

Full Sermon Transcript: The Power of a Truly Saved Christian

June 7, 2024

Now today the sermon is about the power of a truly saved Christian. The ability that we have, the strength that we have from God that we are not a powerless people.

Now I preached this not long ago. It doesn't seem like that long ago. I don't know how many months. Maybe it was a year ago.

I don't know. But before we can even start talking about the power of a truly saved Christian, unfortunately we have to actually define what a truly saved Christian is.

Unfortunately we do have to define that because we were all born into a very corrupt world.

Everything corrupted and more so the younger that you are, the younger you are, the more so that you was born into a corrupt world.

Because even though the world has been corrupted ever since the fall of Adam and Eve and even Satan before that, the world has grown in the amount of corruption every millennium, every thousand years, every hundred years and especially in this past 60 years and so forth and 100 years and 150 years and last 200 years.

The amount of corruption but even more so in the last 30 years. It intensifies now much more than before.

Before it was like intensification of each hundred years and then like every 50 years and so forth.

But then it was like intensification every 20 or so years or something like that.

And 10 years. And the phases got shorter and shorter and shorter and shorter. And now the intensification, the multiplication of the corruption of the earth has greatly intensified every year continually ever since the election of Obama which was not an election of Obama but rather the election fraud of Obama which was absolutely proven.

That was a major fraud right there. So it's very disappointing when everybody wants to focus on the Biden fraud as if that was the first election stolen when it was proven that the Obama so-called election was very much stolen.

And so that was a major intensification right there ever since, ever since Obama.

And it continues to multiply even more at a faster and more severe speed and stronger modification now, yearly and monthly.

So this shows you also we're getting closer and closer to the great tribulation with all these phases.

Phases haven't grown much shorter and the intensification much stronger. So since we're born into such a corrupt world everything is a lie and everybody is brainwashed and everybody is deceived and that's not my opinion.

Revelation 12 verse 9 tells us that Satan has deceived the entire world but it says that in the context of the end time.

It says that in the context of the end time that we're now in this end time generation of great deception.

We know that the strong delusion is very near.

So what is a truly saved Christian?

Most people would say you've given your heart to the Lord. What does that mean? You've given your heart to the Lord. They think it only means that you feel a love for God.

That you feel a love for God in the same way you might feel love for a person. That you said those words, that you said a prayer of salvation.

That you've confessed with your mouth that Jesus is Lord, that he is your Lord, that he is your Savior.

And then that's all. That's all it really means. It doesn't go much deeper than that for the average, I know there are exceptions, that when we speak of the world in general and the average traditional Christian that is as far and as deep as it goes.

But here in the book of John chapter 6, if you go down to the end of the chapter, go down to verse 53, John 6 verse 53, it says, So Jesus said to them, truthfully I tell you the absolute truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of mankind and drink his blood, you have no life in yourself unless you do this.

Unless you drink his blood and eat his flesh, you have no life in yourself. Now of course, you might be alive and never have done that.

So he's not talking about just living on earth as an average Christian, but rather he's talking about eternal life.

He's talking about what it means to be saved, what is true salvation. And that is taking Christ himself inside you. But to do that in more than just confessing with your mouth, more than just believing, more than just having a feeling of love, more than having knowledge of God, more than accepting him verbally and mentally. But actually receiving his blood and body inside of you through the Passover communion is what it's talking about. Most people don't know that's what it's talking about. But how do you take his body and blood inside you? He doesn't want you to be a cannibal. He doesn't want you to find his bones and his flesh or the lost vial of his blood or something like that.

He doesn't want you to be a cannibal and he doesn't want you to believe in a fairy tale that a wafer, a cookie, a communion bread is literally, literally his body and that the wine is literally his blood like the Catholic Church teaches and believes as if they're little tiny baby children to believe in such ridiculous fairy tale that that's literally his body, literally his blood.

Of course he's not talking about any of these things. The only thing that remains is the Passover communion and if we look at the Bible what it says, Jesus said when he handed the cup of wine to them, when he handed the bread to them, he said this is my blood.

But it was not literally. Amen. This is my body. Amen. Eat, take, receive, do this. Amen. So it's very clearly Passover communion and it's very clearly telling you how to get saved.

It's not just only a prayer even though of course you've got to pray and confess with your mouth and verbally accept him as Lord and Savior.

You've got to do all of this of course. But all of that without doing the Passover communion is pointless, is in vain.

And not only that, but we also know Acts chapter 2 verse 38 but a lot of people don't know it so let's turn and look at Acts 2 verse 38 because a lot of churches have not taught this very basic verse.

It might be basic but it's very fundamental and major and vital and important.

In Acts 2 verse 38 it was on the day of Pentecost which is coming up now very, very, very quickly on June 16th of 2024 will be Pentecost.

So I'm trying to look at the calendar, make it out from here. It looks like nine days to Pentecost.

So here in Acts 2 Peter was preaching and in verse 37, verse 37, when they heard this, when they heard that sermon of Peter they were peers to the heart.

That means they were convicted of their sins. It wasn't just a feel good, tickle my ear message like you have in a lot of churches today.

But it was a convicting message. It was a message that made them convicted of their sins. Amen.

And when they heard this they were peers to the heart and said to Peter and to the rest of the apostles, they said, Brother, what shall we do?

They asked how to be saved, basically. What must we do to be saved? In verse 38 Peter said to them, repent that each of you be baptized in the name, in the authority of Jesus the Christ for forgiveness of your sins and you will receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

He didn't say all you have to do is believe. And he didn't make it very generic, give your heart to the Lord, believe, or even commit.

Even though we find verses like that about commit and believe, he was very specific here in what you must do is multiple steps.

You've got to repent. That means change your life. That means stop doing what you're already doing, which means stop going to the false churches, the false religions, false pastors, false ministers, false radio, TV shows, YouTube channels, websites, and books.

Stop doing all those things. Stop believing the fables and the lies. Stop believing and following false religion and be baptized, meaning full immersion in water, in the name and authority of Christ Jesus, which means not only verbally using the name Jesus, and it says nothing about Abba here, and I'm sick and tired of all these people, there's Abba this and Abba that.

Christ said it one time and you want to bring it up every five seconds. But not only using the name Jesus, but the authority of Jesus.

And you can't separate his name from his authority. So when you get baptized by somebody that is in the Babylonian church, which is the synagogue of Satan, the Sunday churches, they are the synagogue of Satan.

The Christmas and Easter and Trinity churches, they are the synagogue of Satan. The Yahshua, Yahweh, and Jehovah churches, those are the synagogues of Satan.

They cannot baptize you. The only thing they can do is take you down in the water and get you wet. It's not salvation there. So in their baptism, yeah, it really doesn't save you, like they say. But a true baptism with the true name, with the true authority, a person that has truly saved, baptizing you, then yes, you can be saved in baptism. And this is Peter's instruction of how to get saved. Repent and be baptized in the name authority of Jesus for the forgiveness of your sins.

Whereas the churches teach that it's not for the forgiveness of your sins. And it's not required for the forgiveness of your sins. All you've got to do is pray one time for the forgiveness of your sins. So see, we do have to define true salvation, how to truly get saved, who is truly saved, and who is not. Because people have been going their entire lifetime thinking that they are saved, when they're not. You can't get saved by being baptized by someone who doesn't have the authority to baptize you. Because they themselves, those pastors, those ministers, those preachers that baptized you, they're not saved themselves. They're worshipping Satan themselves. They're worshipping Satan every Sunday morning, every Christmas morning, every Easter morning. How can they save you? They need to get saved themselves. So you wasn't baptized in the authority of God, in the authority of Jesus. And when you were baptized, if you ever were, was it for the forgiveness of sins? If it wasn't for that reason, then there's another reason that your baptism is in vain and void. Amen. You either believe this Bible verse or you don't believe this Bible verse. Amen.

And look at, go over to 1 John chapter 2, right before the book of Revelation. "By this we know that we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments. The one who says, 'I have come to know Him,' but does not keep His commandments, is a liar and the truth is not in him." That is very powerful words, very powerful speech right there. Those are not my words. Those are the words of John, who was the best disciple of Jesus and the best friend of Jesus. Amen. That's his words and yet he spoke very firmly, very boldly, that even if you do not keep God's commandments and say that you know God, then you're a liar. Very strong words, not mine. It's right there in the Bible. You read it yourself. But that's your average everyday Christian. Average everyday Christian. They say, oh I know God, I believe in God, I serve God, I'm going to heaven, I'm saved, I'm saved. I was saved as a child, so on, so on, so on. I was saved 50 years ago. I hear it all the time. All the time, all the time, all the time. Everybody, they want to stay in that delusion that they don't need to get saved because they're already saved, even though they don't keep Passover. They only started keeping the Sabbath recently. There's never baptized in Jesus' name by a man that believes in Jesus' name alone, that keeps the Sabbath, that keeps the Passover himself, that keeps all of the biblical holy day, that keeps all the commandments of God. The commandments of God includes the Ten Commandments, including the Second Commandment to not have images of anything that is for the purpose of worship or that is being worshipped or idolized, which is everything in this world. It is pictures of Jesus. It is the cross. It is people with all these figurines of wolves and dolphins and unicorns and trolls. It is flags and pictures of marijuana on posters on people's walls. It is idolization of movie stars and musicians and sports figures. It is having a famous quarterback picture, poster on your wall. It is many different things, many different forms. Revelation 12 verse 9, Satan has deceived the entire world. So, people are so brainwashed, so deceived that they don't know that they are idolizing something, that they are worshipping an image. They don't know that they are. So, for an average person, it would be better for them to obey that to the letter of the law to have no images at all.

For a person that is lost, for a person that is not truly saved, it would be better to keep that Second Commandment with

the letter of the law, whereas a truly saved person could keep it in the spirit of the law and have certain images acceptable.

But the majority of people on this earth would be much better to obey God to the letter of the letter because they have no discernment at all and they are worshipping literally everything.

They are worshipping the sun with the pictures of the sun. In every meme of the Christian memes on Facebook, the sun is in every Christian meme constantly.

There. Bam, bam, bam, bam, bam, bam. It's sun worship. It's nothing less than that.

It's sun worship. And they are worshipping the dove as if the Father came down or the Holy Spirit came down as a bird.

That's ridiculous. He did not come down in the shape of a bird. He did not. That is Assyrian pagan mythology.

I don't worship. It would be good to keep the Second Commandment to the letter because people have no common sense and people have no intelligence.

They don't think before they speak. They don't think before they draw. They don't speak before they write. They don't speak before they do.

They don't think period. And every Bible verse that they know from childhood is a twisting of scripture. Literally. Every verse they know from childhood is being twisted.

So, a truly saved Christian is a person that has been truly baptized, which is almost no one on earth, because it's extremely difficult and almost impossible to find another truly saved person to baptize you.

Hey, I know that I'm not the only truly saved preacher on earth. I know that there is somebody else out there somewhere in the jungles.

Somewhere. I know that somewhere is out there somewhere so there's another true pastor.

I just can't find him. I just don't know where he is. I have salt for him. For my entire life I have salt for him.

And so has many other members of the church. Salt and salt and salt and salt trying to find another congregation, another pastor, another website that actually has the truth and we can't find them.

I'm not saying that we know they're out there somewhere. I'm not saying that I'm the only true preacher on earth.

But, if you can find another true preacher on earth, please introduce me. Amen. They're out there. It's just almost impossible to find.

So, how is it then that everybody you run into says, oh yeah, I'm saved. They're brainwashed.

They're lost, they're blind, and they're deceived. Just like the Bible says. A truly saved person has been baptized in truth, which no one has, hardly, upon the earth, keeps the past over, keeps all the biblical holy days, feasts the tabernacles, Pentecost, so forth.

They pay their tithes and a lot more. There is a lot to it. You can do all of that and still not be saved. Amen.

There's a lot more to it than that. What about actually following God's will for your life?

What about that? That's a novel ideal. That's something else. People who have been baptized keep the Sabbath, keep the holy days, pay their tithes, but they still don't follow God's will for their life.

Their life hasn't changed very much and won't change very much. They won't allow God to change who they are, the way they dress, how they comb their hair, or anything else about them.

Nothing's going to change. They're still going to look like a little child and act like a little child.

Nothing's going to change. Ever. If anything gets done, I have to say, hello such and such and such a person. Will you do this or how come you haven't done this yet?

When are you going to do this? How come you've not done this? Because every little thing has to be commanded.

Every little thing has to be commanded.

Now I know that there are some people that do some things for the church, and I know everybody has different abilities, but by far, in general, what I am seeing is nothing but laziness and complacency and childishness.

People don't realize how serious this is. How are we going to bear fruits if we are not working?

And if we are working only inside the church, hello, how is that going to be fruitful?

If we are working only inside the church, but not working out among the lost, if we are not working on Facebook, if we are not working on Twitter, if we are not working out there in the world, but only inside Parrhesia and that's it, how are we going to bear any fruit?

Are you just going to preach only to the choir? The choir is the only audience that you are going to do a work for and preach for? Amen?

I can barely get people to even log in to Parrhesia, to even click like. Oh, I do it three weeks from now, and three weeks from now I would come on there and I would click a hundred likes.

That's actually what people are doing. I tell you what, just keep your three week threshold to yourself and go ahead and delete your membership.

I don't need somebody that's going to show up once every three weeks. Get the hell out.

I really don't care who gets offended. I'm just sick and tired of complacency. We're supposed to be the army of the Lord. We're supposed to be the people that are doing a work, but everything else comes first.

The work of making money comes first. The work of doing that comes first. The work of this and that and that and everything else comes first, but God. This ministry comes dead last.

It's ridiculous that whatever I post in Parrhesia, then I have to copy and put on Telegram and on WhatsApp and on Facebook to make for sure that everybody sees it, who are supposed to be all in one place.

Guess what? On Pentecost, they were all in one place. If Pentecost was to happen a week from now, two weeks from now, in modern times, if Pentecost were to happen today and Peter was to stand here, he would preach to one person, maybe two, maybe three, that's it.

But he would have to drag and find and scratch and dig holes and bust down walls to find the rest of you, to find where you're at, to find, okay, and now I've got to copy it and post it over there.

Now I've got to post it over here. Now I've got to open up the other app and post it over here because you can't get the church all together in one place.

Can't do it. It's impossible. Can't get the church to gather together in one place. Parrhesia is a joke.

This church is a joke. I have a phone, but I should have it disconnected because who's going to call me? No, I'll just use the internet.

I'm sick and tired of the internet. When the internet is gone, the people that remain, they won't even know how to even look at you in the face, eye to eye, to speak to you because where's the keyboard?

Where's the button to push? People don't even know how to dial a phone number on the phone anymore, pick up the phone to call and talk as a real person.

Everybody's so busy with their lives. Busy, busy, busy, busy, busy, busy, busy, too busy really to propitiate in the structure of the church what the church has established to be used.

Not only the Parrhesia structure of social media to be used, but also to pick up a phone to be a human being.

Now, enough with all that. I don't care who gets offended. I'm just saying it the way it is because people need to just hear it the way it is.

God searched the entire earth to find only one righteous man, Noah, and it hasn't changed.

It is the same today. It is the exact same today. So how is it that everybody you think you're saved, everybody, all of you think you're saved?

Bullcrap. You sure don't act like it. Now let's get into the actual sermon. I have to move through it quickly.

Since I had to waste all that time trying to teach the church how to be a church.

Let's go to 2 Corinthians. 2 Corinthians 6. Now we're going to talk about the power that a truly saved person would really have if there was such a thing as a truly saved person on this earth, which there's not.

But if there were, let's just pretend. Let's just pretend that there was a truly saved person on this earth.

What kind of power would they have? In 2 Corinthians 6 verse 14. 2 Corinthians 6 verse 14. For we are the temple of the living Theos.

Just as Theos said, I will dwell in them and walk among them. We sang that song. Walk among me Jesus. Walk with me Jesus.

Walk around me Jesus. I will dwell in them and walk among them and I will be their Theos and they will be my people. Therefore come out from their midst, from the midst of the false religion, from the midst of the hypocrites, from the midst of the wicked people and be separate.

A separate people says the Lord and do not touch what is unclean and I will be a father to you and you shall be my sons and daughters to me says the Lord Almighty. Amen.

There's power in this because God himself is supposed to be inside us. If God himself is inside us, that is the power of a nuclear weapon. That is great power.

That is the power that raises the dead. That is the power that casts out demons. That is the power that heals. That is the power that does miracles.

That is the power that defeats sin. That is the power that defeats complacency and laziness.

That is the power that defeats depression. That is the power that defeats brainwashing, lies and fables and disruption.

Amen.

It is great power. It is the power that defeats hormonal imbalances as far as controlling yourself to obey your husband or not obey your husband.

If you was in that situation, which is a big if, but if you was in a situation where you was a woman married to a truly saved man and that man is leading you in God's truth and you got pregnant and you had all these hormonal imbalances and urges and all these things, that with God inside you, if you were truly saved yourself as a woman of the Lord and a sister in the true church, that if you had God's power, God living inside you, no matter how much those hormones were raging, no matter what is happening inside the body, the physical body, God Himself also being inside that physical body would give you the power, the ability to not hit your husband, to not cuss your husband, to not threaten to take a knife against your husband, to not destroy your husband's property, to not disrespect and disobey your husband, to not treat him like a dog. Amen.

You would not be using your pregnancy as an excuse to act like a demon because God inside you is powerful enough to keep you under control.

Especially when just the day before you just heard the sermon about the biblical requirement for women to be submissive to their husbands, but it just goes in one ear and out the other.

That's not a truly saved woman. Absolutely not. A woman is to respect her husband. And if she cannot respect her husband because he is a heathen and he is a wicked person, then maybe you've got to do something about that as well. But as long as a man and woman lives together, the woman is to keep her mouth shut.

Respect him, obey him, and if he's not a man deserving of respect and obedience, then get out. Amen.

It's just as simple as that. It's just as simple as that. Respect and obey, and if he doesn't deserve it, then get out.

You don't need to be living with him. Amen. We also have the power in this verse here to separate ourselves from the unfaithful, from the unbeliever, from the wicked, from those that are not of us, from those that are not Christ's.

It says separating ourselves. We have the power of God living inside us, light versus darkness.

Light and darkness cannot dwell together. As long as if the light of God really, really, really does dwell inside you, the darkness will flee.

Either that dark person, that person of wickedness will leave or you will leave. You cannot live in the same house very long.

They will be making plans or you will be making plans or both will be making plans to separate, to get out.

I'm making those plans right now. Amen. Whatever situation you may be in, roommates, marriage, relationships, whatever situation you find yourself in, in life, if you are truly saved, God will give you the strength, God will give you the power, God will give you the wisdom, the ability to separate yourself from the unclean.

Of course, what people really want to do is make excuses and be fearful, not trusting the Lord and not following the will of the Lord for their life. Amen.

But if we want to follow the will of God and we are truly saved or willing to get truly saved, then He will give us the power, the strength, the authority, the help, everything that we need to get it accomplished, He would give it to us to accomplish what we need to do to separate ourselves from the unclean.

So you take that first step, then you take the next step, then you take the next step until it is accomplished. Amen.

We are the temple of God according to this verse as well. We are the temple of God. God dwells inside of us.

So we also have power over this temple. You are the temple of the living fields in verse 16.

Do you not have power, some sort of power, some measurement of power over a house that you rent or a house that you own or a bedroom that you dwell in even if you are not the renter or the owner?

Do you have some power, some authority in where you dwell, where you live, where you sleep, where you put your shoes, where you put your underwear?

Do you have some power, some authority?

We are the temple of the Lord and we have power over this temple, this body.

So we don't have to be running to the doctor at every little sniffle. Amen. We don't need to be taking a Tylenol every time that we have a fever. We are supposed to get a fever.

That is the body doing what it is supposed to do. And I have said this repeatedly online so I don't know how many times I have to regurgitate this just like everything else I have to regurgitate.

But you should never, ever, ever, ever try to reduce a fever. A fever is your body doing what it is supposed to do to fight the infection.

Let it do its job. Amen. But we have power to heal ourselves through herbal remedies and by faith in Christ that He will help us, that He will bless and anoint the herbal remedies that we use, that He will bless and anoint our patients and our long suffering while we continue to pray and seek Him for our healing.

He heals us and we heal ourselves and it is a joint effort. We have power over these bodies so we don't have to run to the hospital constantly every time we have a serious illness.

Repeatedly I have had serious illnesses. Repeatedly I am going through one right now and I am not going to go to the doctor.

And it really upsets me when people who claim to be saved tell me that I should go to the doctor.

I know when it is time to go. I am not a five year old little boy. I am a grown man and I have been through major health crises multiple times and got through it every time no matter how serious that crisis was.

I still got through it without going to the doctor and without going to the hospital.

And I would get through it this time. And I am not five years old. I know how to use the internet. I know how to do the research for myself.

I know how to read and open up the books for myself and look up the symptoms and look up the remedies and there is not a remedy that you can share with me that I can't find for myself because I am a grown man.

And I am not complacent like other people that claim to be grown men. I am not complacent.

I know how to find the information and how to use the information and how to cut the information into use. Amen.

And I have said it a million times and I am going to have to regurgitate it another million times.

What are we going to do when the great tribulation comes and we can't go to the hospital anymore?

What are you going to do then? Finally, you are going to have to learn how to long suffer with God, with the natural remedies, with patience and faith and belief that God will see you through it.

And for once and finally, you will finally start to wake up and come to realize the need to be able to do that. Amen.

And especially if you ain't got the money to go to the doctors and hospitals.

Especially if you ain't got the money to go. If I don't go to myself and I don't pay doctors and I don't pay hospitals but I have to pay your doctor and I have to pay your hospital and I am not the one to get the woman knocked up but then I have to pay for your baby.

Well, if I have to pay for your baby, maybe I need to find somebody to knock up myself so I can pay for my own baby. Amen.

Let's go to 1 Corinthians 10. 1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 21. 1 Corinthians 10 verse 21.

You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons. You cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons.

Notice here it doesn't say you shouldn't but rather you can't. You can't do both at the same time. You can't. It's either one or the other. Amen.

A lot of people think they can do both. They can be both a Christian and a Buddhist.

That's impossible. It's totally impossible. People think they can be a Sunday Christian and a Sabbath Christian at the same time.

No, you can't. It's impossible. You're deceiving yourselves. So make up your mind about what the truth is.

People think they can do Jesus and Yahshua both. No, you can't. You can't. It's impossible.

Make up your mind what is the truth and whether you're right or whether you're wrong, no matter which way it might be, make up your mind and stick with it and go with that.

If you're not going to believe in this ministry, you're not going to believe in me and my teachings and my sermons and my writings, fine.

Leave. Find you somebody else to follow. That's your choice. But you cannot follow both the messenger of the Lord and the messenger of Satan at the same time.

So choose which one you're going to follow and make up your mind and stick with it.

Riding the fence ain't going to help you. And riding the fence ain't going to get you to heaven.

Riding the fence ain't going to get you into paradise, into the kingdom of God, into God's favor or any such thing.

Riding the fence will only lead in your self-destruction. So we have power then to make up our minds, if we would.

And we have power to make a decision. And it shouldn't be my commandment to get you to do it. Amen.

We have power to live for Christ. We have the ability to live for Christ, to go to the table of the Lord, to receive His messages, His spiritual food, His spiritual enlightenment, His spiritual growth within us and to push away everything that is not His.

To set aside the world, to be separate from the world and to be okay with that, that we are different from the world. We have power to be at peace of mind, to be content, to be happy, to be joyous, that we are separate and distinct from the world. Amen. That we don't have to be the megachurch. Amen.

We're not going to have as many brothers, as many sisters, as many activities and so forth as the church has in the world, the synagogue of Satan, because they've got eight billion people.

They've got eight billion members. We have five, ten members. But being such a small church as Jesus said that it would be, as the Bible says that it would be, we have to make it count.

Because five, ten, fourteen people out of eight billion people trying to get the truth out there, we're going to have to kick ass.

We're going to have to kick doors down. We're going to have to raise our voice. We're going to have to shout. We're going to have to do things.

We're going to have to sacrifice. We're going to have to commit to energy and strength and passion and zeal for the work.

Because there's not somebody else that's going to pick up the plate and do it for us.

And if you think I can do it all by myself, you're wrong. I've got to have help. I've got to have ten times more help, fourteen times more help than what I've been getting.

We're running out of time. You don't want to be able to, when the first day of the Great Tribulation starts, you don't want to look back and think, I could have done more.

I should have done more. I should have done this. I should have done that. Because by then it would be too late.

How much time we got left? Not a lot of time. What is your priority going to be in this next six months, seven months, eight months?

What is your priority going to be? How much time are you going to spend working for the Lord?

How much time are you going to spend on something else or something else and something else and something else?

I know that there are other things that all of us must do. Everybody has multiple things going on in their lives.

I know and understand that. But how much time will you invest for God? How much time will you invest for the church, for the ministry, for the gospel? For most of you, let me say very realistically, literally, maybe two hours a week max, one hour maybe, some of you fifteen minutes, some of you five minutes per week of doing something for God other than, of course, praying, which is between you and God, but that's not doing a work for God.

Other than reading the Bible, which is between you and God, but that's not doing a work for God.

So I'm talking about a work for God. How much time have you and will you invest in that to actually work for God?

That's taking everything I write on social media, copy and paste it on Facebook or Twitter or Pinterest or something else or Truth Media or something else or printing it out and getting out there and staying out there distributing tracts for like an entire hour.

Getting in your car and putting the tracts, the flyers in every newspaper tube within ten miles of your house.

Other things, you can come up with ideals of ways to work for God. If you need help with ideas of how to work for God, then counsel with the church, counsel with the brothers and sisters in Christ.

Speak to one another. Well, that would be a real miracle if any one of you would speak to the other person.

How many times have I asked people to talk with me? Amen. And I've stopped because it's the same people as no one knew and they haven't talked to me in over a year.

Exactly. Amen. Brother Robert and I both, we have a right to be angry. I have things to share too if anyone actually wants to hear them.

That's right. Amen. We are sick and tired of the complacency, complacency, complacency, complacency. We're just playing church.

That's what every one of you are doing, just playing church. You ain't no better than the average fake Christian.

Okay. So I'm going to keep going here. Let's go to John chapter 10. John 10 verse 4.

John 10 verse 4. When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them and the sheep follow him because they know his voice.

A stranger they simply will not follow that will flee from him because they do not listen to and obey the voice of strangers. Amen.

So a truly saved person would have the power to distinguish the difference between a true preacher and a false preacher.

And yet people that claim that they are saved are still listening to Kenneth Copeland and old audio recordings of Billy Graham and all kinds of false preachers all across the world still listening to the Yeshua creatures and so forth. This is endless. And the false prophets on YouTube that's always predicting Planet X to hit the earth in one month from now.

And that's every month and every year and every decade that they continue to say that.

But people don't know the voice of God and they can't tell the difference between their own voice and the voice of God. People are constantly emailing me and telling me that God said such and such and such when I know God never said such and such because God's not stupid and God's not crazy.

But a truly saved person knows the true voice of God and the difference between that voice and their own voice and their imagination voice and the devil's voice and the false preacher's voice and the false prophet's voice.

We're able to discern a voice of light from a voice of darkness. Amen. That is a power that the average Christian, so-called Christian, traditional Christian absolutely does not have.

And let's go over to 1 John 3, over there near the book of Revelation, right before Revelation

We're going to read 9 verses here. 1 John 3 verse 1. See what kind of love the Father has bestowed on us that we would be called children of God and such we are.

For this reason the world does not know us because it did not know Him. Amen. Beloved, now we are children of Theos and it has not appeared as yet what we will be.

In other words, exactly what size, dimension and so forth that we will be in paradise.

We know that when He appears we will be like Him and not really when He appears but that's what John says.

Because we will see Him just as He is and everyone who has this hope fixed on Him purifies himself just as He is pure.

Everyone who commits sin also commits transgression of the law because sin is transgression of the law.

Verse 5. You know that He appeared in order to take away sins and in Him there is no sin.

No one who abides in Him sins, talked about continually, habitual, no one who sins as a lifestyle has sinned Him or knows Him.

So that right there blows out of the water the theory of homosexual Christians who are still active and unrepentant in their homosexual death style.

That blows that out of the water right there. Amen. And verse 7. Little children, make sure no one deceives you.

The one who practices righteousness as a lifestyle is righteous just as He is righteous.

The one who practices sin is of the devil for the devil has sinned from the beginning.

The son of Theos appeared for this purpose to destroy the works of the devil. No one who is born of Theos practices sin because his seed, the Holy Ghost abides in Him, in that person.

He can't sin because he is born of Theos. Now, let's clarify here. It's not really sin that it's totally impossible for a truly saved person to sin because we will by human nature.

But it's talking about practicing sin is like a doctor or a football player where it is a constant practice.

It is a habitual lifestyle. So we're talking about your lifestyle that you live. And of course we also have the goal to completely become sinless, to be perfect, to be holy, to be a saint.

We have that as a goal and that is, it is absolutely achievable with a process of time.

Unlearning and growing and maturing and different phases that we got to go through.

Absolutely, we got to go through different phases and God doesn't require us or expect us or even want us to reach this level of perfection, of complete no sin until we get to a certain level because we always start as a baby and go upward and upward and upward and upward.

You don't shoot from zero to a hundred in one year as a process. But the overall point here is that we do have power and ability to defeat sin and we should, even before we get baptized, start removing sin, false religion being a sin, false names being a sin, lack of faith being a sin, lack of trust in God being a sin, so forth, many different types of sins.

And continue to remove different sins the first year, the second year, the third year, the third year, the next year, the next and the next and the next for as long as we are alive, continuing to remove the sin of complacency, the sin of laziness, the sin of rebellion, the sin of not doing God's will, the sin of not obeying His voice, the list is endless of the types of sins. Amen.

We are not powerless people. We have the power to defeat sickness, to defeat the devil, to defeat demons. We don't have to live with demons forever.

We can do something about it. Amen. Whatever situation that we have fallen into as humans like animals that will be entrapped, there's a way out.

God always makes a way of His faith. Amen. We may have slipped, we may have made a mistake along the way, somehow, someday, but God would give us a way out.

If we look to Him for the way out and use common sense and use wisdom, He would give us a way out. Amen.

We are not powerless people. We have a way out. We have a way to defeat the enemy.

We have a way to defeat wickedness, but we do need to do it in the right way according to God's will.

We have the power to endure the hardest trials without falling away. We know that a truly safe person can fall away, but we shouldn't fall away. Amen.

And we should do everything possible to make sure that we don't fall away. We have the power to endure, to persevere. The power of God living in us protects us if we're listening to Him, if we're paying attention to Him, if we care about His will.

We have the power to endure, to press through, to look to Him for the answer, to obey Him, to serve Him, and to not fall away.

We have the power to push away demons. We have the power to push away evil and evil things that are trying to destroy us.

We have the power to take action. We have the power to change our lives, to continue to grow.

We have this power. We have a lot of power. We should not be playing the victim card. Amen.

A lot of people just want to play the victim card and continue to play that card every month and every year and the next year and the next year and the next year, and they want to stay a victim. That's what they're comfortable with.

But a truly saved person would not play that forever.

They would get sick and tired of that and they would tear up that victim card and say, you know what, I'm better than this.

I'm better than a victim. I am more than a conqueror to Jesus Christ. I will conquer. I will defeat this problem.

I will take this step. I will make this plan and I will take the next step and the next step and the next step and I will not give up.

And I will have victory in Christ Jesus. I will be healed. And I will achieve this and I will accomplish this because God is for me and God is with me and I am for God and I am with God and I am obeying His commandments.

I'm keeping His Sabbath. I'm keeping all of His Sabbaths. I'm keeping them correctly. I'm growing in the truth.

I'm getting rid of false doctrines. I'm praying and worshiping in Jesus' name. I'm going to put God first even more. I'm going to do more work for God.

I'm going to serve God more. I'm going to serve God better. And I am going to defeat the sins in my life. I am going to be a warrior for the Lord.

An appropriate warrior. Not going my own path in my own type of warrior crap. But the true warrior really truly is serving the Lord according to His will and His path that He has laid for me.

And I will not fall away. And I will not stay a victim. And I will not stay sick. And I will not stay depressed.

And I will not stay with the wicked. I am a child of God. Amen. Or I'm going to be a child of God.

I'm going to get baptized. And I'm going to be a child of God. Amen. Praise God. Amen. We are not powerless people. That we are mighty through Christ Jesus. If we are truly saved. Amen.

That is the end of the sermon. The chat room is open. Go ahead and start typing away.

Also I would check on WhatsApp, Telegram, text messaging. The only thing I don't check is Parrhesia during the sermon.

As I've said many times before. I do not check Parrhesia during the sermons. So I have Telegram. I have WhatsApp. I have Mixlr. I have text messaging. I got all these different ways that people can contact me.

So, Decipher in Korea, he says, "Does Ecclesia 7:28 mean anything other than simply that it is difficult to find a righteous person among women?"

So I'm going to look at that Ecclesiastes 7:28. Page 379.

My soul sought after, but I felt not, for I have found one man of a thousand, but a righteous woman in these I have not found.

So that is exactly what it means. Brother Decipher is if God searches and finds only one righteous man, he doesn't find a righteous woman.

So in other words, there's going to be less righteous women on the earth than what there are righteous men.

It doesn't mean that there's not going to be any, any at all on the entire earth out of eight billion people. But what it means is whatever number you want to choose, however many thousands. And you did find a certain number of righteous men and it's going to be a very small number. The number of righteous women will be smaller. Absolutely, absolutely, absolutely. Because of that nature of Eve, how that she led her husband in deception and she led him in sin. That nature has passed down. We are our parents. I am my dad. We are our parents. And so we're all, all women, they are the daughters of Eve and they all share that element of leading men when they're not supposed to. And that's what we're seeing in this world is that women want to be men. They want to be dominant. They want to be in control. They want to be the boss, wear the pants in the family, disrespect their husbands, back talk their husbands and slap and abuse their husbands. And the fact is, even though, of course, we know that there are some men that abuse their wives and girlfriends. The reality is that it's a much, much, much higher, larger number of women that are abusing their husbands. Much larger, much larger. I know that for a fact. I've seen it with my own eyes my entire life I've seen it. And the facts, the documents, the statistics also prove that to be a fact and I continue to see it. As I get older and older I continue to see it more and more and more and more. The Bible is full of warning the men about the women. We must be on guard. We have that natural tendency that God gave us to desire a woman, to need a woman. That desire should be there. That is supposed to be part of our DNA. But we must be on guard because women are the number one reason that men fall away from God. It really is. Women would lead the man astray so many times and I've seen that and I've seen it and I've seen it and I've seen it. And of course it goes the other way as well. Men leading women away from God too. But the Bible says what it is and I'm not going to argue with what the Bible says about this when it says it a million times. Amen. The Bible is in agreement and different books of the Bible is in agreement that the men must be on guard against the women.

Calm Adam says, I am so thankful to have found this ministry and having later been baptized. Thank you Calm Adam. Especially now since hearing someone preaching, not needing, somebody was preaching, not needing water baptism and twisting the verses. That's a constant thing. That is a very extreme popular. It is extremely common. You're going to see it a million more times Calm Adam. You're going to see that a million more and a million more and a million more. It's extremely, extremely common and it's an everyday thing.

Bountiful Servant says, I thank God for his continued blessing. We got so much needed rain. Well thank God you got rain Bountiful Servant. Praise the Lord.

And Decipher says, I confess that I have been terribly lazy in the things of the Lord but I will be different. Thank you for that. And that comment right there, Decipher, is the best comment all day. I confess I've been terribly lazy in the things of the Lord but I will be different. Amen. Australia for Jesus, she says, I thank God for another day and for the calm weather and the sunny days. Amen.

Alright, Brother Jared, got anything to say? I stand here feeling like a hypocrite for forsaking the work of God, the work for money. Okay, thank you very much. And I also appreciate that very much as well. Coming from Brother Jared, I really do appreciate that. And that's the first step. Realizing what you've done wrong, professing it and then changing it. Amen. We can't change something if we don't realize it and if we don't profess it. And that's a real man that can profess that he has done wrong. Amen. And can do that not only with himself and with God but also to his brothers and sisters. To be able to confess it to his brothers and sisters, to confess to one another as the Bible says.

So I appreciate that Jared and AJ both, Robert and AJ both have confessed their complacency so that they can improve. And it helps to improve when you've made that public confession with the church, to one another, with your brothers and sisters.

It empowers you when you confess that to your brothers and sisters. That empowers you because that holds you more accountable as you say.

So that gives you more strength to change, more motivation to change. Amen. Praise God. In Australia for Jesus, Kiki says, I too confess that I can do more also.

This is what I want to hear. This is what I need to hear. This is what God needs to hear. Amen.

Praise God. And John says, I ask Robert not to give up. I like hearing what he has to say. Amen.

Praise God. Brother Robert is a real contribution to the sermon messages, to give his input, his discussion into the sermon is always very heavily prized.

And I want to add how much the ministry needs help and if I don't do the work, who will? Amen.

We're going to need a lot more work from other people other than just only me and Robert.

We can't do it ourselves. We can't. We simply can't. The ministry is being greatly neglected.

It really is. This ministry has been greatly, greatly, greatly neglected. There's not one day that passes by that I have something huge come into my heart, into my mind that the church needs to do, but I have nobody to do it.

Every day, this is the way it is. And I need an army of the Lord and that's more than just Robert.

I need an army of the Lord to be like, here, I can assign this to this person and I can assign this to the other person because they're willing, because they're reaching out.

What I need you to do is not wait on me to hand you something. What I need you to do is to reach your hand out to receive what I've got to put in your hand because I don't want it to be me all the time reaching out to you.

You need to reach out to me and when you do that, I can have stuff to put on your plate to work on.

Absolutely, I can. There's a lot to do. There's so much that has been neglected year after year and we're running out of time and there's all kinds of things that we could do to reach thousands more people, millions more people.

If I had people that I know would be available and willing to do the work, if I had people willing and able and knew that they were willing and able, but I just feel like nobody wants to do it.

I just feel like there's nobody that I can give a job to that's more significant than just a little tiny meme.

Okay. Now we'll be back for services tomorrow. So as I'm looking at this right, this next weekend is Pentecost. Next weekend is Pentecost, so services two days this week being today and tomorrow and then services two days in a row next weekend.

Brother John from Kansas is going to be here with us that weekend for both days as well, so we look forward to that. It is very nice, once and for all, to have somebody willing to travel hundreds of miles.

I do have to say that for John. I do have to say that for him. That's very unusual, very hard to find. He's willing to do that, so we praise God for that.

We look forward to spending time with him next weekend and having somebody else to talk to and hang out with is very important.

To have fellowship is very important. Brother Robert and I both, we need that so desperately.

We need it so desperately, and my wife needs that so very desperately as well. She needs a sister in the Lord, and that statement is the understatement of all humanity of 6,000 years.

What I just said, my wife needs a sister in the Lord. That is the understatement of eternity. Amen.

Oh, let's see. I've got something on. What's that? Okay, brother Hugh said, I also need to do more for the kingdom. I thank you for your hard preaching. It is always necessary.

Amen. Thank you, Hugh, and thank you for also that confession as well, and thank you for those words.

Okay, let's put on a song. Let's do Stay on the Firing Line. What's the page number on that? There it is.
