correct doctrine, therefore you're testing the miracle that it's not from God but rather from a demonic spirit, even if the statue is crying or bleeding, it's just a statue.

This is not from God, that's a demonic manifestation. Amen? And they may actually cast out demons in the Catholic Church but you don't have correct doctrine.

So miracles by themselves do not prove a church or minister as being from God but you must have true manifestations from God but you must also have correct doctrine to have a biblical church. Amen?

Now we're going to look at some different possibilities other than the speaking of tongues, lifting up serpents and healing, things like that.

What are other types of miracles that we can look for? We think of in the Bible the biblical examples, one of them is divine protection.

Divine protection where it had to have been God, not what we did. Amen? It had to have been, well, a spirit we'll say. And we think of in the Bible the three young Hebrew being men that was thrown into the fiery furnace in the book of Daniel chapter 2 or chapter 3, how they were thrown into the fiery furnace but they were not burnt.

They didn't even smell like smoke when they came out. That was a true divine miracle of protection.

Divine protection is one of the manifestations of things that you can look for and if is a church or pastor or minister really have a spirit or be from God or are they lacking in divine protection.

Now we know that sometimes the true people of God are martyred as well but nevertheless in the years before they're martyred them you have seen examples of divine protection and every person in the Bible that was martyred for God they had a track record of divine protection for many years up until the point that they actually was eventually martyred. Amen?

Think of Daniel, Ezekiel, Jeremiah all of them was eventually martyred but they had a track record of years and years and years of divine protection.

We think of Sister Kiki in Australia how on the Feast of Tabernacles whatever year that was she gave this testimony I think last week it was maybe perhaps sometime recently how she had testified about that the Feast of Tabernacles how that she saw a snake and it seemed like I think from what I understand it was near to her and she's scared to death of snakes and there's a lot of very deadly poisonous snakes in Australia very deadly poisonous snakes there in Australia and the birds came down and attacked the snake and kept and kept chasing it away and attacking it. That's divine protection. Amen.

We think of Hanukkah of 2019 when me and brother Jared was out on a mission to do the work of God.

And it was at night, it was dark, we was walking through some woods. Didn't have a flashlight turned on, anything like that.

And I ran into a tree branch and it went into my eye. And I yanked it out and I felt several inches, at least three inches or more, coming out of my eye when I pulled it out.

It was in there. And, you know, I kind of expected blood and blindness. Thoughts were going through my mind of going to the emergency room. Am I ever going to be able to see again out of this eye?

And I did not have to go to the emergency room. I did not. I did not even follow up with a doctor even. My eyesight

was fine.

That's divine protection. Amen. How do you get several inches of a tree branch into your eye without any blood? That's divine. That's divine protection. Amen. And we was on a mission for God at the time. And God protected us. Amen.

And another manifestation of a miracle is divine favor. Amen. Divine favor.

We think of in the Bible how Joseph was eventually promoted to great power, authority in Egypt.

Even though Joseph had great trials and difficulties being sowed into slavery, betrayed by his own brothers, thrown down into a pit, sowed into slavery, and so forth.

False accusations of pride that was bore against him by his brothers. He had a lot of trials and difficulties.

But he was eventually promoted to great power and authority in Egypt. Amen. Divine favor. Amen.

We think of Sister Kiki and how I remember that she gave a testimony one time that her fruit trees was bearing fruit in the very first year that these trees had been planted.

And normally a lot of times you don't get fruit on a fruit tree until the third or even the fourth or fifth year sometimes.

But her fruit trees did bear fruit the very first year. Divine favor. Amen. Another type of miracle that you see in the Bible and that you see in the lives of his true servants is divine presence or divine manifestations.

God's presence and manifestations such as in the Bible the burning bush. Amen. And cloud by day, manifestations. We saw in Acts 10, Peter, how that Peter saw the fishing net come down out of the sky and it was full of food.

And he wouldn't touch it. He wouldn't eat it. He kept denying that God had cleansed these animals. But God kept telling him repeatedly that he had cleansed these animals.

And that he should rise up and kill and eat these animals. Even though Peter did not understand what he was hearing, he was very rebellious and stiff necked, it was still a divine manifestation and divine presence of God.

I think back to October 2009 when I saw the cloud in the sky that turned into the shape of a turtle and into the shape of a snail.

Same cloud. And I can't remember for sure which one had happened first, whether it was the turtle or the snail.

But it transformed into that shape and then into the other shape and then back to the first animal again.

And when I say that this cloud looked like a snail and a turtle, I don't mean like a lot of times when people say that cloud looks like this and you look up and you can't see the same thing or just barely see the same thing.

But rather this was extreme detail, like an artist drawing sketch. Every, every, every, every detail.

In the turtle, you can see all the powdering on the turtle shell. The legs, the head, every detail.

In great detail. Like a great artist had drawn it. And then with the snail, you could see the whatever you call the antennas on top.

And the entire shape, everything, every detail. The swirl that you would see on the back, every detail.

This was, and then back into the first one. This is not my imagination, this is not my creative imagination.

And this cloud was also very low in the sky just as in Acts 10 that these animals come down from heaven. This is divine manifestation.

I think back in 2008 when I was walking on the side of the highway with the sign that said Russia will invade U.S.

And how I found the giant set of chains and hooks that are right here underneath this table where we have the candles, seven candles lit right now.

It's in that box under there. Brother Jared has seen it many times. Giant hooks and chains. And how that as soon as I returned back to my tent that I pulled open Ezekiel 38 and to my shocking surprise, verse 4 says that I will put hooks in their jaws.

Into the jaws of Gog, Magog — Russia and China — and drag them into your land. Pull them into your land.

That's not coincidence. That's divine manifestation. Divine manifestation. I think back one year when I was at a particular location where we was living in tents, different location.

And this woman comes to me to try to tell me that the Sabbath is not every Saturday but rather that we should go by what they call the lunar Sabbath.

In the lunar Sabbath theory, you start with the first day of the month with the new crescent moon and you count to seven.

And regardless of what day of the week that falls on, the seventh day of the month and the 14th and the 21st and the 28th of the month is always the Sabbath regardless of what day it falls on.

So you would have a different Sabbath day in every month. One month it might be Mondays, the next month it might be Tuesdays, the next month it might be Wednesdays.

But you would always ignore the 29th and 30th day of the month and not even count those as one too.

Not even count them, just ignore them and start over with the first of the month again to count to seven.

That's stupid and I knew it was stupid but nevertheless God worked a divine miracle, a divine manifestation in order to just keep me very solid in the truth that I would not ever ever ever in my life be shaken from the truth that it is definitely Saturday only and no other day of the week.

And you don't have to count the days of the month in order to find the weekly Sabbath which you never find that instruction in the Bible.

Amen, you never find that instruction in the Bible. You find count the days of the month for Tabernacles and for Passover and things like that, yes, but you are never instructed in the Bible to count the days of the month to find the weekly Sabbath.

That's just silly and cannot be backed up by the Bible at all. Nevertheless, so that I would never ever in my entire life be shaken from the truth in that matter.

I was looking one day for boxes to pack something up to ship and I got a box out of the dumpster and didn't see what was written on it.

It was just the right size, did not see what was written on the bottom of the box.

Bring it back home and it said, "Jesus Calling, Saturday Only!" That's God. That's God. Amen. Divine manifestations.

We think here also how that we very often, extremely often, have divine confirmations of the sermons.

Even a lot of times while I'm preaching I will say something that's going to be in the very next verse and I don't even know it's in the next verse.

Sometimes, a lot of times, I don't read every verse ahead of time and I'm just living, I'm just talking, I'm just letting the Spirit of God move and I say something and then we say, okay, let's go to the next verse and there it is, what I just said. How many times have we seen that repeatedly and other types of divine confirmations of the sermons and divine confirmations of the doctrines? Amen.

For example, I think back in November 2016, how one day I sent out a ministry newsletter email and I said in that newsletter email, I said, very specifically, when Jesus comes back, he will burn every copy of the King James Version Bible on earth.

Every copy of the King James Version Bible, he will burn when he comes back. A few minutes later, after that, somehow or another, I saw, I think somebody has sent it to me, a news article how that just the day before, a local man or a man locally had found a one page, only one page of the King James Version Bible.

That had been burned. The rest of the Bible had been completely burned and annihilated.

He found this one burnt page and only part of that page because the rest of it had been burnt to ashes.

There was only a section from the book of Joel, and if you want to turn there right now, Joel chapter one, this was the only part of that entire Bible that was left.

I estimate it because it was a great forest fire and there was a lot of houses and businesses and churches that had been destroyed.

The area is very dominated by people that believe in the King James Version only.

There would have been King James Version Bibles in those homes, in those churches, in those businesses.

It was a great, horrible, big giant forest fire. I estimate it that probably, most likely, there was probably over a thousand King James Version Bibles that was burnt in that fire.

The Great Gatlinburg Fire of November 2016. You can verify that in the news to look up that fire.

Page 595, if you have the one volume of the Alpha and Omega Bible, which is what we use, the Alpha and Omega Bible, the most accurate Bible, using older manuscripts than what was used for the King James Version.

Joel 1, verse 13, Joel 1, verse 13, and these are the verses that did remain, the only verses out of that entire Bible that that man found that actually remained on this one single page and it was burnt all the way around the page, from verse 13 there all the way to chapter 2, verse 1.

So it said, on that burnt page, it said, gird yourselves, of course this is a different translation, but nevertheless these are the verses, gird yourselves with sackcloth and lament, or mourn, you priests, mourn you that serve at the altar, go in, sleep in sackcloths, you that minister to Theos, for the meat offering and the drink offerings are withheld from the house of your Theos.

Sanctify a fast, proclaim a solemn service, and gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land into the house of

your Theos and cry earnestly to Jesus.

Alas, alas, alas, for the day, for the day of Jesus is near, and it will come as trouble upon trouble, or tribulation upon tribulation.

Your meat has been destroyed before your eyes, joy and gladness from out of the house of your Theos.

The heifers have started at their mangers, the treasures are abolished, the wine presses are broken down, for the grain is withered, what shall we store up for ourselves?

The herds of cattle have mourned because they have no pasture, and the flocks of sheep have been utterly destroyed.

To you, O Lord, will I cry, for fire has devoured the fairer places of the wilderness, and this was a forest fire, the fire has devoured the fairer places of the wilderness, and a flame has burnt up all the trees of the field.

This was felt on a burnt page of the Bible. This is divine. This is divine miracle. You talk about miracles?

This is a miracle. And it continues, verse 20, and the cattle of the field have looked up to you, for the fountains of water have been dried up, and fire has devoured the fairer places of the wilderness, sound the trumpet in Zion, make a proclamation in my holy mountain, and let all the inhabitants of the land or the earth be disturbed, for the day of Jesus is near.

Praise God. Can I hear people all the way around the world right now shake the entire earth with praises by shouting and lifting your hands to God?

What a divine, powerful miracle. Have you ever in your life heard of such a great miracle? Amen?

Have you ever in your life? This is so powerful. Amen. And like I said, the man felt that page the day before I sent that message out, but I didn't know it.

I didn't know that. God is my witness. I didn't know it. And I write in that newsletter, God will burn every copy of the King James Bible when he returns, and then only minutes later, if somebody sends me or however it was that I saw that news article, that the man found the King James Bible burnt with only one page and not even a full page left. That's God. Amen. Divine manifestation.

Now, another miracle that we should absolutely find among the true, truly saved people and among the true church is prophetic revelation.

Prophetic revelation. You think in the Bible how God worked, gave divine prophetic revelation to God.

A lot of people, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, Joel, Amos, and others, and even the apostle Paul, even in the New Testament, Paul had a divine gift of prophecy.

Let's see, 2 Thessalonians chapter 2 that Paul wrote is very divinely prophetic. Amen.

A lot of people don't think of Paul as a prophet, but 2 Thessalonians 2 is extremely prophetic, and 1 Thessalonians 4 as well, and some other elements of Paul's writings as well, being prophetic.

And 2 Thessalonians 2 is extremely, extremely important for the end time in a prophetic nature.

But while we're in Joel, let's look at Joel chapter 2 verse 28. Joel 2 verse 28. This is a prophecy for our day and time, our end time. And all my servants and all my handmaids in those days will I pour out my ghosts, and I will show wonders in heaven, or signs in heaven, and upon the earth, blood and fire and vaporous mote, and the sun be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, and as far as the water appears to us in the eyes, before the great and glorious day of the Lord Jesus comes. Amen.

That's talking about the sixth seal right there. But if we are truly living in the end time, as many people claim, and we are, then we should be seeing even before the sixth seal the manifestation of God in our lives, in his church, in his true servants, including prophecy, not just only in the sixth seal.

Let's look at the book of Revelation chapter 19. Revelation 19 verse 10. Revelation 19 verse 10. He said to me, do not do that, for I am a fellow servant of yours and your brethren who hold the testimony of Jesus.

Worship the theos, God, for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

The Amplified Bible says, for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. His life and teaching are the heart of prophecy.

The NIV says, for it is the spirit of prophecy who bears witness or bears testimony to Jesus.

A lot of people despise prophecy. A lot of people love prophecy. You've got these two different mind frames of different groups and different people.

But more and more and more, you've got a lot of people out there that totally despise prophecy.

The Bible says, despise not prophecy and prophesy. Prophecy is important. If we're living in the end time, then the

book of Revelation and even a large portions of Daniel, Ezekiel and Jeremiah and Joel is for our day, our time, our lifetime.

We should be paying attention to these Old Testament prophets, Jeremiah, Daniel and Ezekiel and Joel and Amos and others are very relevant to us, to our generation, even if they are in the Old Testament. Amen.

They connect, prophecy connects these scriptures to our lives in a very real manifestation that's going to be right in front of our eyes.

We're seeing the Bible fulfilled right in front of our eyes all the time. We think about how Israel, a lot of Israel as far as the tribes of Judah has been regathered back to Israel in these last 50 to 70 years, whereas they were scattered all across the earth for the last 2,000 years.

That they've been scattered across the earth and now been brought back to their land and more and more and more every year, more and more Jews are being brought back to the Holy Land. That's a fulfillment of scripture right there. Amen.

In China, a lot of the anti-prophecies were only possible in our lifetime, nuclear warfare and the number of the army of China in the book of Revelation of the millions.

And so for a lot of prophecy has only been possible to be fulfilled only within our lifetime and could not have been fulfilled in the 1800s and earlier.

Prophecy is the spirit of Christ. We think of how in this ministry how God has given us the divine revelation of Purim and Passover and how that there's going to be fulfillment of end time prophecy written in the Bible on those specific dates.

The dates, the true dates of God's biblical holy days. Purim, Passover and Day of Atonement and Pentecost and a fifth one.

We got it. Purim, Passover, Pentecost, Trumpets. Trumpets is always the ones I always forget. Trumpets and then Atonement.

Those five holy days spread out over a three and a half year time frame of great tribulation.

On those five holy days, major historical events occur to fulfill major end time prophecy.

That's very specific. Very specific dates even though we're not for sure of the year yet.

Those are still very specific dates of the year that will fulfill major end time prophecy.

And we'll see that fulfilled in front of our eyes. And even though you can't see that being fulfilled yet, there's no possibility, absolutely zero, that that's incorrect because all you have to do is read what the Bible says, Daniel chapter 12.

The question is asked, how long will it be to the end of these things? And the answer was, from the time of the abomination of desolation, 1290 days.

And bless is he that comes to the 1335th day. And all you got to do is compare that number 1290 and 1335 with Revelation 11 where it talks about 1260 days.

And the difference between 1260 and 1290 is 30 days. And if you start with Purim, there is exactly 30 days from Purim to Passover.

And then if you start with Purim and count your 1335 and count your 1290 and so forth, and you can do this both frontward and backwards, and come out over, if you lay this timeline over a calendar of three and a half years of great tribulation, how that automatically, automatically if you start with Purim, automatically 30 days later is Passover.

And then so many days later is Pentecost, then so many days later is Trumpets, then so many days later is Atonement.

And then take other variations of Numbers in the Bible about end time prophecy and put it on that same calendar, overlay in it, and however detail, every detail, every detail comes out to the exact number of days on the Holy Days.

Not just one Holy Day, not just two Holy Days, not just three Holy Days, not just four Holy Days, but five biblical Holy Days, which proves that the end time New Covenant Church should be observing those biblical Holy Days because major, huge, prophetic events will be accomplished in our day and time on those dates.

So why should we not observe them? It proves the requirement to observe them. And if we don't observe them, then when those events come, we won't be ready for them.

We won't be prepared for them. We won't be looking for those events on that date, and we'll be shocked and prepared, and Jesus will come as a thief in the night to the people that are unprepared.

He will not come as a thief in the night to his own bride. Amen. His bride will have her dress pressed and ready, no wrinkle, no blemish. And the bride of Christ in her dress, she'll be ready.

She'll be watching. Amen. She'll be watching. Her own groom will not come as a thief to his bride. Absolutely not.

Amen. That's a very divine prophetic revelation, extremely.

And then we also think of the divine prophetic revelation of the true meaning of 666 and the true identities of the four horsemen.

And those two prophetic revelations confirm each other. And the Bible should be confirming itself.

That's how you know you've got the true doctrine and the true prophecy is when the Bible actually confirms it rather than these vain imaginations and private interpretations of prophecy.

Which you find all across YouTube, all across Facebook, all across the internet, and all these cults and all these groups, Seventh-day Adventist Church, Jehovah Witness Church, and the Y-Name cults, and all these different groups, and all these female false prophecies, as well as the men.

I mean, the world is overflowing with false prophecies and everyone has their own private interpretation of prophecy, which the Bible says that you should not have a private interpretation of prophecy, et cetera.

But with what God gave us, the Bible confirms and you can't deny it. If you take the time to sincerely examine the scripture with what we have proclaimed with these prophecies and with the doctrine, you can't deny it.

It's absolutely undeniable. A lot of people take the knee-jerk reaction. That's a quick reaction without sincerely examining the proof. And then, because in their mentality, it's impossible that they could be wrong, impossible that they might be wrong, impossible that they're deceived.

The deceived don't know that they're deceived because they don't examine themselves, which is another purpose of the Holy Days, is taking time to deeply and sincerely and honestly examine yourself, your doctrine, your faith, your belief, your salvation, everything about yourself, to test and examine yourself.

But if you don't have these Holy Days, you're not doing that. Amen. Not to the extent that you need to. Amen.

There are so many reasons to keep the biblical Holy Days. So, miracles are required, as we've been talking about, but you must also have the church, the ministry, the pastor that teaches and focuses, that has a great focus on repentance, which is very lacking in a lot of the churches.

New Age churches, they don't teach repentance in the New Age churches, not at all, because that mentality, the New Age mentality, is do as you want, which is the satanic motto, literally, do as you want.

Repentance, healing, casting out devils, divine presence, divine protection, divine favor, prophetic revelation, and other types of miracles must be present, but you must have correct doctrine that lines up with scripture.

But also, we also need to understand, and this is what is totally lacking in other groups, other churches, totally lacking, is also understanding that the Apostle Paul and the prophets and people that wrote the Bible, they were human.

And sometimes they heard from God, but sometimes they were a little off. Paul and the prophets of oath actually repeatedly, repeatedly and repeatedly said that the Lord was coming back, basically, in their lifetime.

Such phrases and such words as the Lord is at hand, the day is at hand, they believed and they taught and they proclaimed in their congregations and their followers, absolutely, they taught that Jesus was coming back in their lifetime.

But were they false prophets? No. Of course not. Paul and Ezekiel and Jeremiah, they were not false prophets, even though they did proclaim the coming of the Lord in their lifetime, so they had the timing wrong, but nevertheless, correct prophecy.

And correct prophecy is the most important part, rather than the timing, unless you get down into the certificate details of divine revelation about these holy days, which is important as far as the holy day rather than the year. Amen.

I hope that this has helped someone, somebody today. I hope that this has helped you in some way or edified you or encouraged you or helped you to make up your mind, because this and what we're teaching today is absolutely biblical. Amen.

I've opened up the chat room now on Mixlr and also if anybody has my contact information on Telegram or text message or WhatsApp, however you're able to contact me, this is the time to speak up if you have any questions about prophecy, if you have any questions about miracles or anything I said today.

Also, if you have a testimony for the Lord, if you want to sing a song right now, if you want to play a musical instrument, if you have a dream or prophecy to share, if you have a Bible verse that you read this week that you want to share to encourage the church or edify the church, this is the time to do any of these things so that you may propitiate in the worship service in this way.

Calm Adam up in Kansas, he says, actually he's quoting 1 Timothy 4. 1 Timothy 4 verse 13 and 14 says, until I come, give attention to the reading of scripture, to preaching and teaching.

Do not neglect the spiritual gift within you, which was bestowed on you through prophetic utterance with the laying on of hands by the ministers. Amen.

Praise God. Until I come, not until Christ dies or until John dies or until Paul dies, which is what a lot of people are teaching more and more every year, a lot of these false preachers out there teaching on YouTube and so forth that we should not pay any attention to prophecy.

That there is no gift of prophecy, that there are no apostles, that there are no prophets of the end time, that there's no prophets after Paul died and John died.

That absolutely cannot be backed up by scripture. People that proclaim such, they don't know the Bible, they don't understand the Bible, they're not called of God to preach, they're not called of God to teach, they're ignorant of scripture, they do not have the Spirit of God, they are not saved, they are wolves in sheep's clothing and it's absolutely ridiculous that they have thousands and thousands and thousands of followers on YouTube.

The more followers that someone has, the more lies that they embrace and that's to God the honest truth.

The world is full of insanity and wickedness and only getting more and more wicked, you can see that yourself.

How the world is becoming more and more intensely wicked every, every, every year, every year without exception and yet, and yet their number of followers are increasing.

That's not logical, that's not logical if the Bible promises demonic miracles in the end time, demonic manifestations, great deception.

What does the Bible say in Timothy also? That in the end time, in the last days that they will heap to themselves false teachers, amen.

They will heap to themselves, they will gather to themselves false teachers that tickle the ears.

So the more followers that any church, the mega churches, the big famous preachers, the best sellers, the New York Times best sellers, if somebody's on the best sellers list, you need to stay away from that book, that person that wrote that book as far away as you can because they are not of God.

If the world is full and overflowing with false doctrine, falsehood, lies, deception and wickedness, why would you have a million followers?

It's impossible, it's impossible, amen. The church is a small flock, the true church, Jesus himself called the church my little flock, little flock, not no mega church, he never said my mega church, amen.

Now of course the numbers will increase in the final year especially of the great tribulation, the Bible does promise us that, that there will be a great number of people that could not even be counted that do get saved in the final year of the great tribulation, but that's the final year, that's not now, that's not this year, amen.

That's the final year of the great tribulation that there will be a great number of people that finally get saved.

And MRWCC says, I praise Jesus for the trials that I have been going through lately and especially this week.

My husband had spinal surgery that could have easily left him a paralytic, but it went fine.

I have been very busy these past couple of weeks getting my house ready to put up for sale and had two people come this week and look and one looks promising.

My son was arrested and is in jail for something stupid he did last year and lately my agent computer keeps stopping during the messages.

As a human it is hard not to worry, I am earnestly trying to give God my burdens and let him lead me and provide.

I am so grateful for this Sabbath day of rest and worship, everything is working out according to his will, will work out according to his will, amen.

Praise Jesus. Thank you for sharing that. Brother Jared, you have anything? "I'm looking for a verse, it's a verse that says something like, 'I rise unto the Father and you will perform greater miracles than these.'"

Oh yeah, the Bible says, okay I'll try to find that real quick, where Jesus said that those that believe in him or whatever commit to him will perform even greater miracles, even greater miracles than this.

John 14. John chapter 14, around verse 12 or so in that area. Okay, John 14 verse 12, even verse 11, let's go back to verse 11. Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, otherwise believe because of the works themselves.

Verse 12, truthfully I tell you the absolute truth, he who entrusts his soul to me, the works that I do, he will do also and

greater than these will he do because I go to the Father, amen.

Jesus worked great, powerful, wonderful, huge miracles that he himself said that his followers shall do even greater miracles, amen.

So if you go to a church and the greatest miracle you ever see is somebody got a job or somebody got over the flu or somebody got over this or that or sickness or even healed of cancer, even healed of cancer.

Well people get healed of cancer when they take chemotherapy, radiation, so forth.

They do go into remission. Sometimes God helps that along but it's not necessarily God.

We need to see miracles other than healings, other than jobs, other than so-called blessings and so forth.

Other types of miracles are needed to really and truly confirm. It's got to be something where there's no other possibility.

Like when I pulled several inches of wood out of my eye and there was no blood, not even a job.

That's a miracle and nobody could ever, ever deny that.

So, but we also have to have correct doctrine as well. That can be backed up by scripture when the scripture is tested. Because you've got all kinds of people that say, okay, what I teach, what they teach does align with scripture but if you take the time to carefully examine it, it doesn't line up with scripture.

Like the Trinity doctrine, pre-trib rapture, Christmas, Easter, all these different things, once saved, always saved.

The people that believe in all that crap, they will claim that it lines up with scripture and they will try to give scripture to try to prove their points.

But when you examine those same scriptures, they don't prove what they are saying.

They take them out of context, they twist, they distort and then they at the same time, they ignore tons of other verses that if they even looked at those verses and considered those verses, will absolutely and totally and undeniably prove them wrong.

And when you share one of those verses with them, they change the point. They change the point.

They change the topic. They move on to something else because they know it proved them wrong and they don't want to admit it every time. Amen.

They just totally ignore those other scriptures which is a red flag. Why don't they answer the question? Why don't they talk about the verses that we bring up that does prove them wrong and they just don't want to talk about it? Amen.

And we also have Tom Adams says, are there more spiritual gifts than what the Bible lists?

And I would say yes. Amen. I would say yes because God is so awesome, God is so great that there are many types of things and we could go all day and all night about what the Bible does.

List God talking through a donkey and the plagues upon Egypt. And I mean we could go all day and all night with the miracles that are in the Bible, but absolutely I would say that there are types of miracles and different manifestations that are not in the Bible.

Not everything is in the Bible. Amen. Not everything is in the Bible. But we got to start with the Bible and the Bible does talk about the gifts as well which are miracles.

The gift of knowledge, the gift of tongues and the interpretation of tongues and types of miracles and it even says in that list of the gifts of the Spirit, it says diverse types of miracles and diverse types of healings.

And so for those great variety of manifestations of God. Maybe later today something will come on top of my head.

I can't think of anything right now but I'm sure that there are types of miracles and forms of miracles that the Bible doesn't really cover because not everything could be written and the Bible even says that not everything could be written. Amen.

And we don't know how many books of the Bible we don't have such as the writings of Ariston or however you pronounce his name in Mark 16.

We have only that little tiny segment of what he wrote. Amen. You got to consider also Philo wrote a whole lot that's not in the Bible that we don't consider Bible, that we don't consider scripture but maybe we should.

What Philo wrote, he wrote the book of wisdom of Solomon in the Old Testament which most Bibles don't even include but was originally there.

And then the book of Hebrews Philo wrote. Philo of Alexandria, he wrote the book of Hebrews.

He's the only one that we know of that wrote an Old Testament book and a New Testament book as well.

But we have lots of books of his writings that never appeared as biblical manuscripts.

But if he wrote two books of the Bible but he wrote many other books why wouldn't we consider those as possibly

divine to some nature to some extent.

But he wrote a lot, a whole lot.

Anything else? "Yeah. How it says to believe because of the works themselves.

So when I was looking for, trying years ago before I came to this ministry but before that I was an atheist and then I started looking at the politics and reading the Bible and thinking about these things.

And seeing how the political state of the world is so unstable. And so I'm trying to get some of my questions answered about God and the Bible and so on. And I see all these ministries making ridiculous claims that can be easily disproven. And then there is this ministry doing a lot of claims that look, some of them are, it's like the basis sounds extravagant at first, but then when you look at it it proves to be true. Particularly the number of days between Purim and the Day of Atonement being exactly, a Day of Atonement three years later being exactly 1293.5 days, 1293 days practically every year. And even some of the ones where it doesn't, it's the way that the new moon might fall in one day or the day after and maybe it's actually really the day after and it's not long. But just to happen that way consistently.

And then other things like the mark of the beast, the physical manifestation in the end times being the Islamic halal mark which will be put on everything they sell as they conquer the nations. And how that, that's a very obvious and logical conclusion that fulfills the prophecy because it's a mark of a product or service being sacrificed, dedicated to Allah." Yes, amen.

"But no one who seems to make that claim even though it's obvious. And there are several others such as the identity of the son of perdition, the anti-Christ being Assyrian which is, what nationality is that? That's Syrian, obviously.

But no, there was one like, one person, one crazy guy, a Y names person, but basically no one, basically no one making that claim even though it's, it should be the obvious default claim."

And even that one guy that he was talking about that was proclaiming Assad as the anti-Christ, he's pretty much wiped off the map on the internet now.

You can't even find him on YouTube now. But there's some very few more minor guys that are on YouTube claiming Assad as the anti-Christ, but they're so minor and that's the only thing they got right. They have nothing else right.

"If enough monkeys throw darts at a dartboard, one of them gets a bullseye. But it's not being claimed en masse or it's not popular like, there was the Protestant prophecy doctrine that was popular even in the times of Isaac Newton, what was it, the fifth trumpet about an angel that had fallen from the, some of them had said, oh that's Muhammad. And it would actually make sense for that claim to be made. And that doctrines like that were possible, but they also were popular.

But you don't hear anyone making the same claim in this case, even though people make wide and varying claims of prophecy, you don't hear them saying that the Assyrian is the Assyrian. And there are several other examples like that. It's just like, how is it even possible that no one's claiming it, except for this one ministry that's claiming a ton of other things, which it looks crazy when you examine it's true, or at least can't be true."

The truth looks strange and crazy because we never heard it before. Amen. And then if we take time, sincere time, real time, and read every word, because people a lot of time they just glance through the page and they're not reading every word and that's why they still don't believe and that's why they still are not sure, is because they're so quick to just glance through the article instead of reading in detail every word and examining every word to get the real and the full, the points and the principles that we're bringing up.

You've got to examine every word of it in order to get the full examination.

A lot of great points there, and while it's on my mind also, the gift of interpretation of tongues, very biblical, but people are very narrow minded in what that means.

So things that's not in the Bible, a lot of times the Bible will just glance a topic but not really explain a topic because that was left up to the individual pastors in the congregations to explain in detail such things, and those details was not written down as far as what we still have today.

And so it takes all these thousands of years and even our entire lifetime to try to figure out these things with our own personal relationship with God and what God is speaking today to explain things.

So with the interpretation of tongues, one thing that the Bible does not explain, but what we have learned in this ministry is that can actually come out in the form of Bible translation.

It can come out in that form rather than, because it is, when we talk about speaking in tongues, we're talking about real languages.

Hebrew, Greek, Aramaic, even Spanish, Chinese, Russian, whatever the language may be, we're talking about real

languages.

We're not talking about just gibberish. We're talking about real languages that are then being interpreted by somebody else in the congregation that doesn't know those languages, that don't know those languages, and they interpret it by divine knowledge that's just coming through the brain and out of their mouth.

And that can also be accomplished with the translation of scripture. It doesn't necessarily take someone that is extremely well trained with PhD and years upon years of studying those languages.

It can come out as God divinely showing the translator what this means in his heart, in his soul, in his mind to give that person understanding.

So there's many different ways that gifts of the Spirit and different diverse types of miracles can be manifested that the Bible doesn't go into detail. Amen.

Anything else? "I can think of a few miracles I've seen over the past years. I can talk about some of the miracles that you have seen and witnessed over the years.

So I've got a large list somewhere. My memory is terrible. I remember a few very prominently. I think of the sermon confirmations, how frequent those were, and are.

One of them I remember is you had made a statement, a kind of statement that you rarely make, like once or twice a year, about how it's not always the biggest, toughest guy who wins a fight, the guy who fights the hardest.

And then after the sermon, hours later, we go walk around the hospital as we were doing at that time, and on the ground there are two spiders.

We see two spiders on the ground in front of us. They walk and stop in front of each other like a confrontation.

There's a big one and a tiny one. They stare for a few seconds and then suddenly the big one runs away scared."

Cool. Awesome.

"Things like that."

I don't know what it was. I remember one time, one time ago, I had such a sermon about insects, and then they go on that trail, and there's the locust shells on the tree.

I can't remember exactly that. That was definitely a divine confirmation. It's been so mean. Yeah.

"Speaking of bugs, wasn't there that one time you had recommended a particular movie to Kiki, and what did she report that same day?"

Oh, and all the times that we watched movies later on the Sabbath day, and it confirmed the sermon so powerfully and divine and powerful, but you couldn't deny that that was God.

That in the movie they would say the exact words that I had said in that sermon that same day.

Several times, many times we saw that. And a lot of times we didn't even have that movie planned ahead of time.

And movies we had never saw before that did that. So that's not in the Bible, right?

No. That you would watch a movie and it would say the exact words that you just said in the sermon.

That's not in the Bible, but that's a divine manifestation of God. I think it's so many other times.

Yeah. But we don't have to list a whole bunch, but they get the point. Yeah. Amen.

Thank you. Okay. I don't see anything WhatsApp and Telegram and text messaging. If I have missed anybody, please forgive me.

Now, on the announcement on the AOB, the Alpha and Omega Bible, it didn't work out.

We're not going to be able to have the Walmart link nor the Barnes and Noble. So there's only going to be only two ways that you're going to be able to get the Alpha and Omega Bible.

And that's on Amazon.com and directly from the ministry. Those are the two ways you'll be able to obtain the Alpha and Omega Bible.

God is our witness that our goal in publishing and providing the Alpha and Omega Bible is not money and profit.

That is not our goal and our heart in the release of the Alpha and Omega Bible. God is our witness and what I have said on that is recorded in heaven. Amen.

I take these things very seriously. We're not trying to get rich. I'm not trying to buy a brand new car and things like this. Our purpose in releasing the Alpha and Omega Bible is, way back in 2015, in the first part of that year, I found myself in every sermon saying, Well, in this particular verse, as I was still reading from the King James Version, or maybe it actually was the New American Standard at the time, but even back in the King James days when we were using that, I would have to say, in our preaching, this verse is better translated, this particular verse is better in the NIV, whereas the

other verse is better translated in the King James, and the other verse is better translated in the NIV in the same chapter, in the exact same chapter, and each verse is different.

Or even in the same verse, one word of that verse is better in the NIV, but another word is better in the King James in the same verse.

And it's like, how can I preach this way? We need one Bible that has all the words and all the verses correct, or at least much more than what we were experiencing in any of the other translations.

And that was why we released the Alpha and Omega Bible. And not that it's perfect, but it continues to be perfected, it continues to be improved consistently, just about every week that we'll find something that a particular word or a particular verse needs edited and improved.

And a lot of people find that strange, and they say, if it's the most accurate, why are you continuing to edit it all of the time?

What those people don't realize is the same thing was done with the King James, and the New American Standard, and the NIV, and other translations throughout history.

The King James was changed and changed and edited over and over and over. And most people, they don't have a 1611 King James Bible.

Most people that believe in only the King James have never even seen an original copy of what it looked like, and how it read, and what the words were in the original 1611 King James.

For example, the original 1611 King James had 12 more books than what you see in most versions of the King James version today.

Most people own a copy of the 1873, or something like that, if I'm not mistaken, or 1893 or 1873 translation version, revised version, of the King James.

And other translations have been done the same way, because as we continue to find more manuscripts, as well as more and more people learn these agent languages that were lost in time, and as time evolves and changes, people are learning these languages more and more, and we're finding more and more archaeological discoveries, and we're finding more and more scrolls and manuscripts that were lost in time, and therefore we have to update our translations to match the growth and understanding of the agent languages and of the agent scriptures.

So this is not unusual at all. This is actually the standard practice for biblical translations, is to continue to edit and perfect it, getting closer and closer and closer to the accuracy of the original scriptures.

But the Alpha and Omega Bible has been updated again to get greater accuracy, and is now available on Amazon.com.

The links have now been put up on the Alpha and Omega website, and it is cheaper than what it was.

And if you don't want to use Amazon, I understand, and you can request it directly from the ministry.

You can find all of that information on the most accurate Bible website, or the Alpha and Omega Bible website.
