

No Third Jewish Temple To Be Built
Full sermon transcript
May 6, 2023

Oh, for grace to trust Him more.
Amen. Praise Jesus.

You know, it's very sad how there are a lot of people in our modern time who detest, even hate, the name of Jesus.

It's very sad. People are being taught that the name of Jesus is demonic.

And people fall for it hook, line, and sinker.

If you share the truth with them, they will not embrace it.

Time after time, person after person, year after year, they hate the truth.

Even many people hating His name.

But we stand here today in the name, the holy name, the mighty name of Jesus almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

And there is a day coming when every knee will bow, every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord. Amen.

That day is coming. All wickedness will be destroyed.

The only ones remaining will be the righteous, obedient, faithful servants of Christ Jesus.

That's the bottom line. Amen. That is the bottom line.

Today, we're going to talk about the theory of a temple being built, a Jewish temple. Many people out there have been taught that we must look for and await the building of a Jewish temple on the Temple Mount.

If you think about that, it's very laughable.

If you really, really, really think about that in the light of modern politics, the nation of Jordan and their control over the Temple Mount, the Islamic nation, the Palestinians, communism conquering the world, America and Canada both conquered by communism, even England, Ireland, Scotland being conquered by communism, nations around the world.

To think that the nation of Israel would be granted the freedom while the entire world is being conquered by Islam and communism in cooperation with each other.

But yet Israel, the nation that all the Islamic nations hate, all the communist nations hate, Jordan hates being given the freedom to build upon the Temple Mount when they don't even have complete freedom to even pray on the Temple Mount.

It's really very laughable.

Just like the letter Y names or people are taught to hate the name of Jesus, people don't spend enough time to think about the doctrines that they are taught.

Just like flat earth, they don't spend enough time dissecting and thinking and using their brain.

Nevertheless, today we will look at the Bible verses that they use to try to claim that a third Jewish temple will be built before or during the great tribulation.

We will look at their verses, the verses they use, and we will objectively examine this issue.

You already know where I stand because we use logic and common sense.

We use our brains.

But nevertheless, we will examine these verses that they use. Amen.

First, let's go in prayer.

(Prayer)

All right, let's turn to the Holy Scriptures.

Ezekiel 40, for people that's listening for the first time, we're reading from the Alpha and Omega Bible, a restoration of the original Scriptures. Amen.

God is good.

Ezekiel 40 is one of the most commonly referred to verses in the Bible when they try to teach that a third Jewish temple will be built in either before or during the Great Tribulation.

And therefore we must be watching for that event.

Chapter 40 all the way through the end of Ezekiel, those nine chapters, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, nine chapters.

All nine of those chapters describe a temple, a temple of God that has His anointing, His presence.

But look at chapter 43, let's turn there right now.

Ezekiel 43 verse 19, we're going to read from there through the end of this chapter here, starting in verse 19.

And you shall appoint to the priests and the Levites of the seed of Zadok that draw near to me, say of the Lord Jesus to minister to me, a calf of the herd, for a sin offering, and they should take of its blood and put it on the four horns of the altar, and upon the four corners of the seat of reconciliation, what they call the mercy seat, and upon the base around the bow, and they shall atone, make atonement for it.

So already we see a Levitical priesthood and animal sacrifices.

Verse 21, and they shall take the calf of a sin offering, a calf, an animal of the sin offering.

So this is an animal sacrifice for the purpose of appeasing God about our sins.

And it shall be consumed by fire in the separate place of the house outside the sanctuary.

Verse 22, and on the second day they shall take two young goats without blemish for a sin offering, and they shall make atonement for the altar, and they shall make atonement with the calf.

And after they have finished their atonement, they shall bring an unblemished calf of the herd, and an unblemished ram of the flock, and they shall offer before them the boy Jesus, and the priest shall spend the salt upon them, and shall offer them up as a hope and offerings to Jesus.

And seven days shall you offer a kid daily, that is a kid goat, for a sin offering, a young goat, and a calf of the herd, a ram out of the flock, and they shall sacrifice them

unblemished for seven days, and they shall make atonement for the altar, and they shall cleanse it, and they shall consecrate themselves.

And it shall come to pass from the eighth day onward that the priest shall offer the hope and offerings to the altar, and the peace offerings, and I will accept you to serve Jesus.

This is very clearly old covenant.

There's no way possible if you're a Christian and you believe in the blood of Jesus, that He did atone for our sins. Why did He die? To atone for our sins.

Automatically, this is not talking about the future.

This is not talking about any time after the crucifixion of Jesus, at any time in all of history after the crucifixion of Jesus.

It cannot be. It's totally impossible.

The only way you can believe that this would be future tense after the crucifixion of Jesus would be to reject that He died for our sins.

That's the only way.

And yet, these churches are using these nine chapters to say that a third Jewish temple...

Well, they say, but the Jews do reject Jesus.

They say, but the Jews do reject Jesus.

Well, yes. But think about this. This is God's instructions. Do this. And if you obey God's instructions, then you're not rejecting Jesus. But the Jews do reject Jesus.

Right?

So it still doesn't make sense even for the Jews to do it because they don't accept Jesus today. They did back... Well, not even...

In the time of Ezekiel and so forth, you had some that did accept Jesus and some that didn't accept Jesus. Right?

But for there to be a temple on the Temple Mount, not only must you destroy the entire nation, all the Islamic nations and all the communist nations in order to make that happen, but you would also have to have a government and priesthood that are willing to obey God, not just in the Sabbath, not just in the Holy Days, by every word that God commends.

And yet, really, the Word of God commends that you not observe the animal sacrifices anymore.

Because the blood of Jesus does atone, did atone for our sins one time.

The Bible says He died one time for our sins.

He doesn't have to do it again and again and again or heal an animal over and over every seven days or every day of the week or whatever and once a year or every time we sin or any of these.

The blood of Jesus atones permanently for our sins as long as we stay within that atonement, as long as we stay obedient to Him, as long as we do not fall away from Him and start following Queen Easter and so forth.

And as long as we follow Him in truth, which includes logic because logic is truth.

So, none of this makes sense for this to be a temple in our day and time.

Also, they relate this to verses in the New Testament, Revelation 11 and 2

Thessalonians 2 where it has the word temple of God, not the Jewish temple.

It doesn't say the Jewish temple.

It says the temple of God.

So, you would call the Jewish temple back in the time of King Solomon and King Herod.

You would call those Jewish temples, you would call that the temple of God.

But a temple built today in modern times on the Temple Mount, God would not call it His.

God would not claim it.

So, the Bible would not call it the temple of God.

If it was to be built and if it was a biblical prophecy, then it would just simply be called the Jewish temple or the temple of the Jews, not the temple of God.

Because of the fact that the animal sacrifices and the Levitical priesthood being existent within that temple, it goes contrary and it goes as an enemy to the blood of Christ.

The Sabbath is not an enemy of the blood of Christ.

The Holy Days is not an enemy to the blood of Christ.

But animal sacrifices is. Absolutely.

So, what is this talking about then in Ezekiel 40 all the way up to the end of Ezekiel?

Those nine chapters.

What is it talking about then?

Well, there's two possibilities here.

One possibility is that it was actually already fulfilled with the second temple.

And that's what the Jews actually say and that's what they teach is that it is described in the second temple.

But, however, the shape and dimensions of it, which we're not reading, we don't have to go into all that detail, but the exact dimensions described of how to build it does not match.

It does not match the second temple.

But the Jews say it is the second temple, but that the instructions were not followed to fullness, to a complete perfection for whatever reason.

The second option is a very real option and that is that these chapters were wrongly inserted into the Bible.

And the reason we can say that and the reason it is a strong possibility is because these nine chapters do not match the writing style of all thirty-nine chapters leading up to this point.

The first thirty-nine chapters of Ezekiel that have a certain writing style, as anybody does.

Everybody has their own writing style.

You can identify who wrote something by their style of writing.

You can even do that to determine if you're just looking at only the words and didn't know who was writing it between the writings of John.

And Luke and Mark and Matthew. The four gospels. They each have a different writing style.

For example, John focuses very heavily upon the divinity of Jesus. That Jesus is God. He focuses extremely heavy upon that and there's also a recurring theme of water many times throughout the book of John as well.

So that's unique to how John wrote. Supernatural.

Even the book of Revelation being a very supernatural book.

He wrote in a theme of supernatural theme. And so forth.

You can do this throughout the Bible.

The writing styles of all the different authors.

The book of Hebrews.

How that is written.

And compare it to the writings of Philo of what we call the works of Philo and identify that that's who wrote it.

The same words, the usage of words, unique words between Hebrews and the writings, the works of Philo.

So we identify who wrote Hebrews by his writing style.

If you compare the writing style of the nine chapters, last nine chapters of Ezekiel, it does not match the other 39 chapters.

It does not match.

It was written by somebody else.

It's very clear. Absolutely clear.

Now perhaps Ezekiel fired his previous scribe or his previous scribe died or whatever. Perhaps.

That could be a possibility.

It really can be a possibility.

But we don't have anything to really indicate that.

So it would be only assumption that his scribe died or was fired or replaced or whatever.

And really isn't the job of a scribe is to write what Ezekiel is actually saying.

So he's not making up his own words.

The scribe, he's opposed to whatever Moses is saying or whatever Ezekiel is saying, whatever John is saying, whatever.

Then you write down what the master is saying.

I use the word master because the scribe is an apprentice to the mentor.

So the word master is very appropriate in that context.

So he would just write down the exact words.

So you would still have Ezekiel.

You would still have the words of Ezekiel and the words of God.

So it would be more logical to believe that it's not the work of Ezekiel at all.

Not the work of Ezekiel at all, those last nine chapters.

Knowing this, knowing this, both that it's not the work of Ezekiel, it definitely is not.

Perhaps it's the work of a true man of God or perhaps it's the work of the Catholic

Church or some Jewish mystical person, mystic, we don't know.

But we know it's not the work of Ezekiel for sure.

With that knowledge, we can't really use it for teaching anything, at all, no matter what it is.

Whether it's a rebuilt temple, animal sacrifices, circumcision, Levitical priesthood, it don't matter.

We can't use those nine chapters at all because we cannot support who wrote it. Who wrote it. It could be anybody. Anybody in the world. Evil, righteous, bad, good, anyone. So until the author is identified and verified that he's a true man of God, these nine chapters we cannot use to teach anything at all.

One thing we do know for sure, more than anything else, it cannot refer to a New Covenant time zone temple of God because the animal sacrifices today in the context of New Covenant time would be an enemy to God.

It would be confronting, for the lack of, I can't think of the word I'm trying to think of, but maybe affront, if that's the word, to God.

That's it. It would be affront to God. That is the right word.

So we have to look at other verses in the Bible.

Let's look at Revelation 11.

They use Revelation 11 a whole lot to try to prove that a third Jewish temple would be built. So let's look at that. Revelation 11. Verse 1.

"There was given to me a measuring rod like a staff, and someone said, Rise, measure the temple of God, the temple of the Theos, and the altar, and those who worship in it." Right there it calls it the temple of God. Again, a Jewish temple.

Verse 1 calls it the temple of God, and as I said a while ago, a Jewish temple in modern time, God would not claim it as His, therefore the Scripture would not call it the temple of God.

A temple that has animal sacrifices in our day and time is not a temple of God. It would be only a Jewish temple.

So the very verse that they use does not prove a Jewish temple, because a Jewish temple our day and time would not be the temple of God. Plain and simple.

If you accept the blood of Jesus, then God would not command nor even allow such an abomination.

It would be an abomination to have a Jewish temple sacrifice in the animals today.

Now He does allow some tremendous abominations upon the earth, but this would not be something He would allow, not because it's an abomination, but because it's not something that He is ordering, and the doctrine is saying that He is ordering this.

They're saying that God approves of this, that God is the one bringing it about.

So it's not logical.

Now we'll continue.

Verse 2, Leave out the courtyard which is outside the temple and do not measure it, for it has been given to the Gentiles, and they shall tread underfoot the Holy City for forty-two months.

Now right here says that the Holy City, which is Jerusalem, is underfoot of the Gentiles,

the Muslims, the Commoners.

Now this is more than just Jordan, because Jordan, being Gentiles, they already have control of the temple now and have had control of the temple now for decades.

So this is not talking about Jordan, because this is something new.

This is forty-two months.

That's three and a half years, so not decades.

So it's not talking about the current occupation that we have in Jerusalem of the Jordanian authority over the temple now.

This is something new to the end time, to the forty-two months, the three and a half years of the Great Tribulation.

So what Gentiles is it talking about?

Compare that to Ezekiel 38, because Ezekiel 38, that becomes two chapters before Ezekiel 40, so you're still within the true writings of Ezekiel. Amen?

The true writings of Ezekiel that we can use for teaching, should use for teaching.

You compare it to Ezekiel 38, it says Gog and Magog.

People debate that all the time, but it's very clearly Russia and China.

It doesn't take much study or research to really come to that conclusion.

It's very clear.

And then you've got Persia.

Persia, there's no debate at all there. That's Iran. We know that for sure. Everybody agrees that that's Iran.

Who leads Iran? If anybody was to lead Iran, who would it be?

There's only one possibility and that's Russia.

Iran will not follow anybody, but Russia, only Russia.

Iran is not going to follow the European Union. Amen?

Even though there's a lot of people out there, many, many, many people, many churches, many denominations, saying it's the European Union and Germany where the Antichrist is going to arise from.

The European Union to invade Israel.

That's crazy.

That's crazy talk.

It really is crazy talk that the European Union is not going to invade Israel.

That's just...

If you think that, you ain't got no sense.

And if that offends you, I don't care because that is such a silly, ridiculous thing to think buy a brain.

Buy a brain and buy it today.

It's ridiculous to think that Germany is going to invade Israel.

Now, maybe back in the time of Hitler, but we don't have that extremity today.

Therefore, let's use some common sense in our modern context. Amen?

Modern context is everything.

If it's an end time prophecy, then you have to look at the political powers that we actually see upon this earth.

And the political dramatics, not dramatics, the dynamics.

You have to look at that.

You have to consider that.

Not just ignore it.

Not just turn a blind eye to it.

We have to look at these things.

Iran, they're not going to follow or obey or allow anyone to lead them except for only Russia.

Only Russia has that political power upon this earth today over the Islamic nations.

Amen.

And Ezekiel 38 uses the term that the Gog would come out of the father's north, as far north as you can get, and that's Russia.

And chapter 39, Ezekiel 39 says the extremity of the north.

So between chapter 38 and 39, you have two different phrases that defines Gog as being a nation that is to the

very far north, the father's north you can get.

And yet they lead Iran.

So both of those are huge, huge clues. Amen.

So the Gentiles here in Revelation 11 would include the Iranians and the Russians and their other allies.

Other allies.

It's the confederation of Islamic and communist nations for three and a half years after their tribulation.

Therefore, to think that Iran and Russia and the other Islamic and communist nations would allow a temple of the Jews to be built and to continue to exist and to continue to operate on the temple mount in place of the Islamic temple that they have there now, the Golden Dome, or next to it, either way, that is some pretty insane thinking. Amen.

It's not using your head at all.

It ain't going to happen.

It ain't going to happen.

So what is this temple of God then in verse 1?

What is it?

Well, all you've got to do is go down to verse 19.

It tells you.

Verse 19 says the temple of God which is in heaven.

It tells you.

It's not on the temple mount.

It tells you it's in heaven.

And they said no, that verse 1 is on earth and verse 19 is in heaven that is showing you the comparison of the one on earth with the copy in heaven or vice versa or whatever.

But you would have to prove that to me.

You can't prove that to me other than we do have indication that we do have a copy on earth of what's in heaven.

Yes. Yes. They would point to that in Hebrews.

But you would have to prove that this verse right here is referring to that. And you can't prove that to me. You can't. It's impossible. There's nothing in the context.

There's nothing in the Bible anywhere to prove that this particular verse is a comparison of two different temples.

To say that it is a comparison of two different temples doesn't match the reality of the world that we see today.

And it doesn't match the reality that God would not claim it as His.

So this is the verse they use. And it doesn't prove it. It does not prove it.

But there is a temple in heaven. And it's also referred to over in 2 Thessalonians and they also use that as well.

So let's go over there and look at that.

2 Thessalonians 2.

Now it amazes me that they want to use this chapter in 2 Thessalonians 2 because actually this chapter, if you read the whole chapter, exposes their churches as being very ignorant of the Bible and having false doctrine and trusting in a fairy tale.

That's what this chapter proves.

And yet they will use this chapter to try to prove the Jews on the temple mount.

Not realizing that they're pointing to their own death and exposing their own false doctrines.

This is how ignorant they are. That's pretty ignorant. That's pretty ignorant.

We're going to first find the verse that they use.

And I see it right there in verse 4.

Verse 4 says, talking about the antichrist, that he opposes and exalts himself above everyone called God or object of worship so that he will sit in the temple of God exhibiting himself as being God.

There's a major problem with this.

Two major problems actually.

At least two major problems.

And one of the problems is that the temple of God, according to Revelation 11 verse 19, is in heaven.

So you would have to show me a Bible verse that says the temple of God in Jerusalem or the temple of God on earth or the temple of God in Israel or something like that.

There's no such verse.

But you would have to show me such a verse to prove to me that this temple of God is on the temple mount or in Jerusalem or on earth.

There's no such verse.

You would have to assume it's on the temple mount.

You should never assume it.

You have to have proof.

You would have to assume it, which you should never do.

People would say, but you're assuming it's in heaven.

No, I'm not assuming it's in heaven.

The Bible says it's in heaven.

Revelation 11 verse 19, I can actually give you a verse that says in heaven.

So that's not assumption.

I have a verse. Amen.

Now let's back up to verse 1, which will expose them as being very ignorant of the Bible and teaching a false prophecy of a pre-tribulation rapture.

And that's very important to expose that because they connect that prophecy with the prophecy of the temple.

Right?

So if you prove them wrong about the pre-trib rapture, then you also prove them wrong about all the other prophecies because it is a package deal that they are totally ignorant of the Bible.

Totally.

Absolutely totally.

The only thing they got right is that Jesus died for our sins and that's about it.

That's about it.

They don't even go to church on the right day, which is a very basic thing, a very easy thing.

You don't have to read the Bible much to be able to figure that out.

And yet they don't even get that right.

When the Sabbath day does come, the true Sabbath, they don't treat it any different from any other day.

They're still going to the yard sales.

They're still working.

They're still mowing the yard.

They're still going to the gym.

Whatever. Whatever.

It's the same as all the other days.

They don't treat it as a separate set apart holy day.

No respect.

No honor for God.

That's just the way it is.

So, verse 1, Now we request you, brethren, about the coming of the Lord Jesus, the Christ, and our gathering together to Him, our gathering to be with Christ.

Verse 2, That you not be quickly shaken from your composure, or be disturbed by spirit, or message, or letter, as if it was from us, to effect that that day has come.

Let no man, no one deceive you until the hypocrisy, the falling away comes first, and the man of lawlessness, that's the antichrist, everybody agrees, that's who it's talking about, until the man of lawlessness, the antichrist, be manifested, the son of perdition, the son of destruction, who opposes and exalts himself above everyone called God or object of worship.

So right there, it's saying, don't let anyone deceive you that we are not being, we are not going to be gathered to Christ pre-tribulation rapture before the antichrist comes.

Very clear.

This is easy to understand.

It's very simple.

The Bible says it in very simple, easy language.

Even a child can understand it.

You're not going to be gathered to Christ before the antichrist.

It ain't happening.

But even though it's very simple and easy that even a child can understand it, these churches are teaching, yes, you are going to be gathered to Christ before the antichrist comes, that you're not going to have to worry about the antichrist, that you won't even see the antichrist, you won't be here.

And yet this very verse says it ain't happening.

And yet they will choose the one verse, verse 4, where the antichrist is in the temple of God claiming it's on the temple mount and saying you won't be here to see it.

And yet the Bible just said it ain't happening. Amen?

So we've already exposed them just within four verses here.

Just within four verses we've already exposed that they are extremely ignorant of the Bible.

And that they're teaching and putting their hope and putting their faith in a fairy tale.

So why would you trust them about anything else when it's so simple?

Why would you trust them?

Why would you go to their churches?

Why would you walk through that door knowing that your pastor doesn't know the Bible?

Why would you want to keep going?

I don't know why you would want to keep going.

I really don't.

So the antichrist is actually sitting in heaven here.

According to Revelation 11.19 the temple of God is in heaven.

That makes a whole lot more sense than a man standing or sitting on the temple mount.

It makes a whole lot more sense because there's been a lot of different men come and go that actually did stand on the temple mount claiming to be God.

That's already happened over and over and over.

And they usually get as many as maximum, maybe 2,000 followers, 5,000 followers, whatever.

10,000 maybe, but just in the thousands as not millions.

But if you look at the book of Revelation it says that the whole world will follow the antichrist.

Everybody, everybody except for only the saints that are appointed and chosen by God but everybody else in the entire world according to the book of Revelation will worship the antichrist.

Will.

That's millions and millions and millions of people perhaps over a billion people because there's going to be a lot of people that's going to die in that invasion of Israel.

Invasion of America.

Invasion of Australia.

So forth.

A lot of people are going to die so we don't know how many billions will still be alive during the first six months of the great tribulation.

So that's why I'm saying these numbers.

But nevertheless there's a lot of people.

A man standing on the temple mount is not going to get billions of worshipers.

It ain't happening.

It ain't happening.

But if you have somebody appearing in the sky in a fake rapture because that's what they want.

That's what they teach.

That's what they put their hope in.

That's what they put their faith in instead of putting faith in Christ.

Their faith is in a false event.

If you have a fake Christ which is what they serve every Sunday.

The day of sun worship.

The Catholic Sunday.

The Catholic Church.

They claim to be Protestant but they're not Protestant because they're still keeping Catholic Sunday.

Catholic Easter.

Catholic Ash Wednesday.

St. Valentine's Day.

The list goes on and on and on.

They call themselves Protestant but they're not Protestant at all.

They're still Catholic.

Catholic Trinity.

The list just goes on and on and on.

So, they're putting their trust in a fake Christ in a fake rapture and it's going to happen because God does turn them over to what they want.

What they worship.

Whether it's homosexuality.

Buddhism. Hinduism. Atheists. Whatever.

A person, the Assyrian gods.

Whatever they have chosen to serve.

God says, okay, that's what you want?

Here, choke on it. I'll give you more of it. Go for it. Kill yourself.

According to the Bible, that is what He does.

Absolutely.

It does describe that. Read it. Read it for yourself.

Read the Bible. Amen? Read the Bible.

So, that's why they put their hope in.

That's what they want to happen.

God says, okay, choke on it.

You're going to get it.

I'm going to give you a pre-true rapture.

I'm going to give it to you.

Your fake Christ in which you serve, in which you co-exist with all religions, your witchcraft, your demonic activity, your yoga, your Buddhism, your Hinduism, your witchcraft, here, choke on this.

That's what you want to serve?

Go for it.

That strong delusion, the Bible calls it strong.

It ain't no weak delusion.

A man standing on the temple mount claiming to be God, that's happened more times than I can count.

It's a weak delusion.

But the pre-true rapture is a very strong delusion, very strong delusion, which over a billion fake Christians put their trust in.

That fits the biblical description of the entire world. Amen?

And the Muslims also trust in that, too. The Mahdi coming in the sky.

They trust in that, too.

So you can add in the billions of Muslims.

Same thing as a fake Christian, really. It's all the same thing. Fake religion.

The president of Syria, he's the only one that could possibly fulfill these prophecies because he does command his military, his army to worship him.

They do behead people for not worshipping him.

And they do work in conjunction with both the Muslims and the Catholics both.

He is the only one that is trying to force his own version of the Koran down the throats of all nations and Islamic organizations.

His name is in the Bible as being the name of the antichrist.

Revelation 13, the word beast in Arabic is his family name.

The word Assad means lion, as in he has the mouth of a lion.

The mouth of a lion speaking great blasphemies.

But you can tell every bit of this to somebody and they're like, nope, I don't believe it.

His name might be in the Bible, but I still don't believe it.

You can't convince the truth to somebody that doesn't want the truth.

I'll say that one more time.

You can't convince somebody of the truth that doesn't want the truth.

If I see somebody's name in the Bible, I'm convinced you don't have to show me nothing else.

I don't need a thousand different ways of proving something.

That's pretty convincing right there.

But they still don't believe it.

Well, it can't be so. It can't be so.

It can't be so.

They don't believe the Bible.

Plain and simple. Plain and simple.

There's pretty much only about one more verse that they try to use and that's Daniel 9. So let's look at that real quick.

Daniel 9, verse 27. Page 182. Okay. Page 182 if you have the paperback, Alpha, and Omega Bible. Daniel 9, verse 27.

Now, in the book of Daniel, in Alpha and Omega Bible, you'll notice that we have two paragraphs for sentences for each verse.

The top sentence for each verse is the traditional Theodotion version of Daniel of the Greek situation.

The second verse, the bottom verse for each verse, or the second line of each, or the second paragraph for each verse is the older Greek version of the Greek situation, the older Greek version of the Greek situation, the oldest Greek of the Greek situation.

And therefore, actually the oldest version of Daniel that we have.

Verse 27, we're going to look at the old Greek version here, but it's pretty much the same.

And the covenant should rule in many.

Now, they say that's a peace treaty, but you'd have to prove it to me.

I'm not going to assume it.

They love to assume things, don't they?

It doesn't say peace treaty. It says covenant.

There are many different covenants that are not peace treaties.

You have to prove to me that it's a peace treaty which you cannot prove, period.

So right there alone, we're only three words into this verse and we're already exposing that they're making assumptions that can't be proved.

That's a bad start. Amen.

But it's some kind of a covenant.

And the covenant should rule in many and he should return again and it should be rebuilt in breadth and length and at the time of times or the end of times and after seven and seventy times and sixty-two years until the time of the end of war and the desolation should be taken away and the covenant should be prevailing for many weeks and at the end of the week, the sacrifice and the drink offering should be taken away and on the temple should be the abomination of desolation until the end and the end should be given unto the desolation.

Other than the fact that they're already exposed that make an assumption that can't be proven, other than that, the rest of this is too confusing for people to try to figure out how it would come to relate to the end time great tribulation.

You would have to do some decrypting, counting of years, centuries, decades, millenniums.

You've got to be basically a mathematician to figure this out.

It's too confusing.

And whenever you have a verse that is very confusing, then you definitely need a more clear Bible verse, some results that is straight and to the point and not confusing.

That is simple so that you know that you understood that you interpreted this correctly. And there's no such Bible verse that we can use for clarity about what this means if we're going to try to force it to be an end time prophecy for our day and our time. And since we don't have any Bible verse to prove of our doubt that it's at least in part referring to the end time generation, we can't use it.

We can't.

Because if we use verses that are confusing and could be easily misinterpreted, then you're asking for trouble.

Absolutely. Amen?

I believe that this was 100% fulfilled in the life and death of Christ and the temples that existed before that and during that time and destroyed in 70 A.D.

I believe that this is entirely fulfilled just like a lot of the Book of Daniel has already been fulfilled in a time of Antiochus Epiphanes and the different wars and the different invasions that happened thousands of years ago.

That can probably be more easily proven than trying to force it to fit in the end time great revelation.

So we really can't use this to try to prove a temple will be built in our day and time because it's too confusing.

We can't verify it with another Bible verse and the very verse itself is already being twisted by these false churches to try to preach a peace treaty.

It's already being twisted in that way.

So if they're already twisting it, they're going to continue to twist it.

Don't that make sense? Amen.

So out of all the different verses we've looked at, we don't have the proof of a rebuilt Jewish temple.

It's very interesting that today is the coronation day of King Charles of England of the British Commonwealth.

I did not realize that it was today as far as my fresh memory, my realization.

I didn't grab onto it.

I didn't embrace it even though I know I've read about it that it was coming forth and the date to it and all that.

But it wasn't fresh in my memory yesterday and last night when I was preparing these sermon notes.

It didn't come into my consideration at all.

Yet today Brother Jared did bring up that King Charles was being crowned today.

This is the coronation day.

And it really struck a bell in my spirit because of the sermon topic today being a temple. And a temple is basically a palace of God. Amen.

A government of God, administrative center, the first temple mount, the second temple mount, I mean not temple mount, but temple, the true temple of God, first one and the second one.

It was where God actually was present in a very strong and powerful way and where His priests brought forth commandments and orders for the nation, for the world, for

the people.

It was an administrative center.

It wasn't just only worship and animal sacrifices.

It was an administrative center.

And it was where even though the Jews had and the Israelites had governors and physical kings, those governors and physical kings would have to obey the word of God coming from the temple.

If they did not obey the word of God coming from the temple, God would remove them from the throne. Amen.

So the temple exercised a lot of authority over the government.

As I have preached before, you really cannot separate church and government. You can't. It's impossible.

Even when you try your very, very best, even in the communist nations and any nation, any government, these antichrist governments and city councils and state governments, California, New York, and so forth, even though they try their best to separate it, they can't. You can't.

Even being an atheist is serving the devil.

And all false religion, anything that's not true Christianity, anything that is not true Christianity is automatically in the eyes and heart and mind of God, antichrist, an abomination to Him, and therefore is serving the devil.

So even when you try not to have religion, you're serving the devil.

You either serve God or you serve the devil. That's the way it is. There's no in-between.

You are either serving God or you're serving the devil.

There is no in-between. There's no gray area. This is simple. Life or death. Left or right.

That's the way God commands.

You cannot serve both the devil and God both at the same time.

Choose which side you're going to stand on. It's that simple.

God does not accept vain worship, half-worship, half-hearted worship.

He does not accept it according to the Bible.

That's not my words. That's what the Bible describes.

But people think that they can coexist with religions that do not accept Him as God.

And just be at peace with that.

Just be at peace with yourself and make yourself God and lift yourself up.

It's not right. God doesn't accept it. He hates it.

It's an abomination to Him.

You either serve God or you serve the devil.

And when you're trying to lift yourself up and exalt yourself outside of God, it ain't going to work.

You will only pay the consequence.

People wonder

why they suffer with that.

Why would they suffer this or that or this or that or this?

I think the answer is pretty simple.

God is good to reveal Himself and His light, His truth, and in Him we trust and put our trust in. Amen?

We are to put our trust in the Lord God Almighty and put Him first in everything, absolutely everything, and be obedient to Him because He's God.

And He deserves obedience.

He deserves honor and respect.

He deserves it.

And this is the full duty of man. Amen.

It is our reasonable service, the Bible says.

So let's worship Him in truth wholeheartedly, 100% not wavering, not compromising the false religions, churches that are ignorant, pastors that are ignorant.

Let us be worshiping Him in spirit and in truth.

John 4 says that He is seeking, He is searching for a people who will worship Him in spirit and in truth.

You have to have both.

A lot of people focus only on the spirit.

A lot of other people focus only on knowledge.

That's the way of Freemasons, knowledge, book smarts, knowledge.

That was the way of the Pharisees, only knowledge, but not faith, not spirit.

God wants both spirit and truth, where we have knowledge, the right knowledge, the correct knowledge, and applying all of it in the spirit of God, having a real relationship with Him, trusting Him, depending upon Him, following Him, obeying Him, where He is Lord of our life, Master of our life and no other. Amen.

He is our Lord, our King, our Master.

In God, Jesus, we trust.

Long live the king.

We know that King Charles is compromising with communism and Islam in a lot of different ways, but we have to look at the example of David and Saul, how David, even though he had the right to just go ahead and kill Saul and disrespect Saul, he could have very easily done that without being censored by God, without being punished by God.

David could have done anything he wanted to.

The throne was rightfully his. He had the authority of God behind him. But David showed honor and respect to the king. He allowed the king to destroy himself, basically. Amen.

And we should take that same mentality for King Charles of honor and respect because he does sit on David's throne.

He does sit on David's throne as the Bible promises that there would never be a time when a person would not sit on the throne of David.

Somebody sits on the throne of David according to the Bible.

We have the history of the British royalty going all the way to David.

That's recorded.

They actually are the bloodline of David.

And they still sit on the throne.
So this is very easily proven.
Very simple. Very easy.
Very logical. Very real.
Very biblical.
So he sits in the throne of Saul.
He sits in the throne of David.
And this is a position that is something we better not mess with.
God put him there.
He's going to make some mistakes in this wicked generation just like a lot of the kings of Israel fell away from God like Solomon.
But with him sitting in the seat of David under the authority of God, we have to show him a certain level of honor and respect and reverence.
We have to be careful about such things.
Let God deal with them. Amen.
God is His judge.
Long live the king.
May he prosper and be in good health.
He is the son of Queen Elizabeth.
Long live the king!
Long live the king!
Long live the king!
Long live the king! Amen.

Okay, thank you for listening today.
I know I've been talking awful slow today.
I guess I need some espresso.
Alright, talk to you later.

Let's see, we've got three weeks to Pentecost.
We'll be counting the days to Pentecost, three weeks.
I hope to see brother Andrew here.
It would be nice if we could see other people here as well coming in from the different states to do what the Bible says, to go on that pilgrimage three times a year at Passover, Pentecost, and Tabernacles.
It sure would be glorious to see people obey God.
It's going to happen one of these days after God gives them good speaking with the war, with the invasions, the great tribulation.
Finally, people will start waking up and start wanting to obey God.
It ain't going to happen until then.
We'll find a few more true brothers and true sisters, a few more, one more, two more, three more, here and there, very slowly, one at a time.
As I preached very recently, the countdown to the true revolution of Jesus, the true Jesus revolution, it ain't happening before the tribulation.

According to the Bible, it ain't happening until the final year of the great tribulation. If you've not heard that sermon yet, look that sermon up. The countdown to the true Jesus revolution concerning the final year of the great tribulation.

We're not going to see no great revival anywhere on earth, anywhere.

It ain't happening until that final year.

Because the people, they want to coexist with ignorant pastors, ignorant churches, and false religion and disobedience and disrespect to God, and they're not going to change.

I've tried. I've talked to them.

I've talked and talked and talked and talked.

I've talked and talked and talked.

They ain't going to change until God gives them a very good spanking.

That's just the reality of it.

That we look forward to the one person, the one next person that is willing to serve God in spirit and truth.

And I hope that will be you.

And I hope to meet you soon.

Until then, may Jesus bless those that are growing in Him.

In Jesus' name, so be it. Amen.

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
